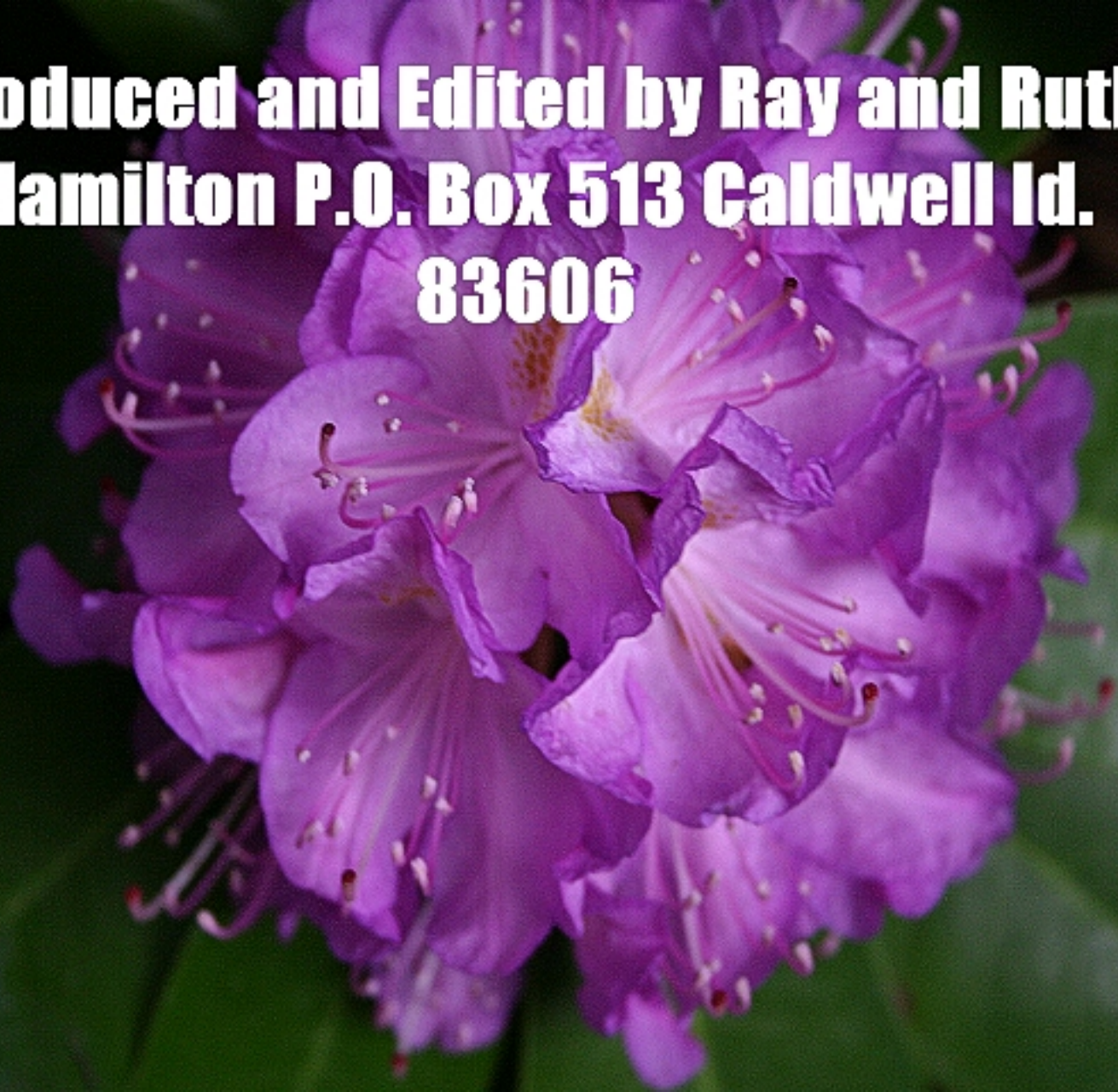


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