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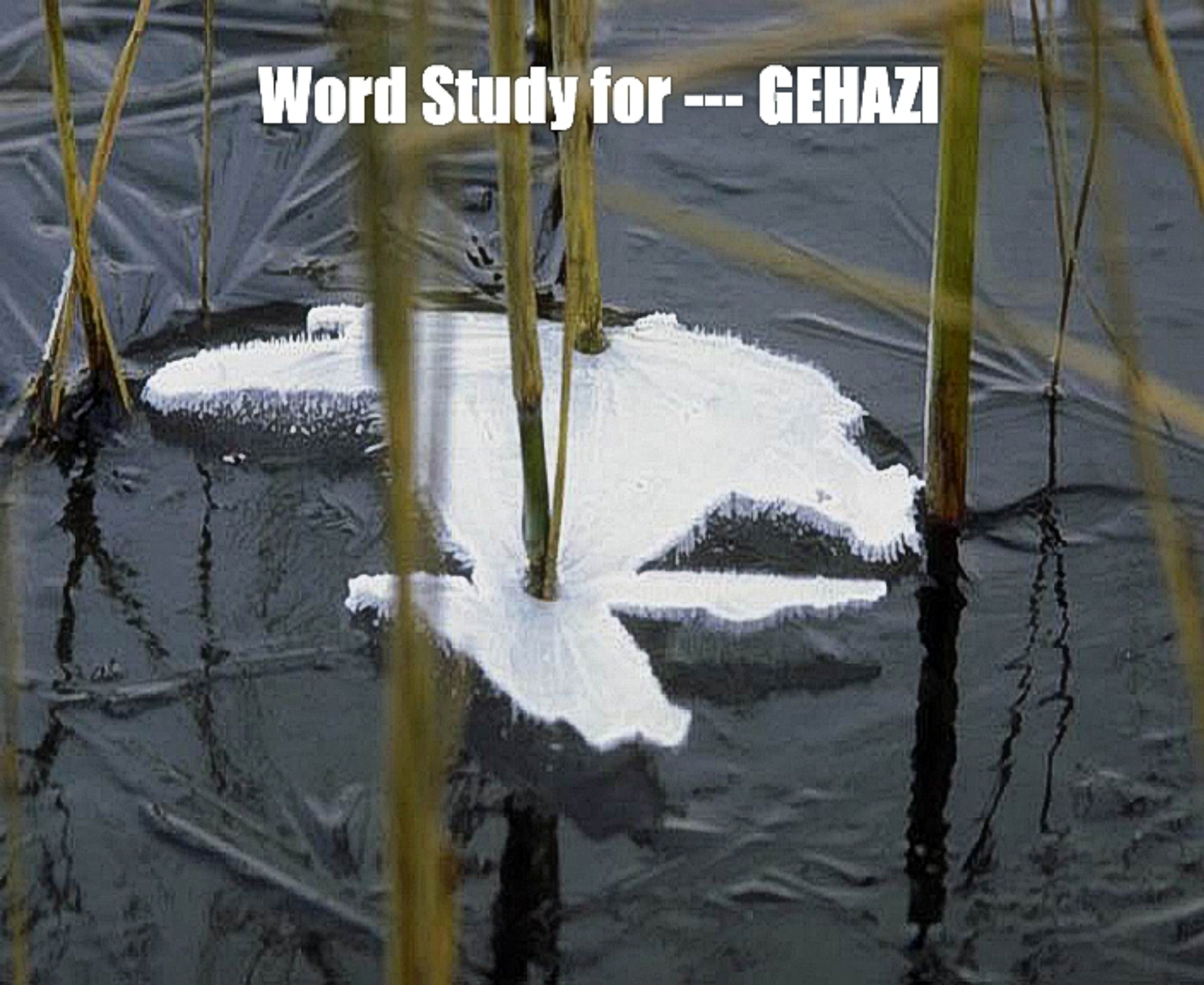
