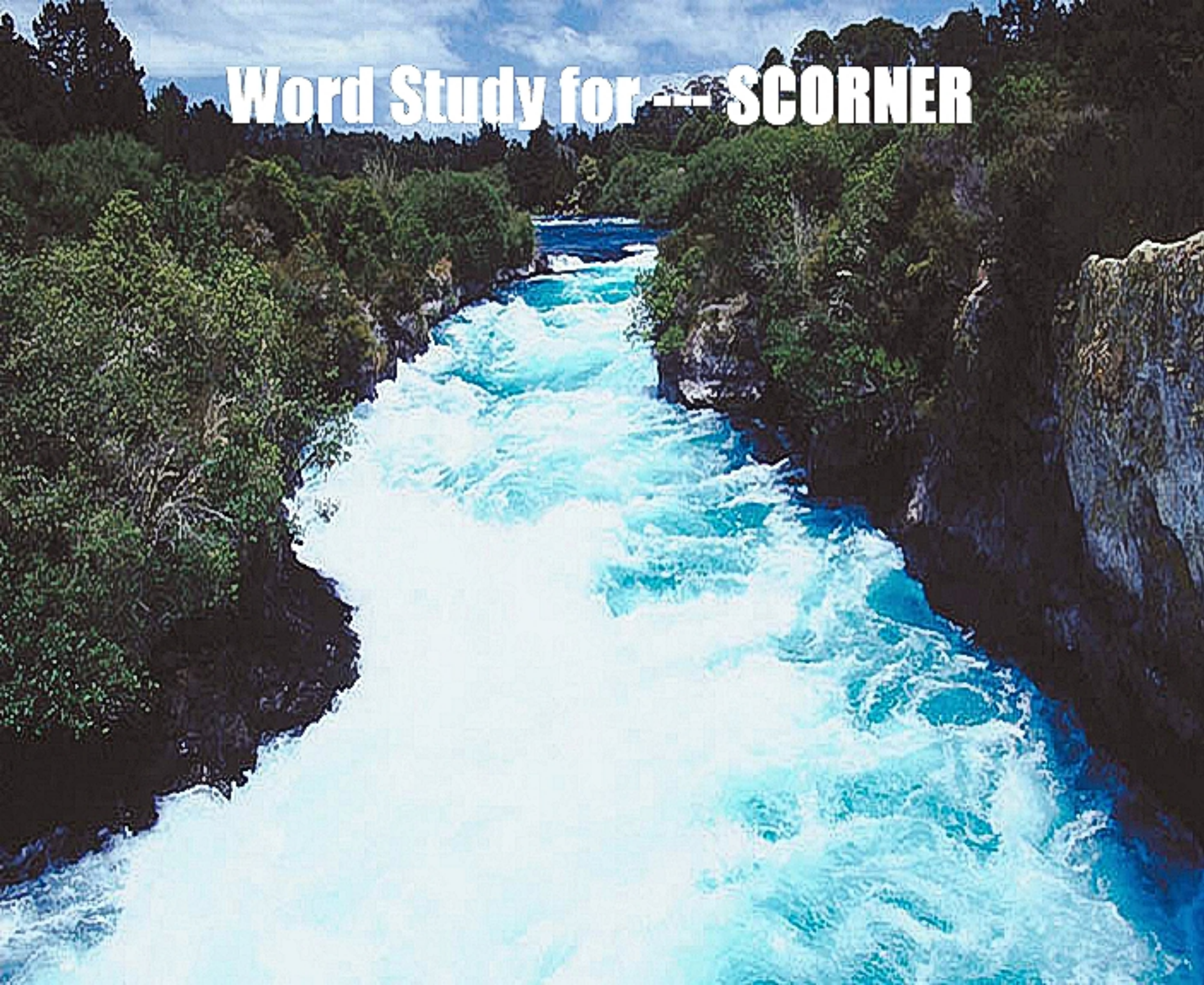

himself a blot.**

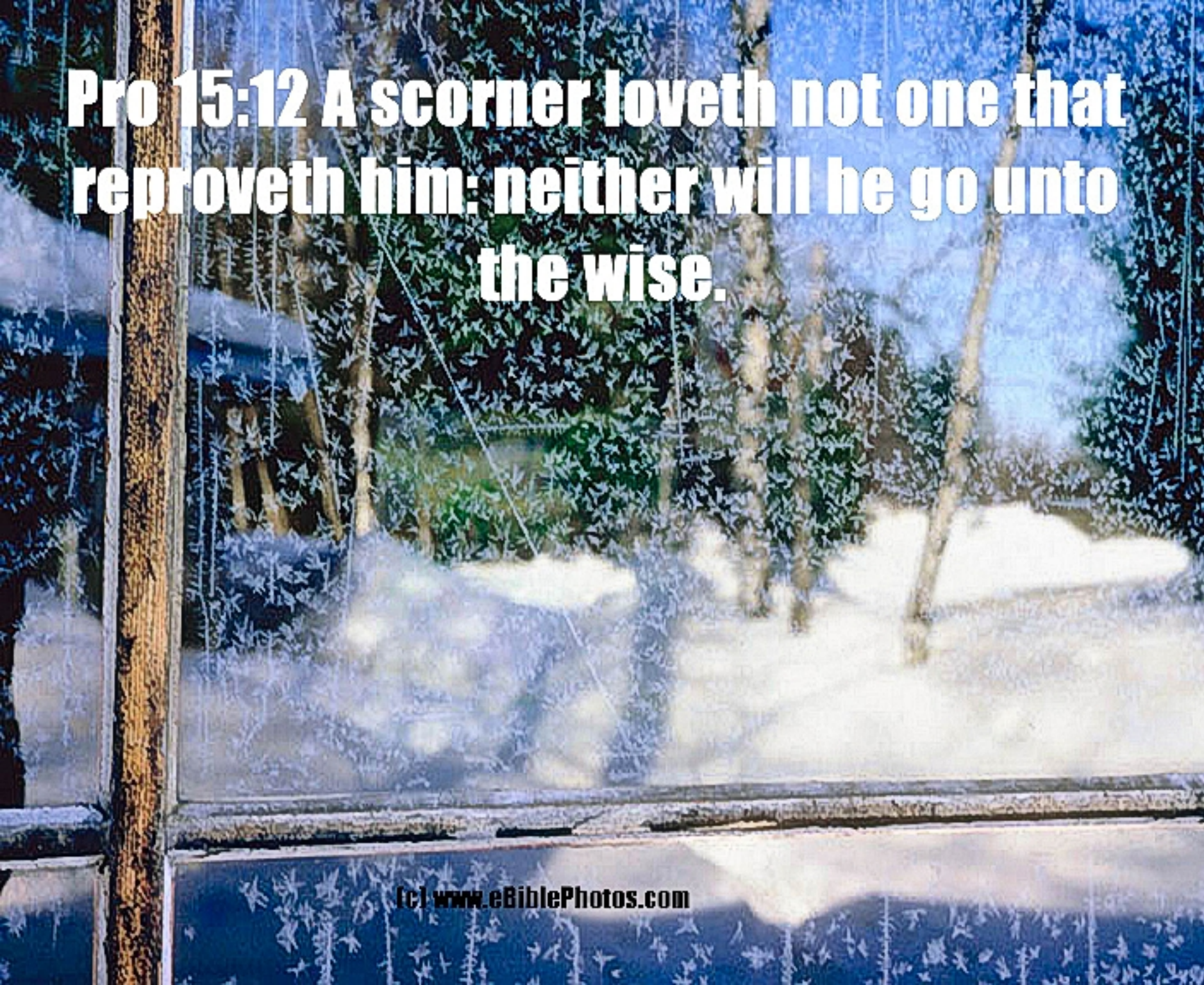