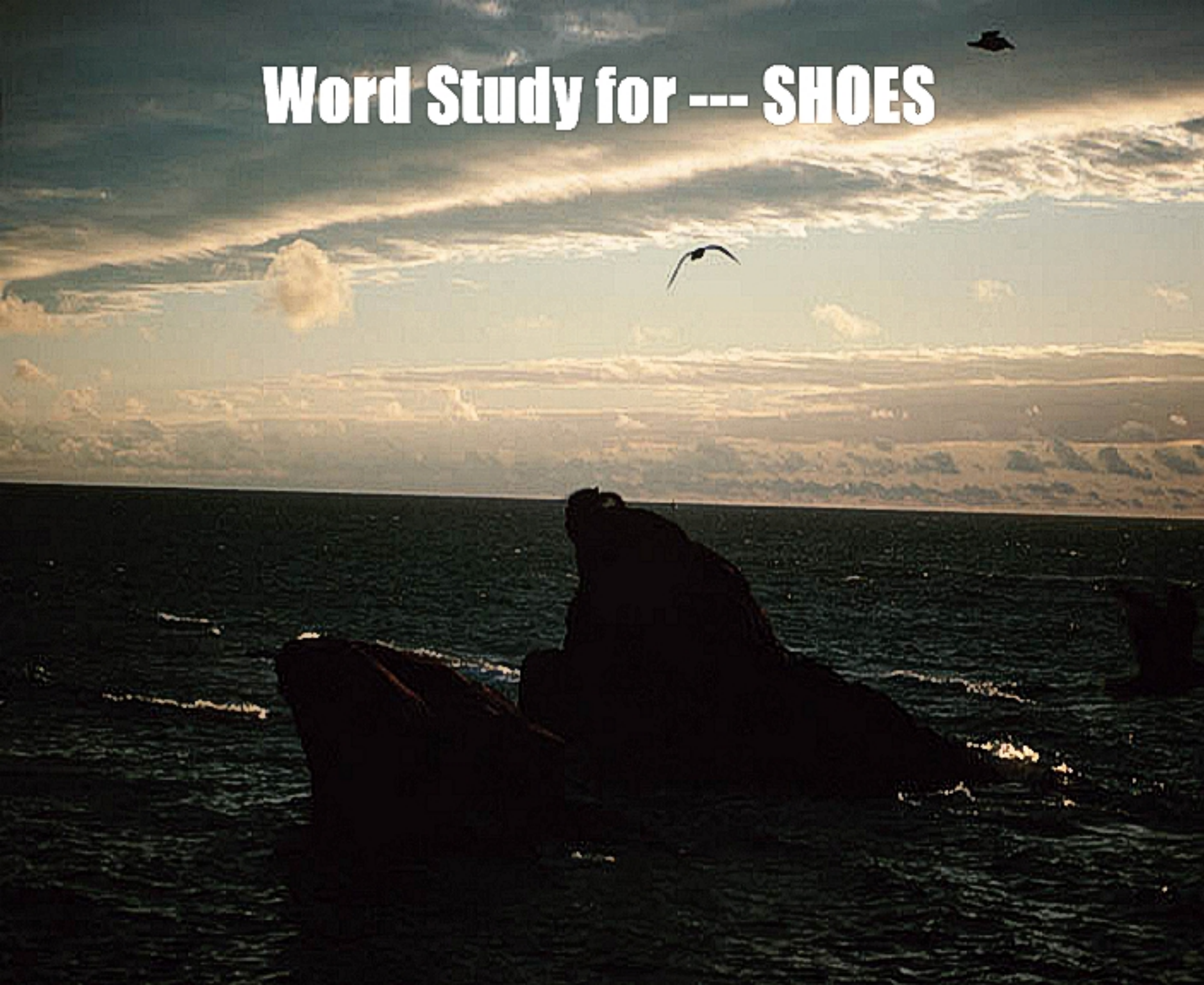
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Word Study for --- SHOES