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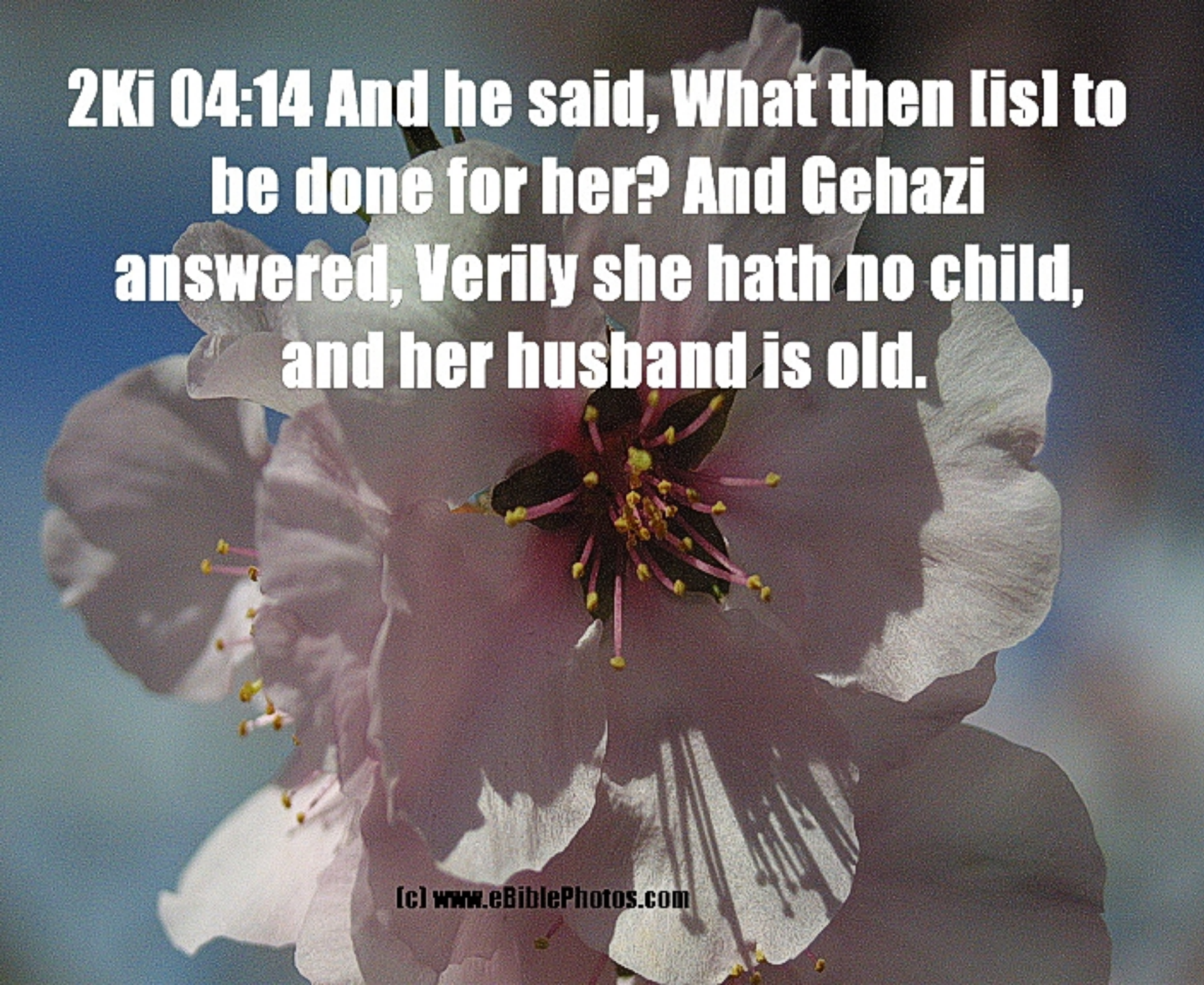