**Pro 09:08 Reprove not a scorner, lest

he will love thee.**

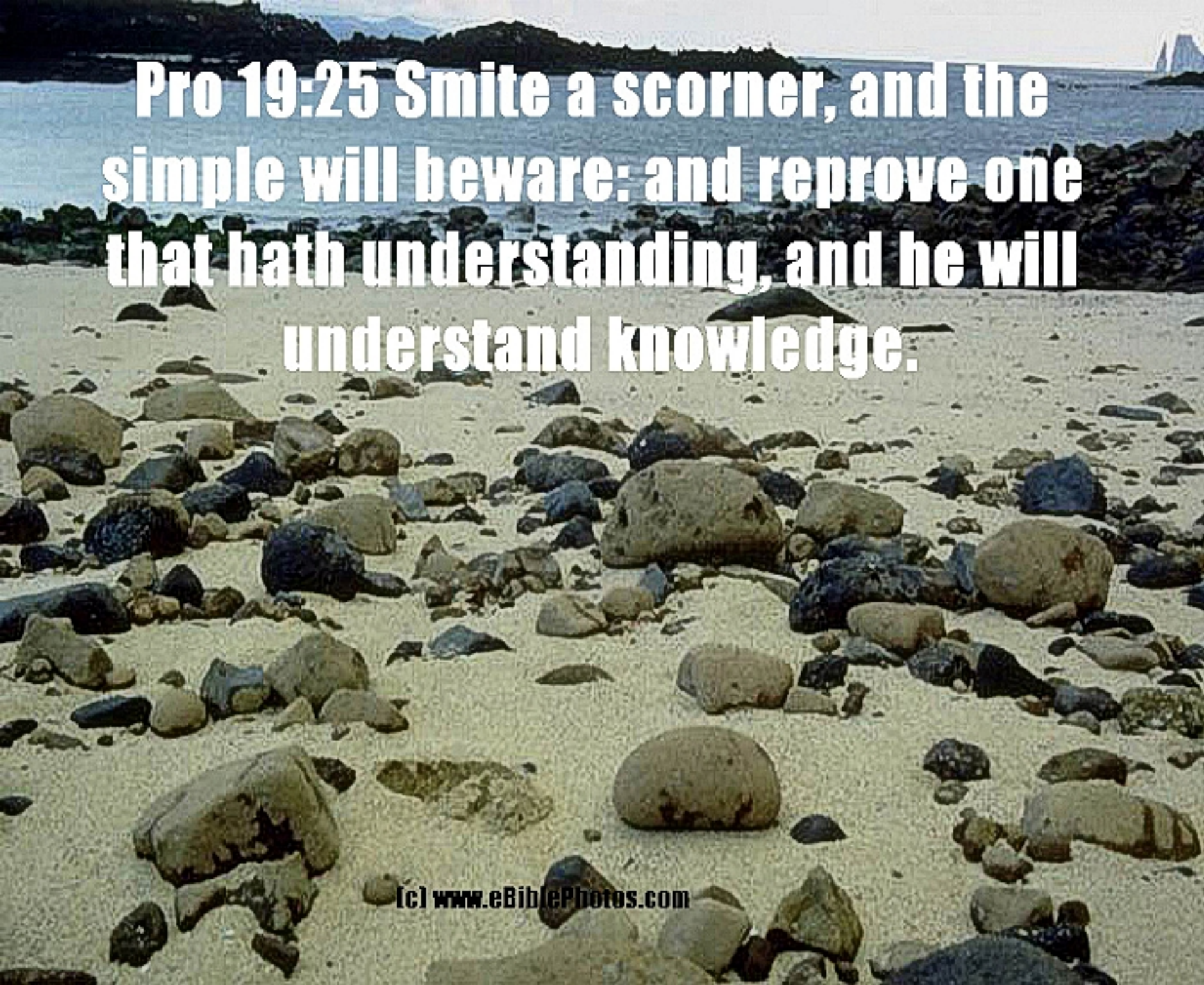


**Pro 13:01 A wise son [heareth] his

heareth not rebuke.