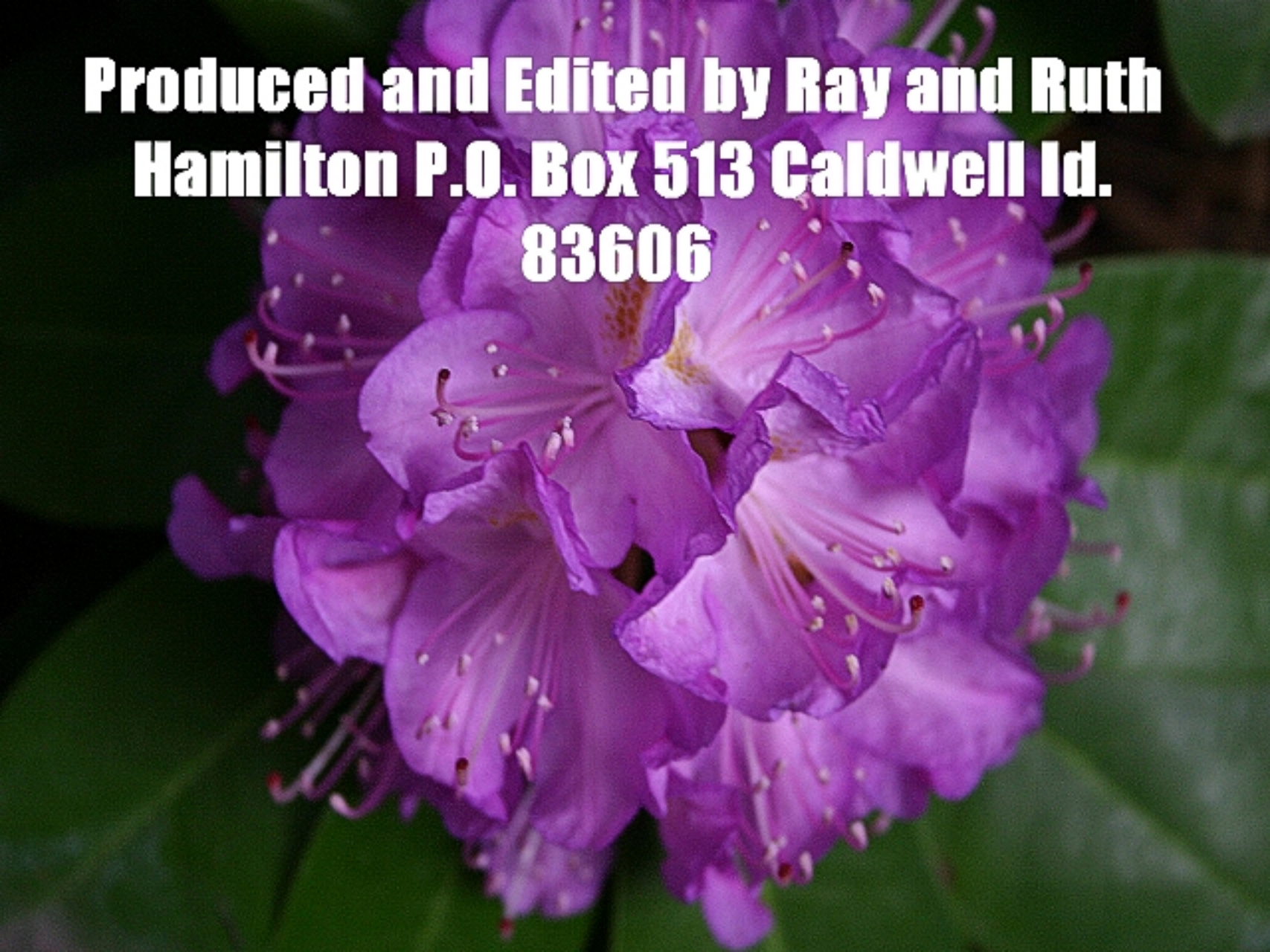

come before him.**

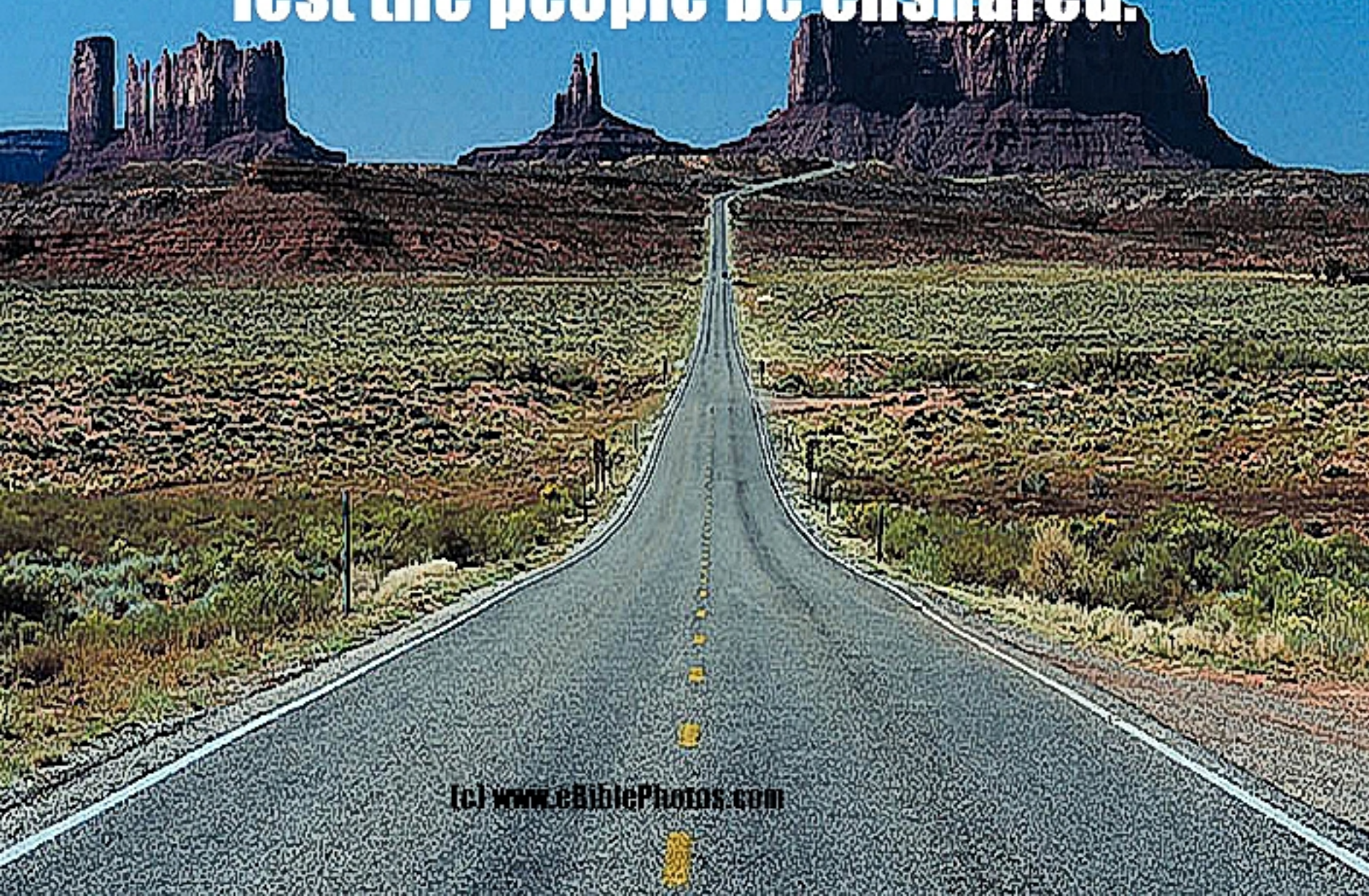
