19_PSA_55_01 [to the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, \[A Psalm\] of David, give ear to my prayer, O God; And hide not thyself from my supplication.](#)

19_PSA_55_02 [attend unto me, And hear me: I mourn in my complaint, And make A noise:](#)

19_PSA_55_03 [because of the voice of the enemy, because of the oppression of the wicked: for they cast iniquity upon me, And in wrath they hate me.](#)

19_PSA_55_04 [my heart Is sore pained within me: And the terrors of death are fallen upon me.](#)

19_PSA_55_05 [Fearfulness And trembling are come upon me, And Horror hath overwhelmed me.](#)

19_PSA_55_06 [And I said, Oh that I had wings like A dove! \[for Then\] would I fly away, And be at rest.](#)