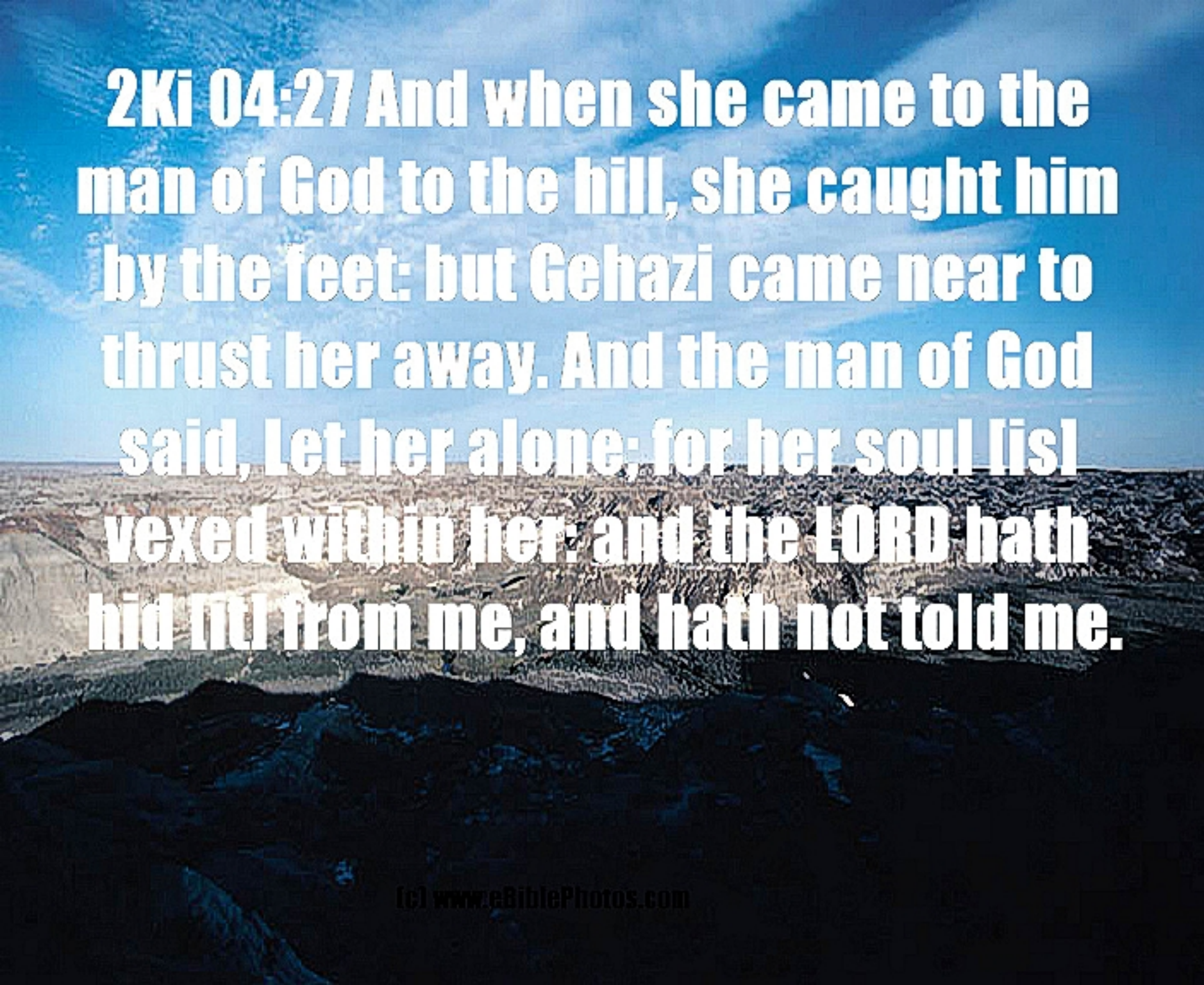


**2Ki 04:12 And he said