**

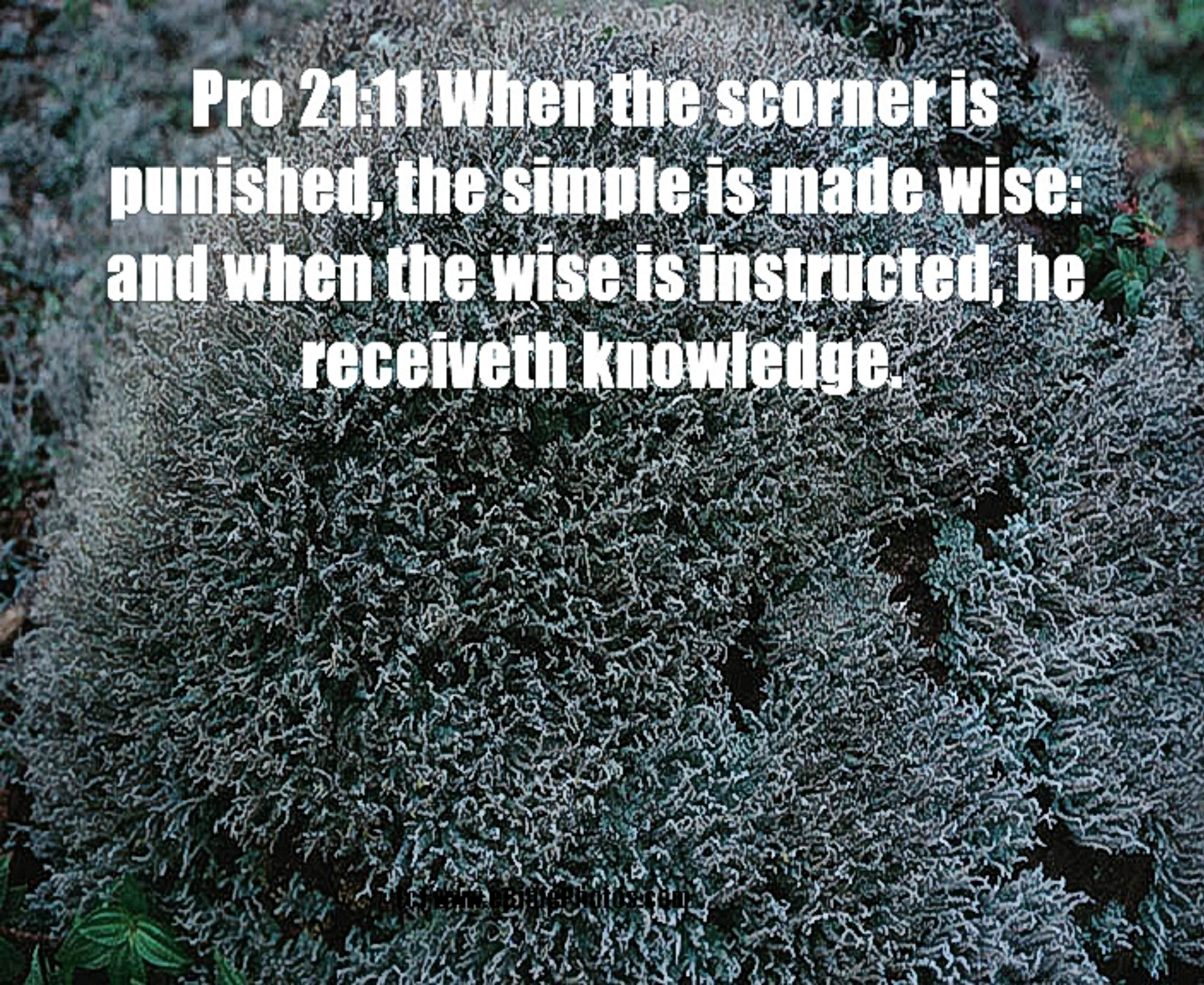
**Pro 14:06 A scorner seeketh