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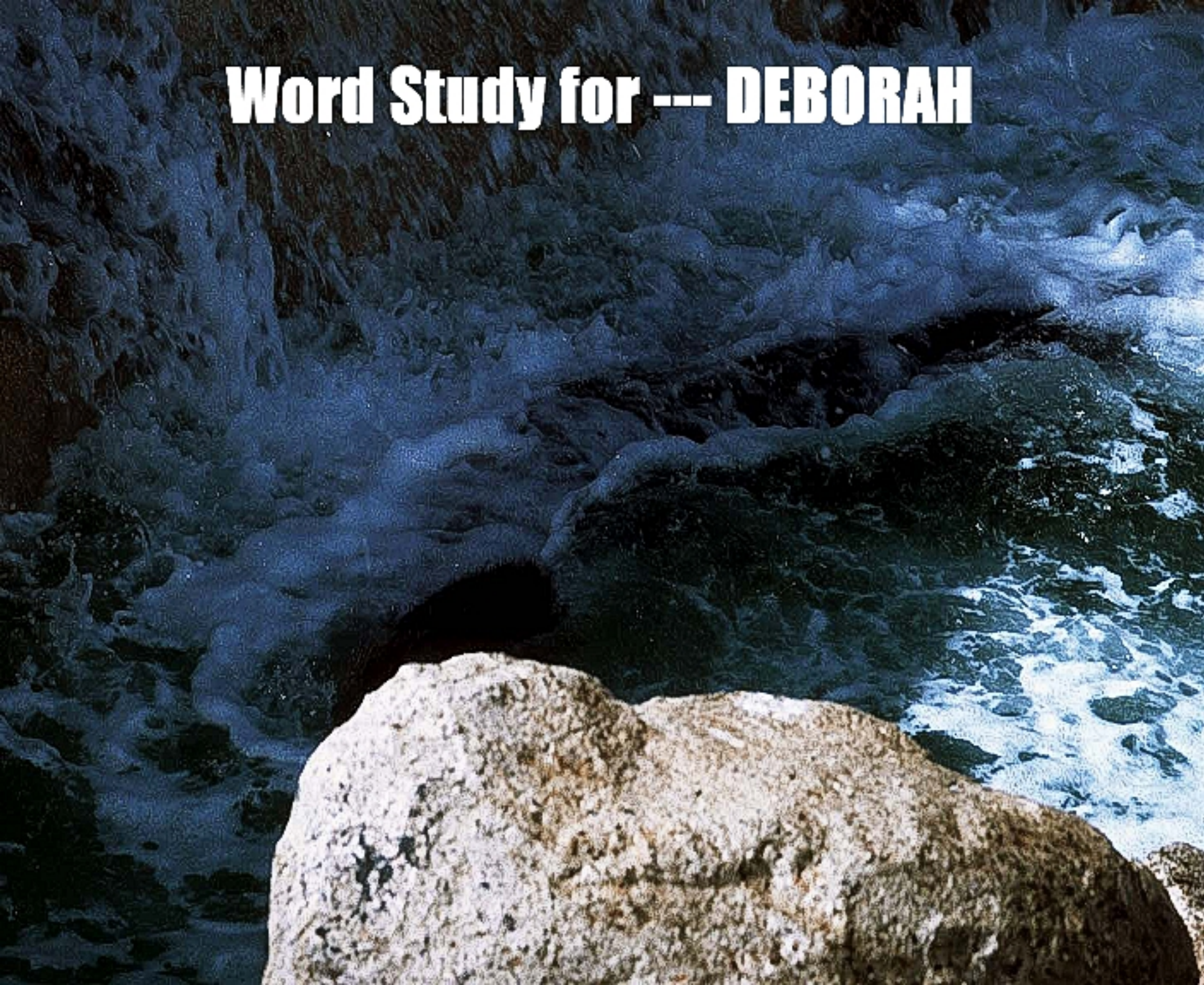