to Gehazi his

before him.**



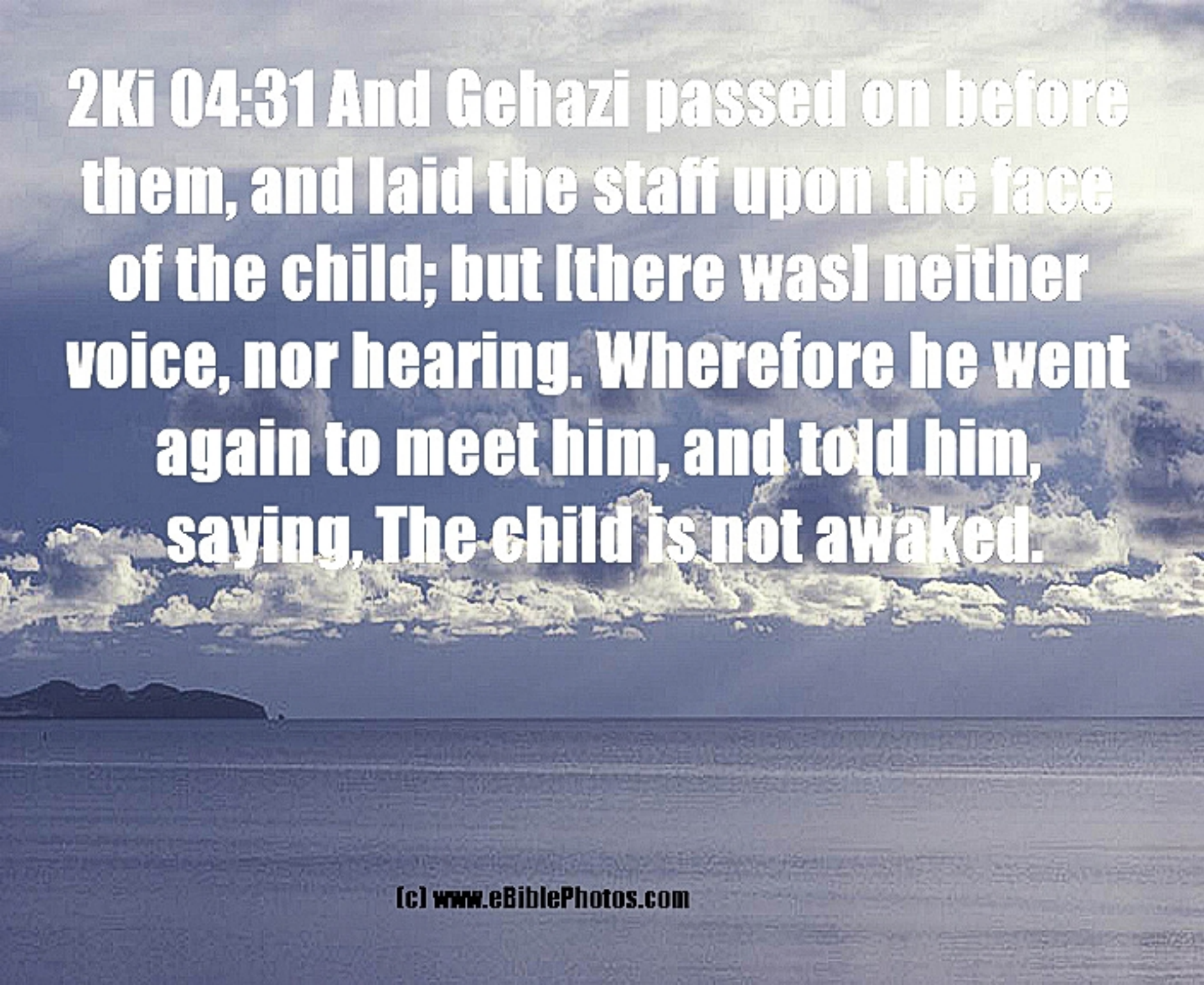
