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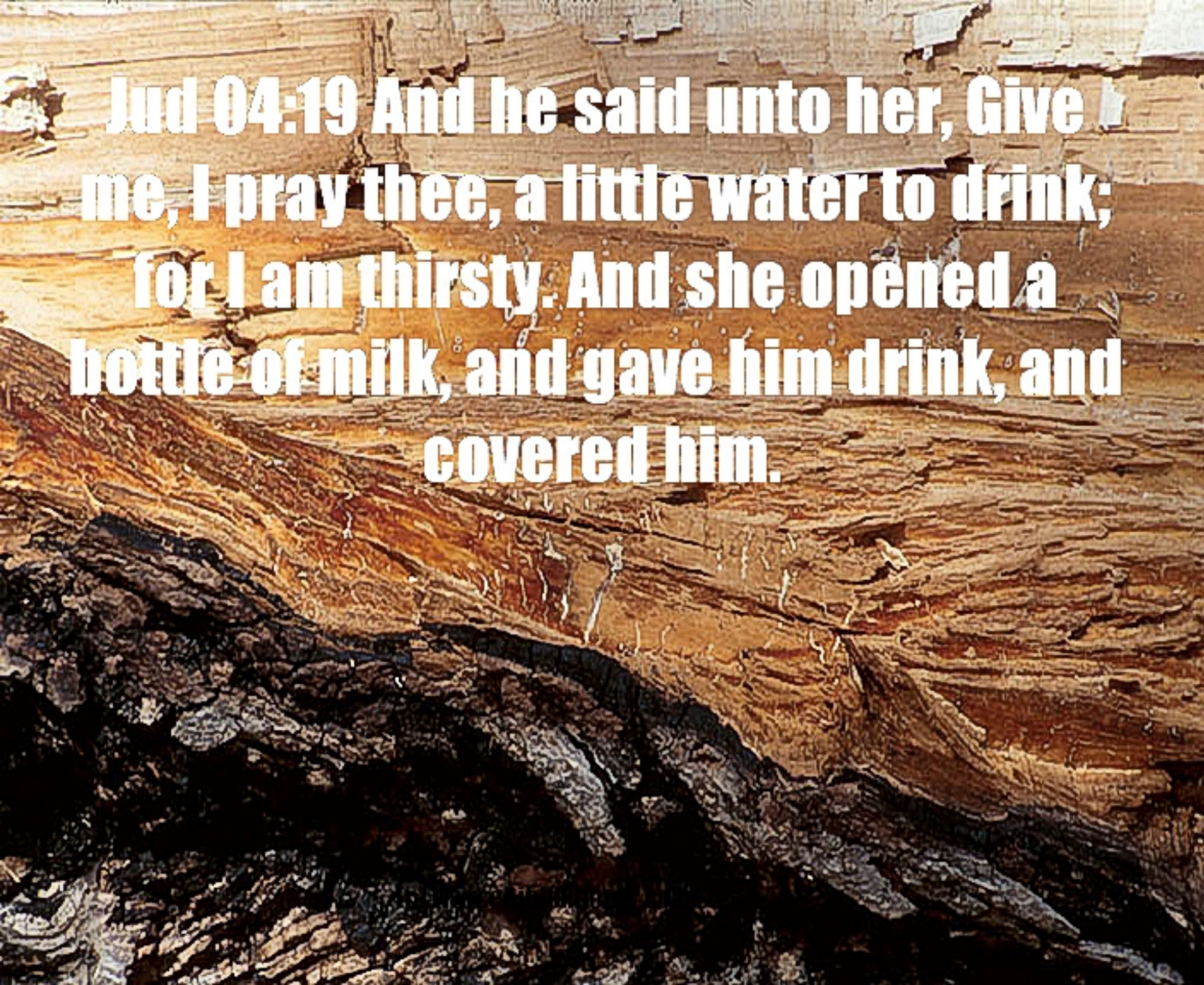

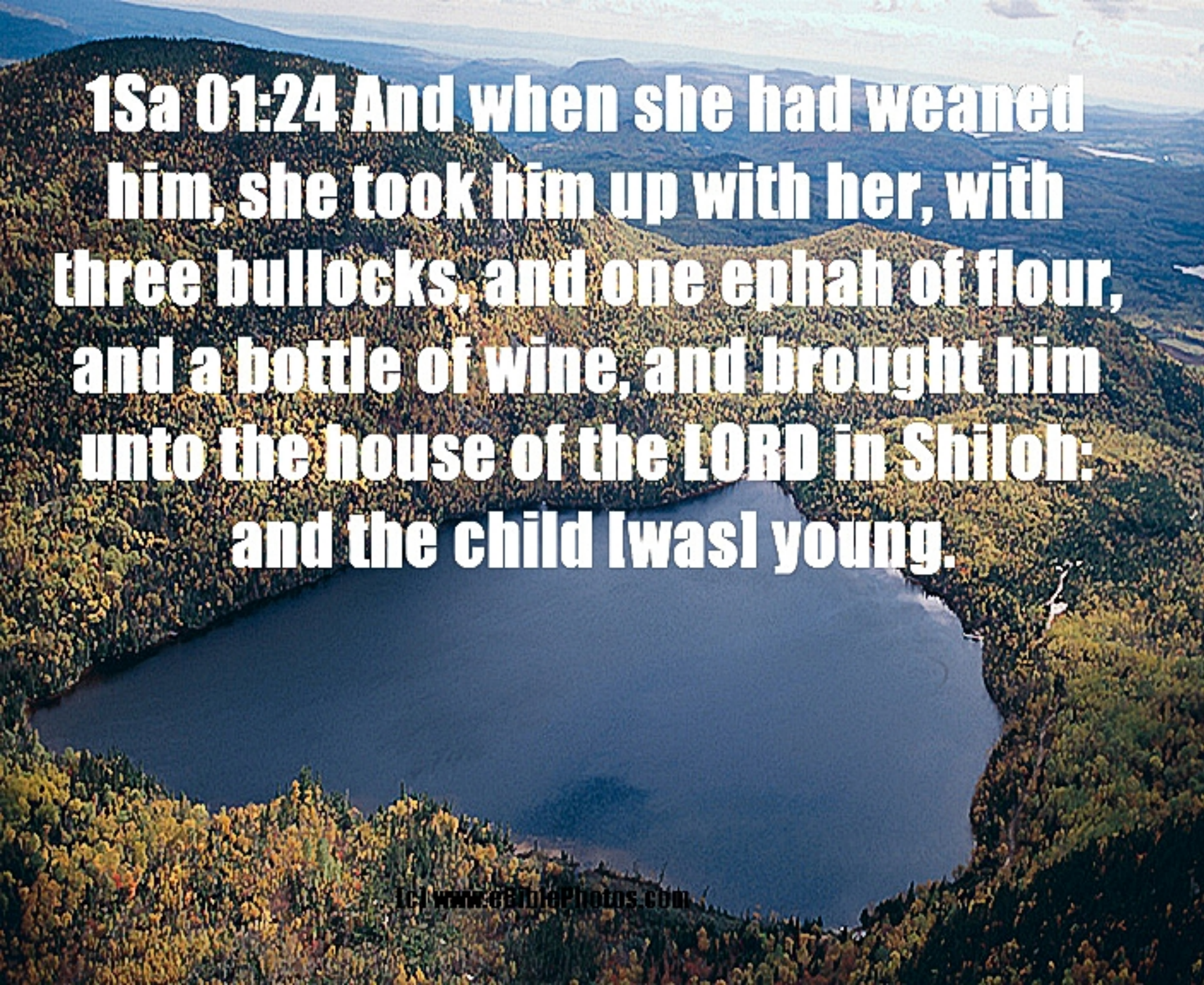