provision was dry (and) mouldy.**

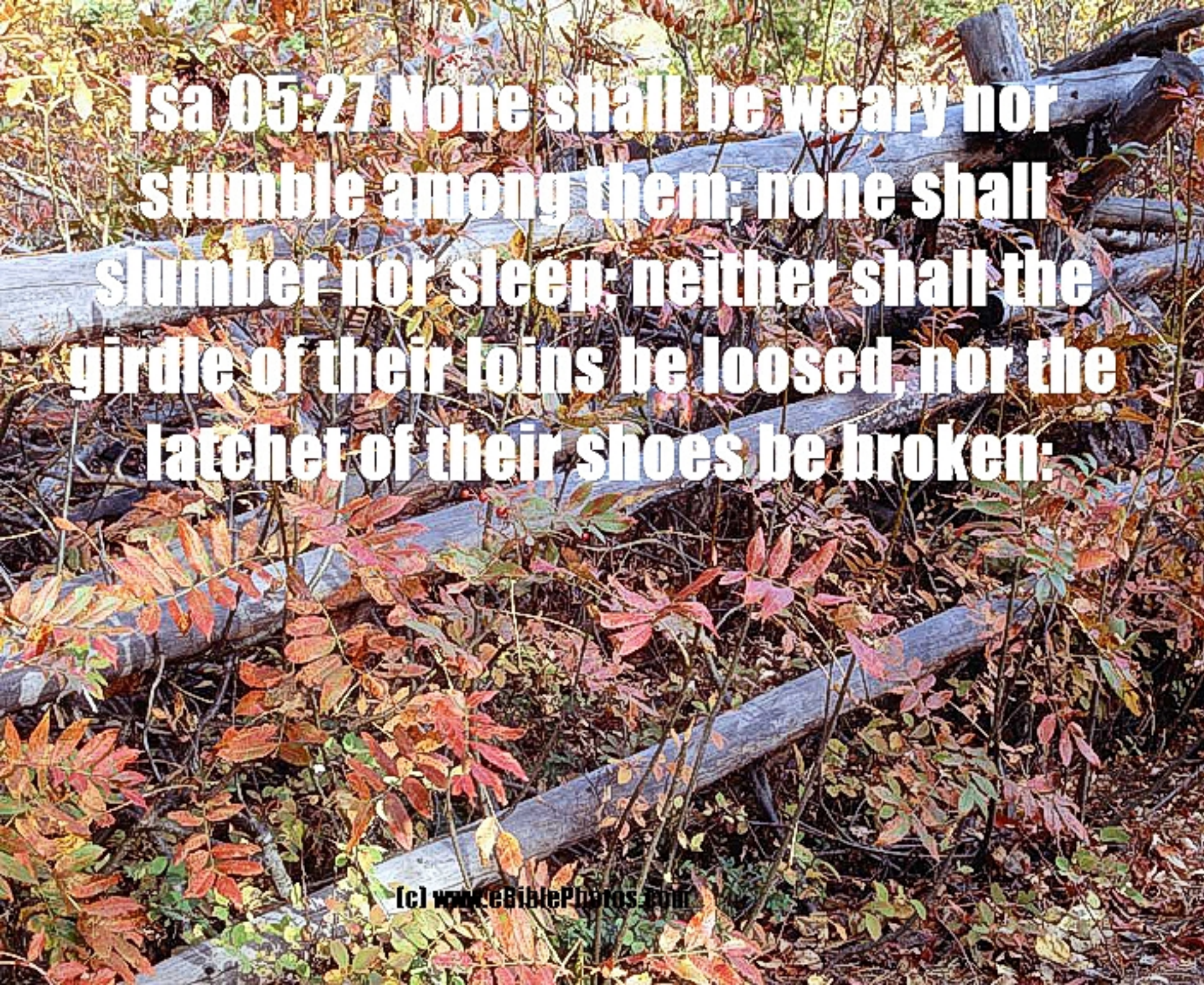


**Jos 09:13 And these bottles of wine,