**2Ki 04:14 And he said, What then [is] to

Shunammite:**

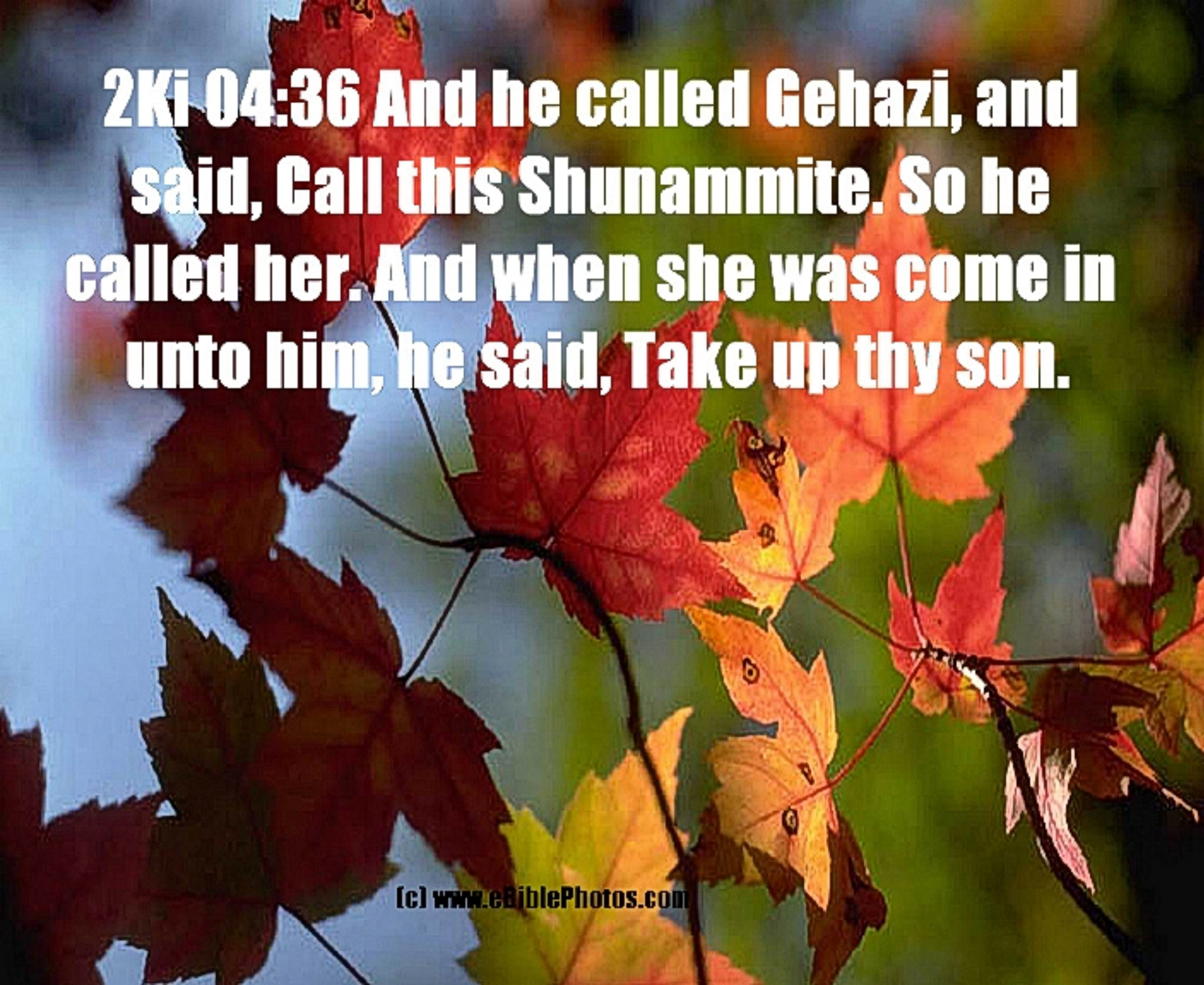