one of the shrubs.**

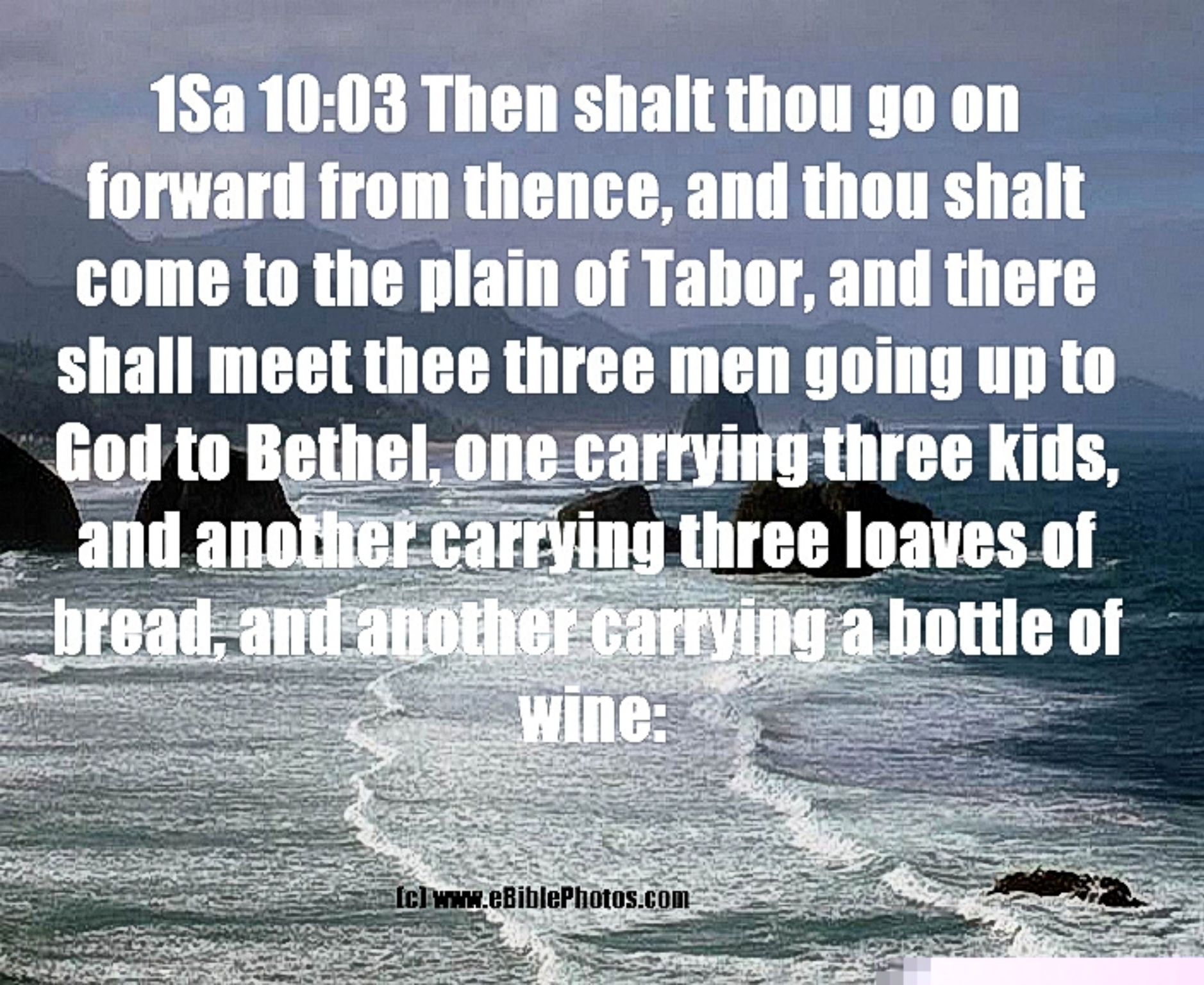
**Gen 21:19 And