**Job 17:08 Upright [men] shall be

hypocrite.**

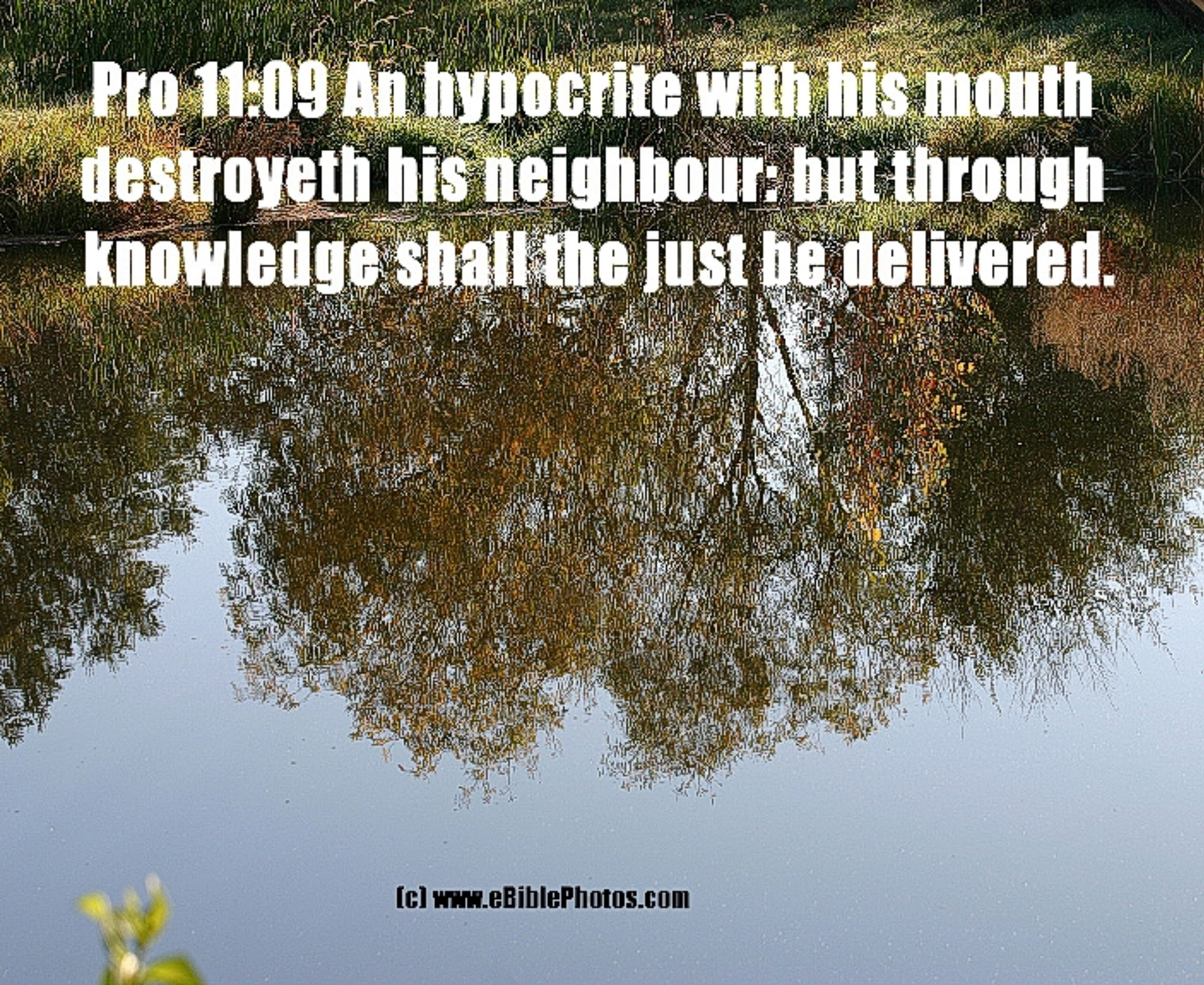
**Job 20:05 That the triumphing of the

hypocrite but for a moment?**