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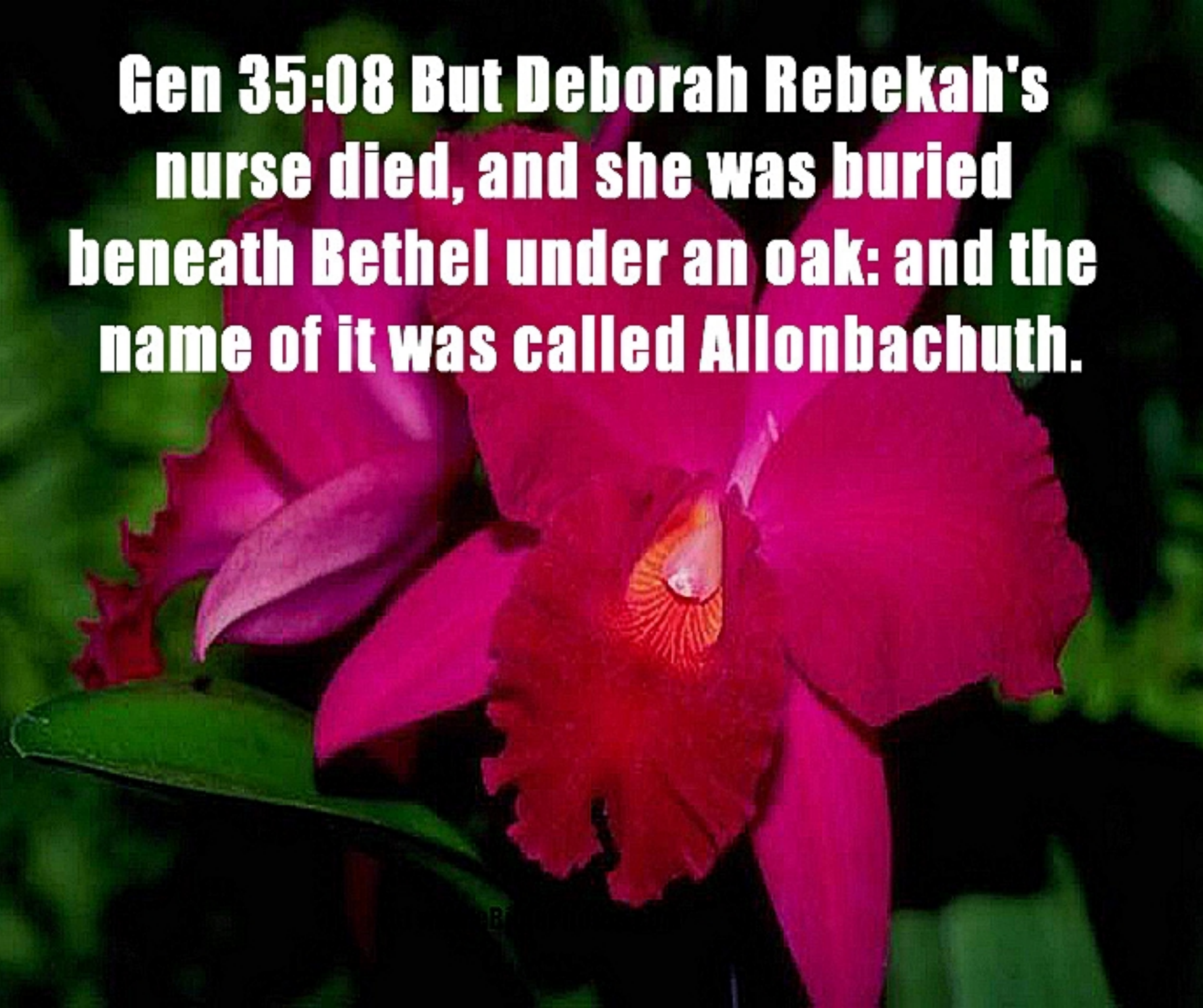