God opened her eyes, and

gave the lad drink.**



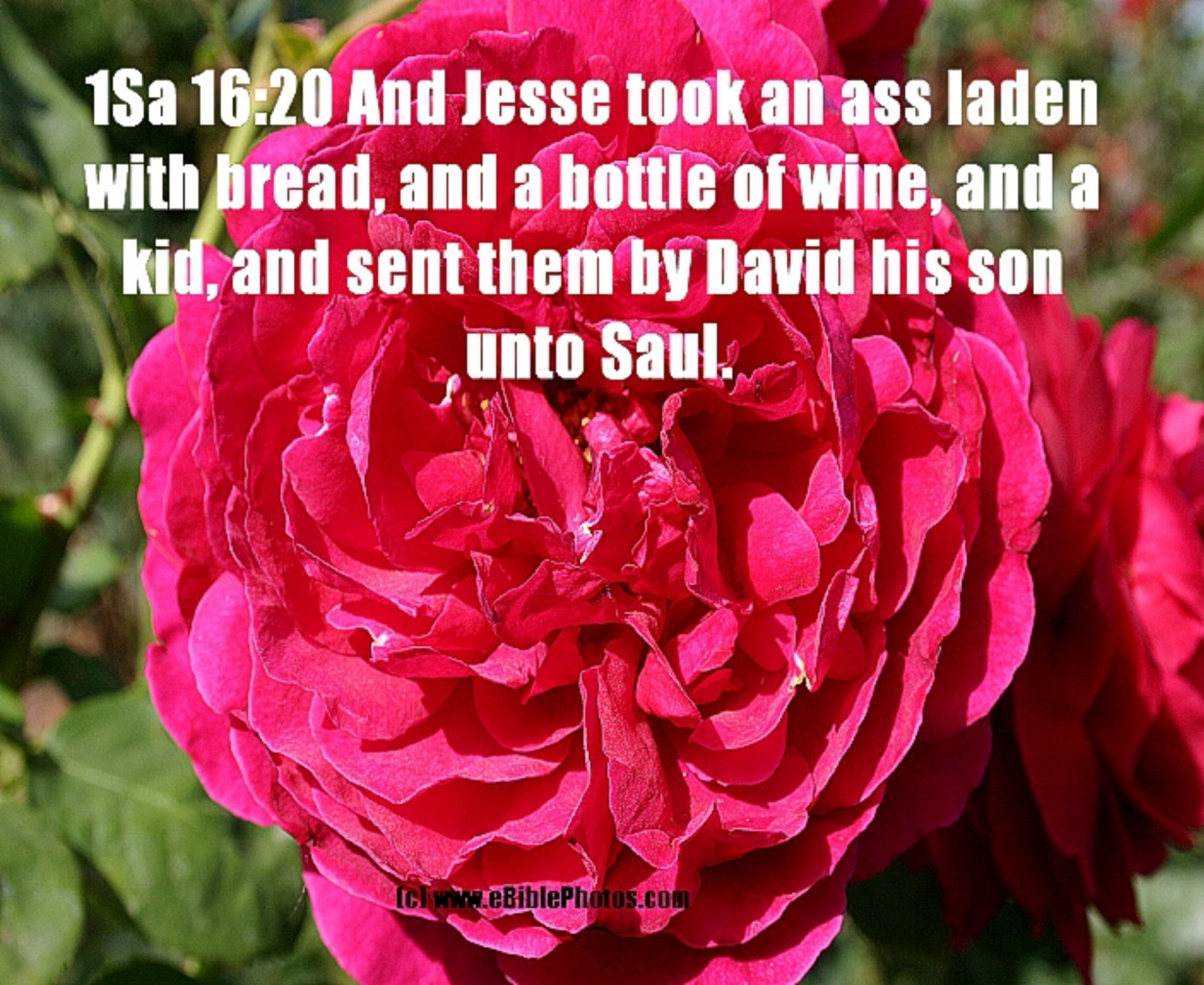
**Jud 04:19 And he said unto her, Give