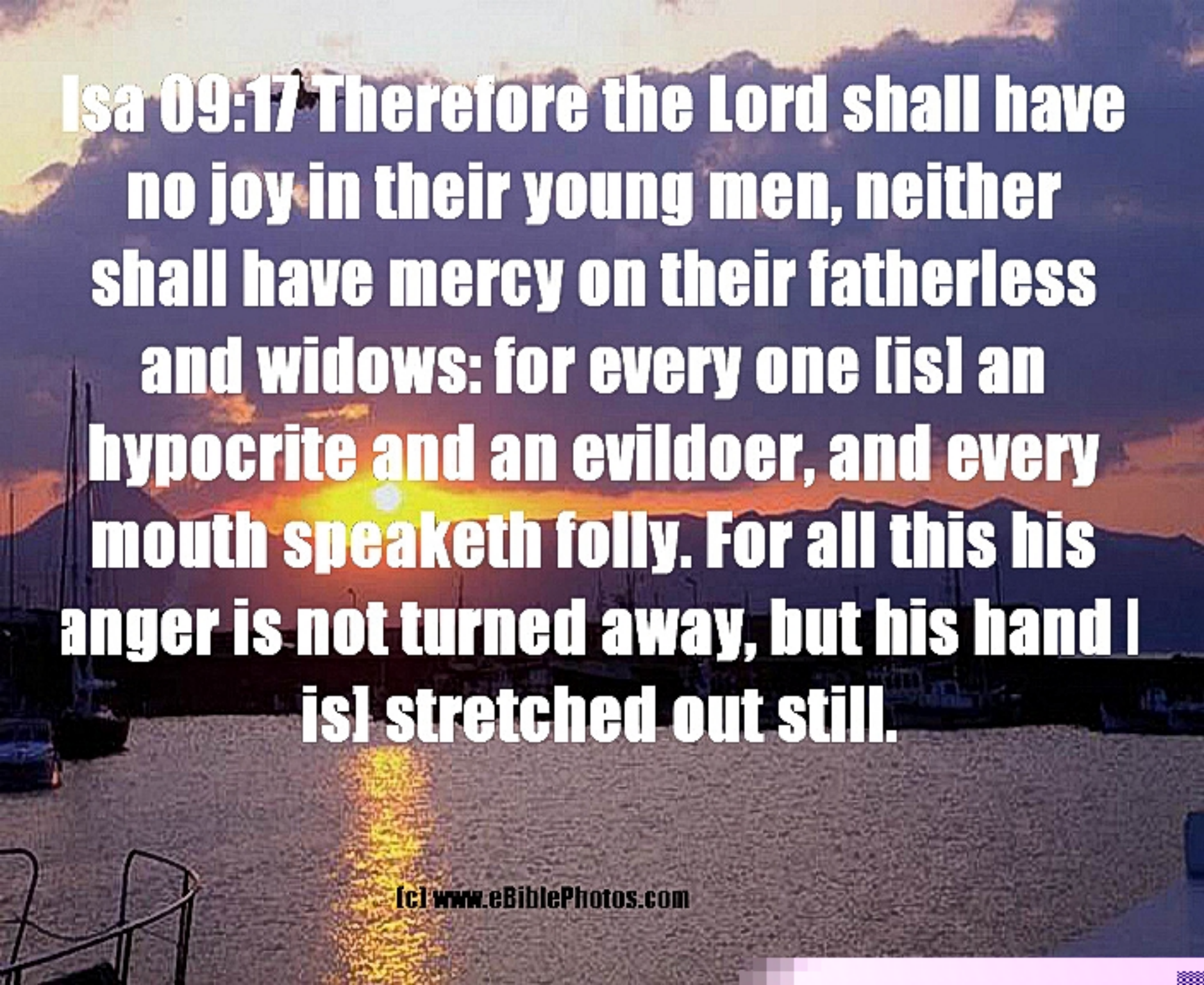
**Job 27:08 For what is the hope