old by reason of the very long journey.**

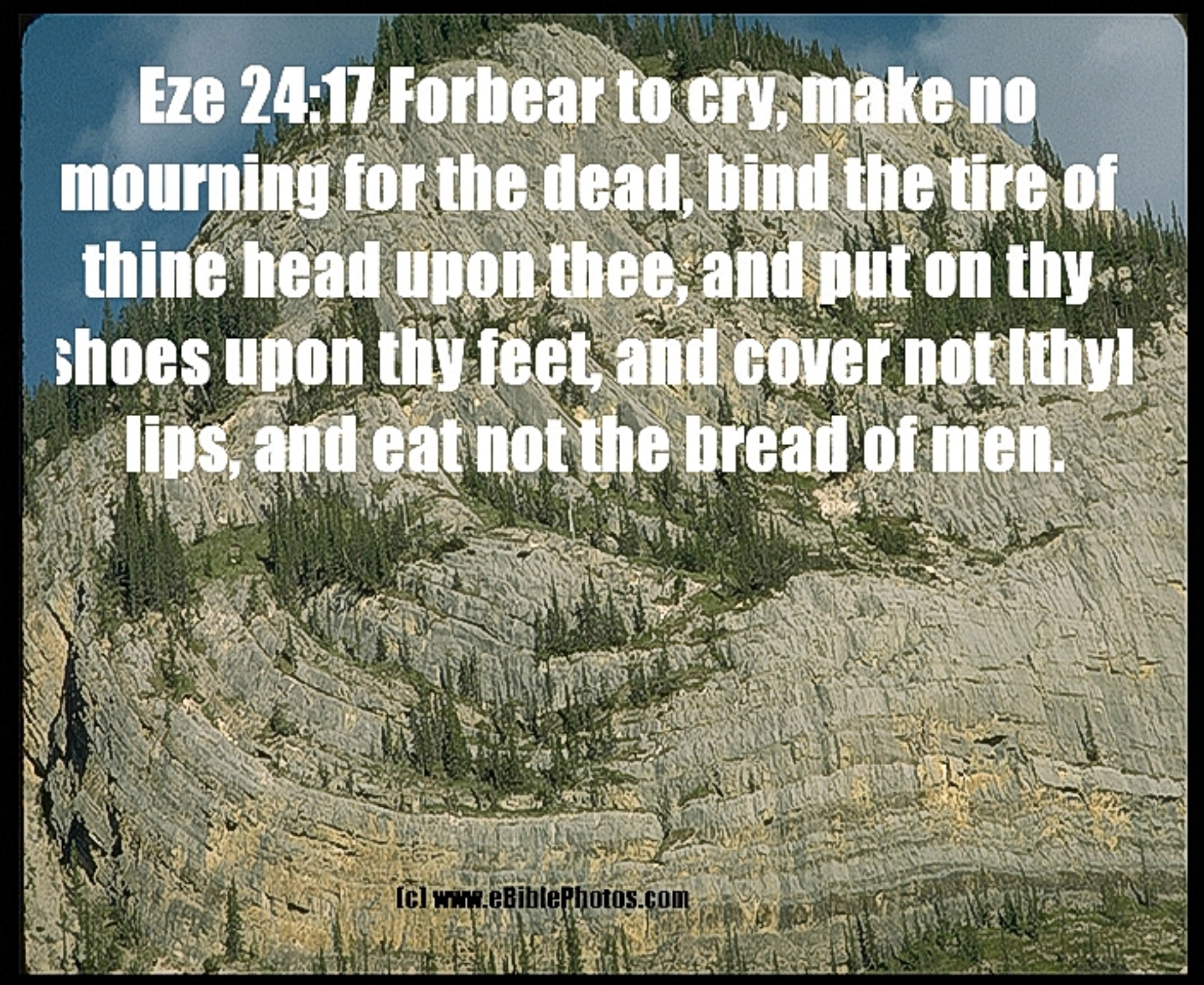
**1Ki 02:05 Moreover thou