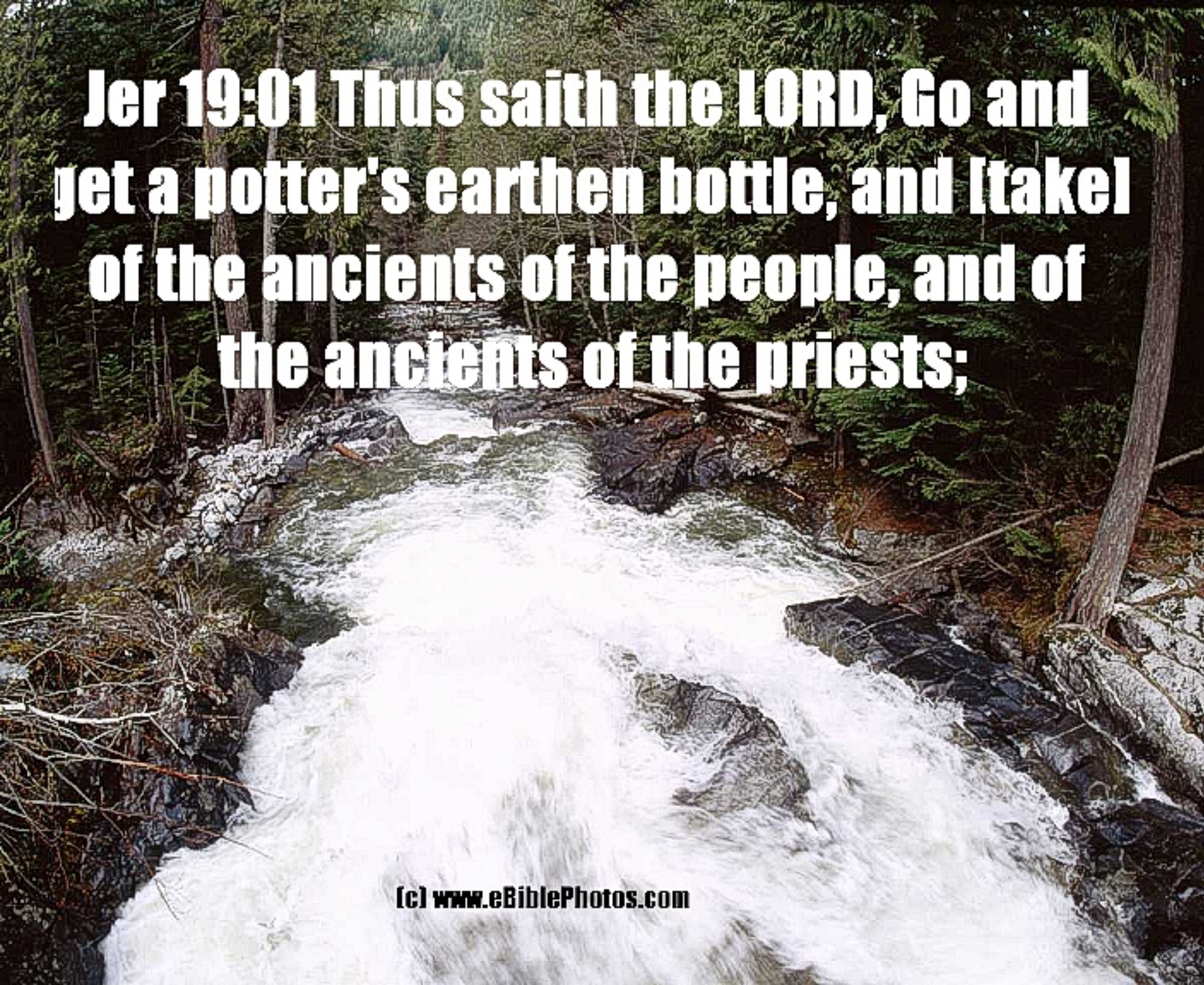

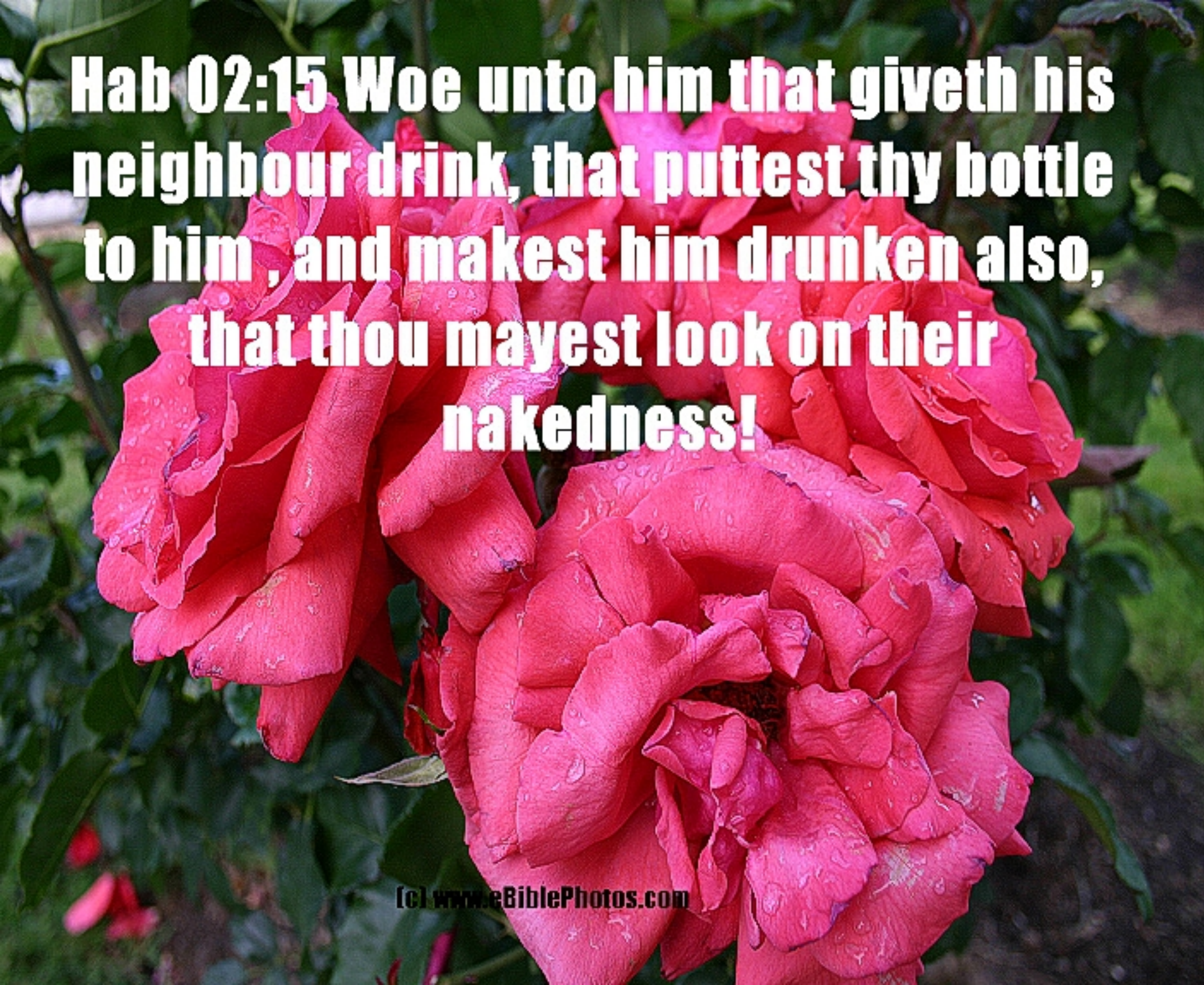