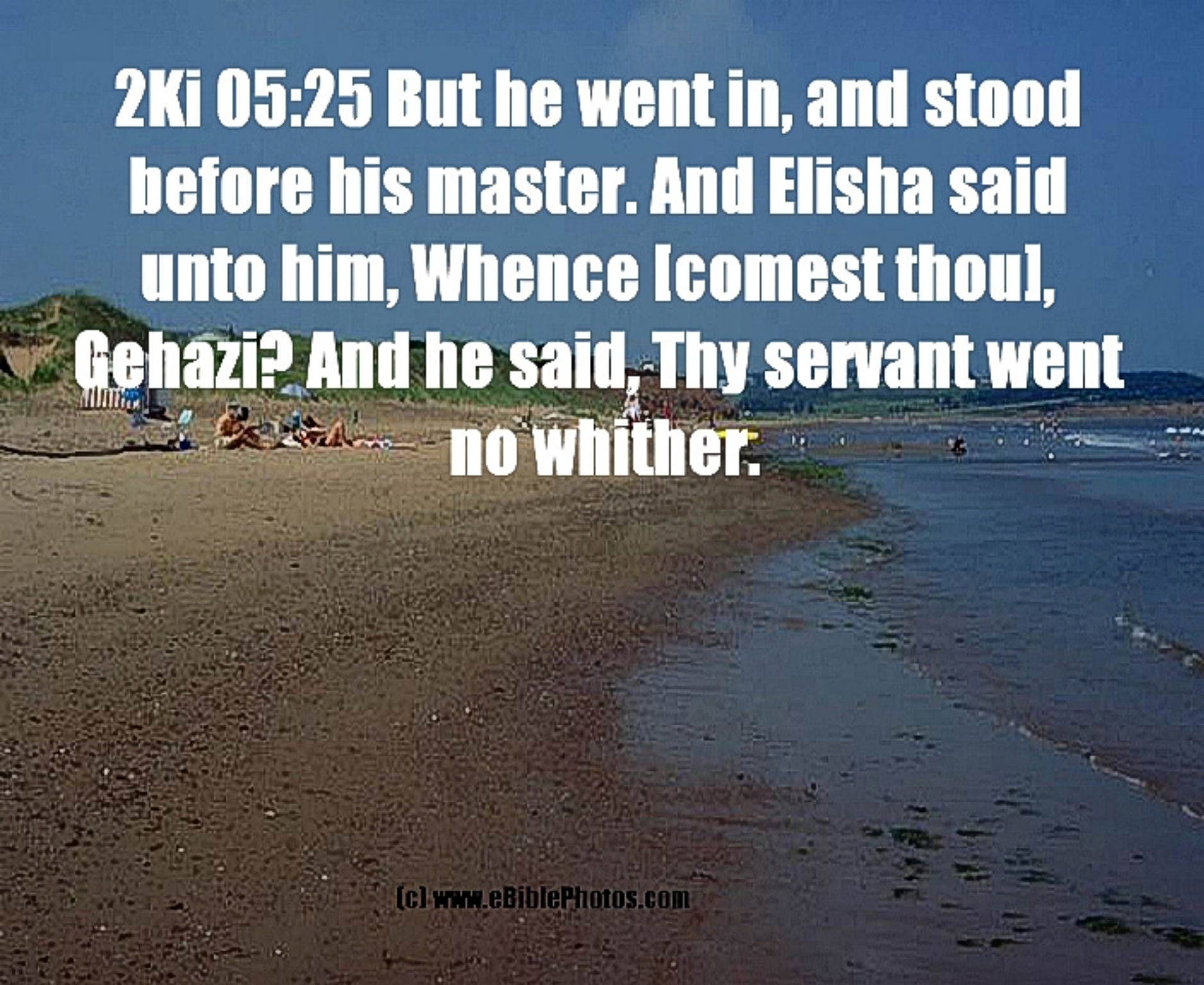
**2Ki 04:36 And he called Gehazi, and