knowest also

of his meat.**

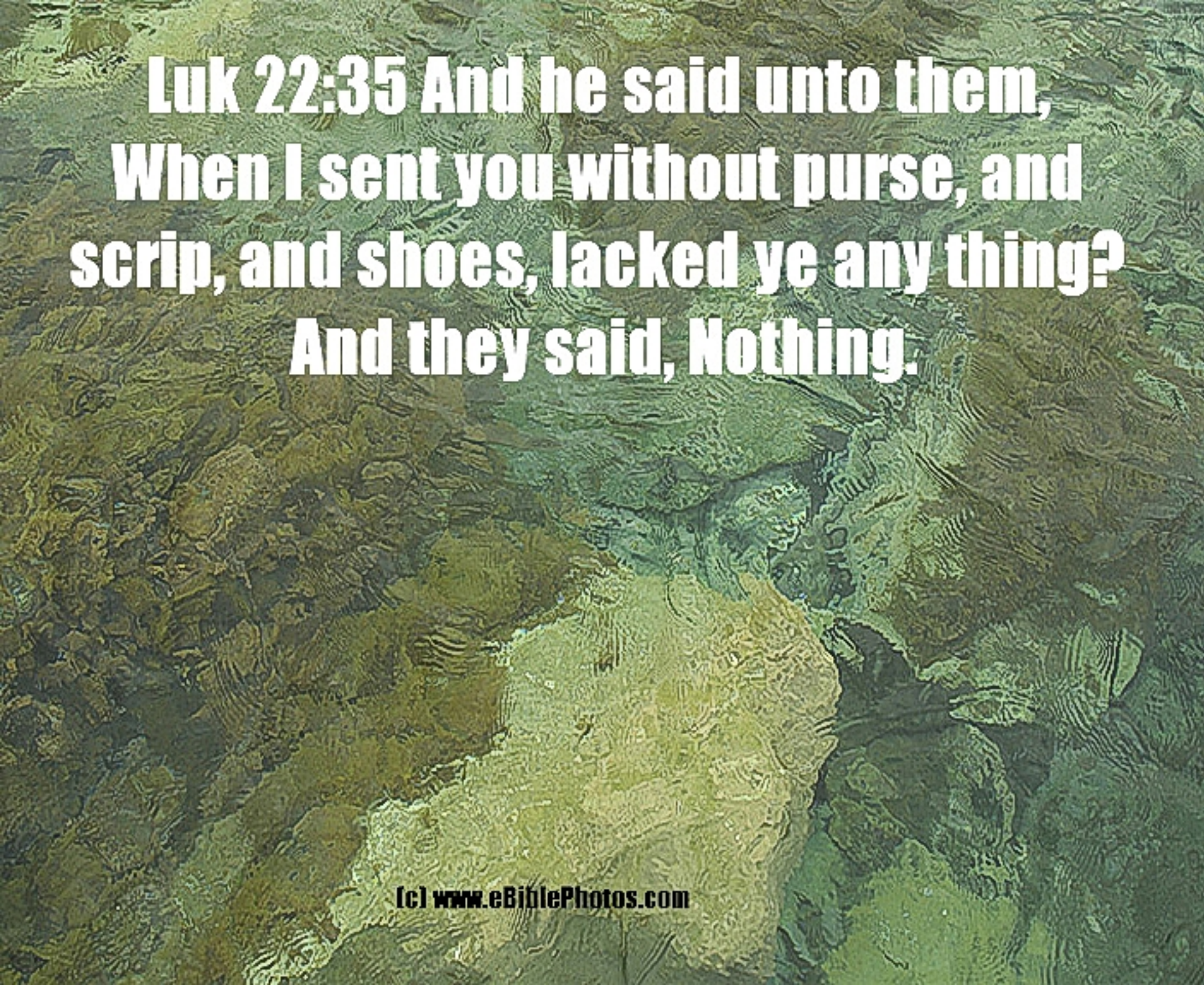
**Mar 01:07 And preached, saying, There