name of it was called Allonbachuth.**



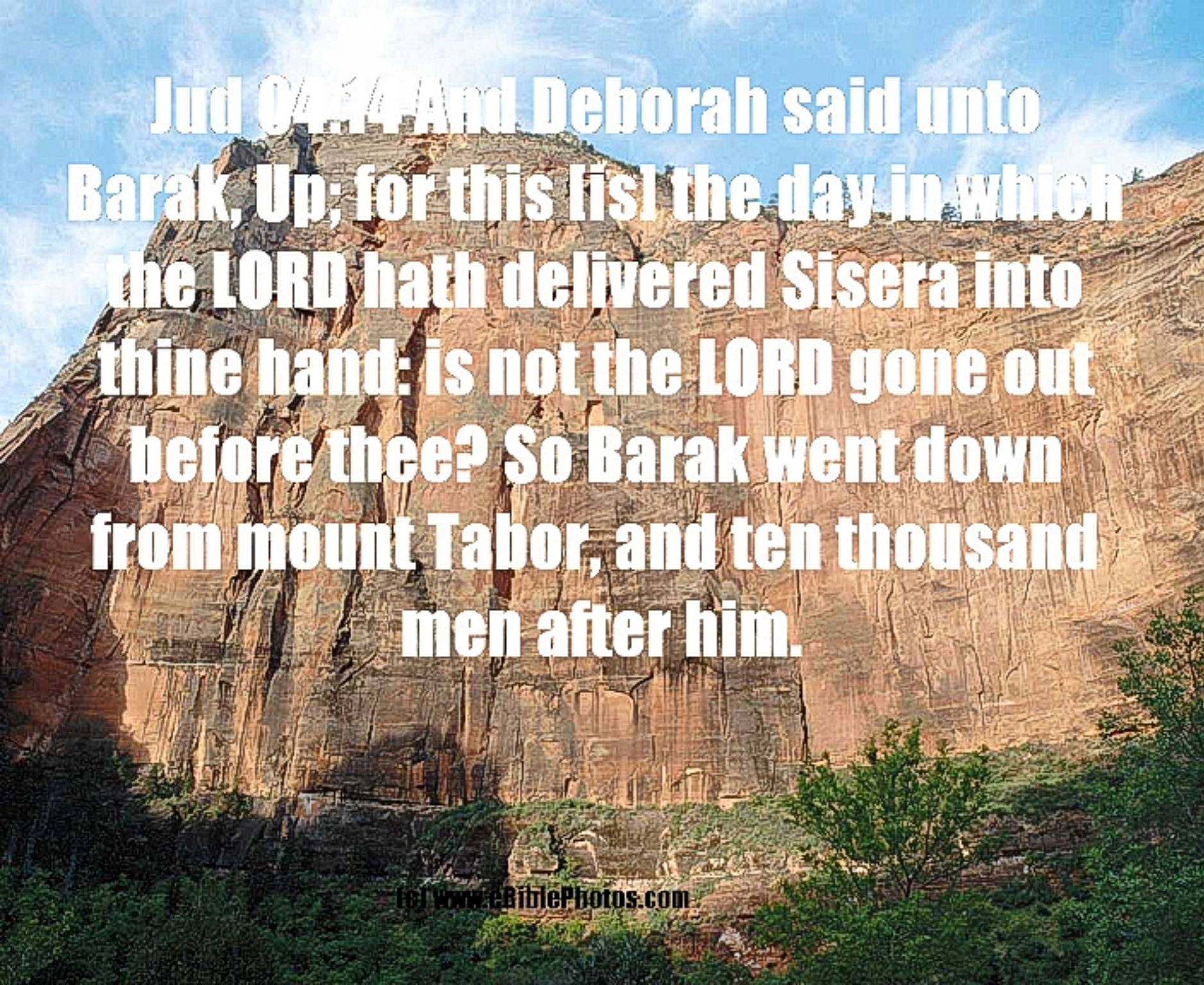