of the

lest the people be ensnared.**



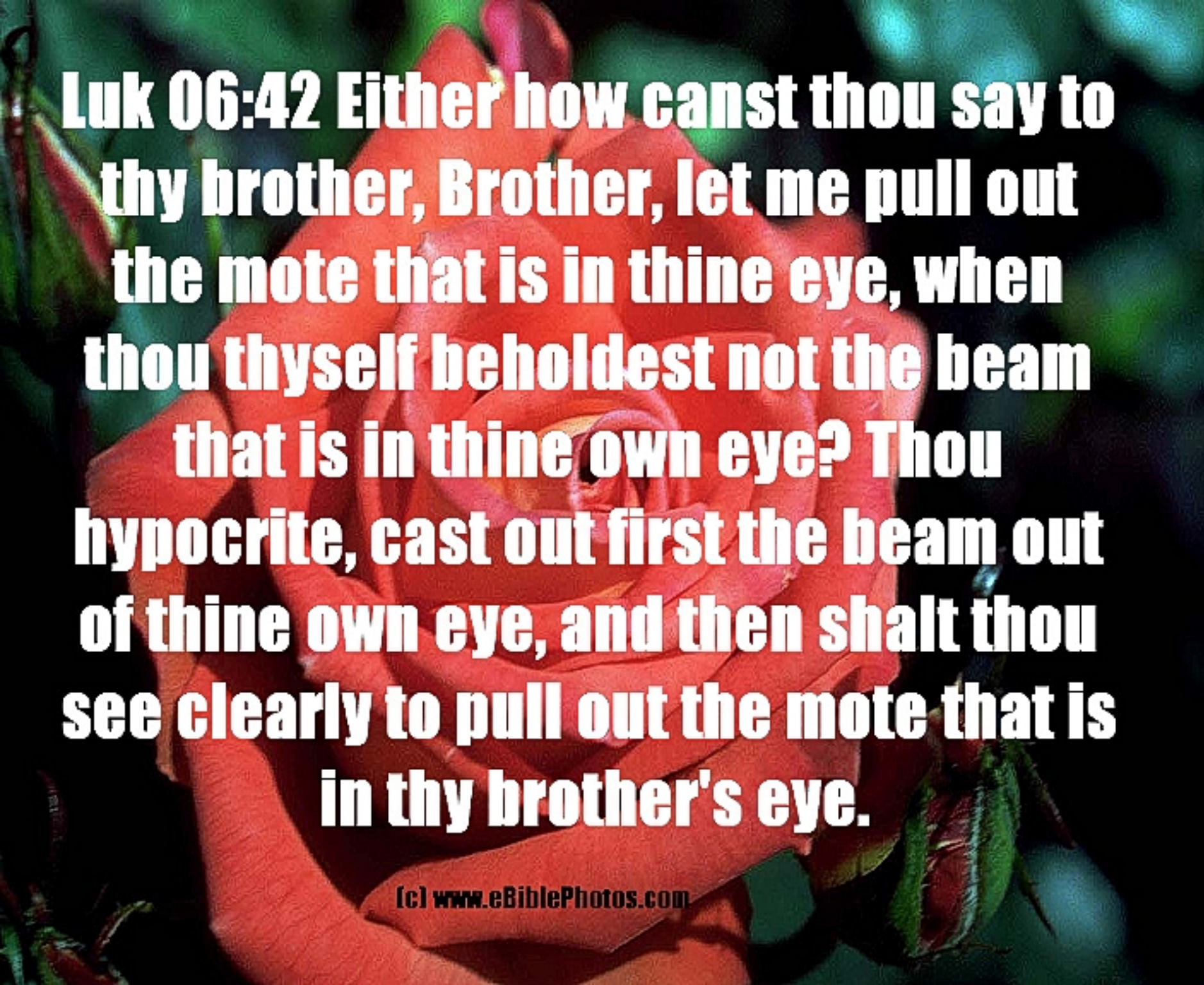