wisdom,

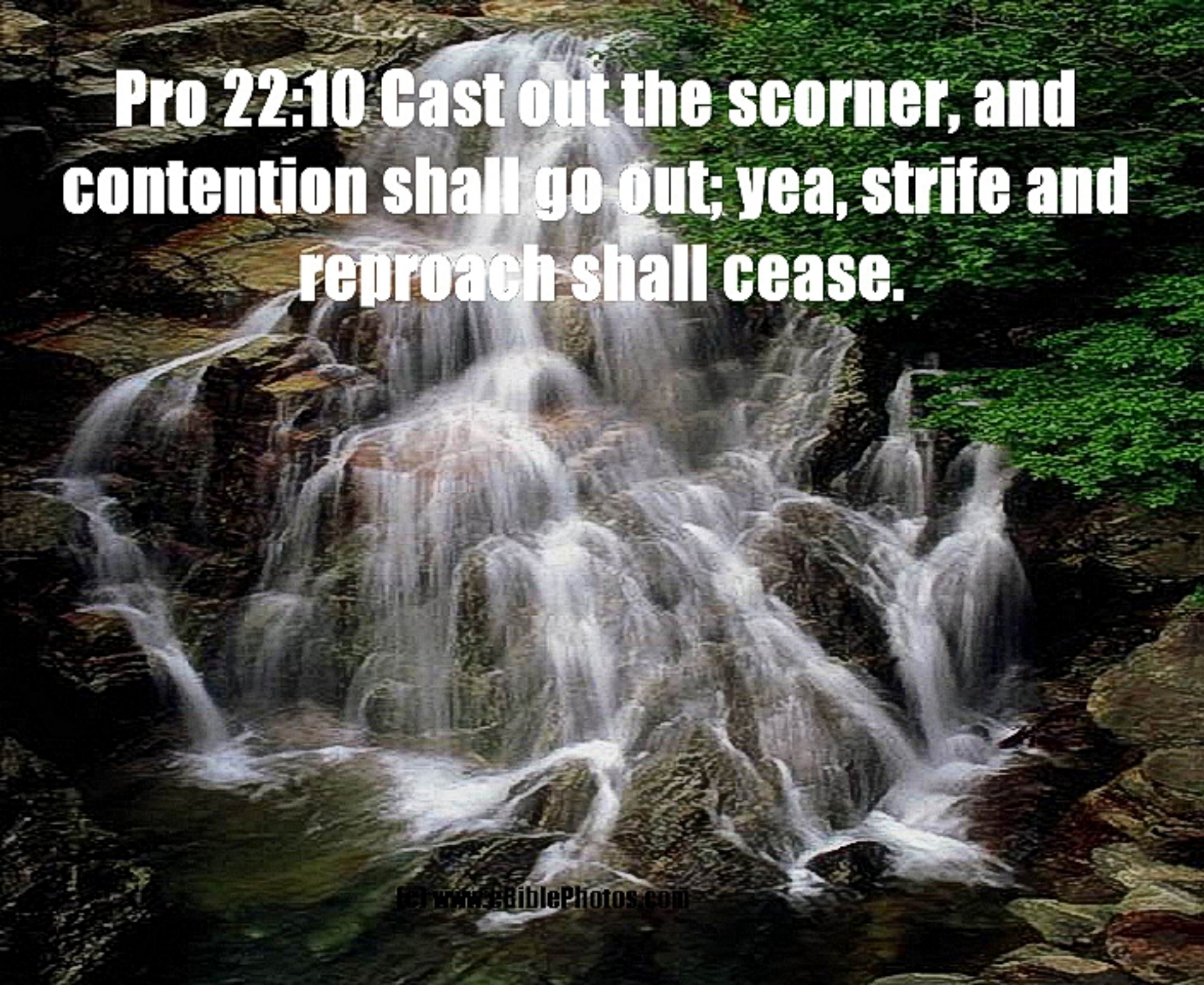
**Pro 19:25 Smite a scorner, and the