**Jud 04:04 And Deborah, a prophetess,

judgment.**

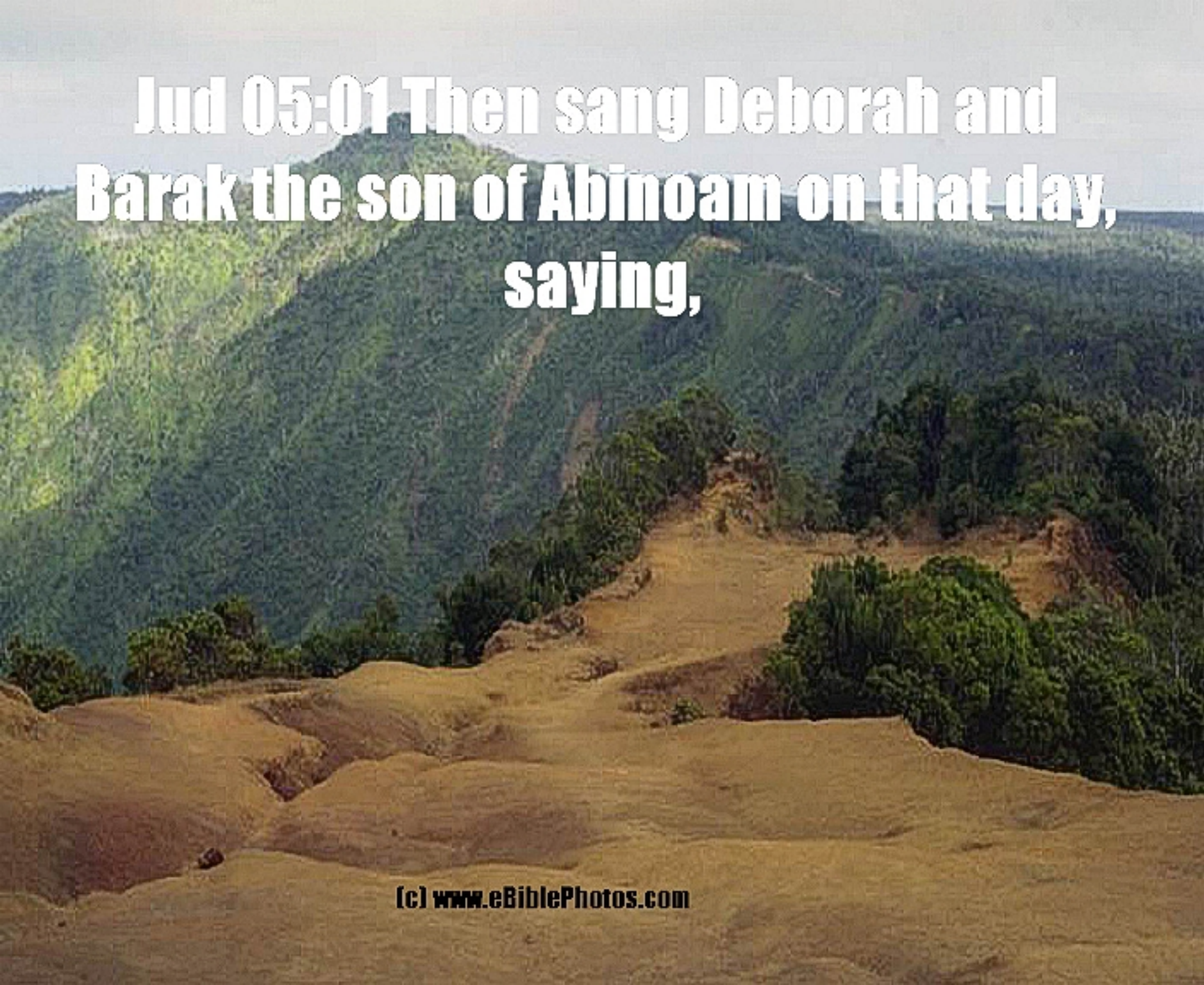
