- 23\_ISA\_51\_01 [hearken to me, ye that follow after righteousness, ye that seek the LORD: Look unto the rock \[ whence\] ye are hewn, And to the hole of the pit \[ whence\] ye are digged, thanksgiving, And the voice of melody.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_02 [Look unto Abraham your Father, And unto Sarah \[ that\] bare you: for I called him alone, And blessed him, And increased him.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_03 [for the LORD shall comfort Zion; he will comfort all her waste places; And he will make her wilderness like Eden, And her desert like the garden of the LORD: joy And gladness shall be found therein, thanksgiving, And the voice of melody.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_04 [hearken unto me, my people; And give ear unto me, O my nation: for A law shall proceed from me, And I will make my judgment to rest for A light of the people.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_05 [my righteousness \[ Is\] near; my salvation Is gone forth, And mine arms shall judge the people; the isles shall wait upon me, And on mine arm shall they trust.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_06 [lift up your eyes to the heavens, And Look upon the earth beneath; for the heavens shall vanish away like smoke, And the earth shall wax old like A garment, And they that dwell therein shall die in like manner; but my salvation shall be for ever, And my righteousness shall not be abolished.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_07 [hearken unto me, ye that know righteousness, the people in whose heart \[ Is\] my law; Fear ye not the reproach of men, neither be ye afraid of their revilings.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_08 [for the moth shall eat them up like A garment, And the worm shall eat them like wool: but my righteousness shall be for ever, And my salvation from generation to generation.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_09 [Awake, Awake, put on strength, O arm of the LORD; Awake, as in the ancient days, in the generations of old, \[ art\] thou not it that hath cut Rahab, \[ And\] wounded the dragon?](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_10 [\[ art\] thou not it which hath dried the sea, the waters of the great deep; that hath made the depths of the sea A way for the ransomed to pass over?](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_11 [therefore the redeemed of the LORD shall Return, And come with singing unto Zion; And everlasting joy \[ shall be\] upon their head: they shall obtain gladness And joy; \[ And\] sorrow And mourning shall flee away.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_12 [I, \[ even\] I, \[ am\] he that comforteth you: who \[ art\] thou, that thou shouldst be afraid of A man \[ that\] shall die, And of the son of man \[ which\] shall be made \[ as\] grass;](#)

- 23\_ISA\_51\_14 [the captive exile hasteneth that he may be loosed, And that he should not die in the pit, nor that his bread should fail.](#)

- 23\_ISA\_51\_16 [And I have put my words in thy mouth, And I have covered thee in the shadow of mine hand, that I may plant the heavens, And lay the foundations of the earth, And say unto Zion, thou \[ art\] my people.](#)
- 23\_ISA\_51\_17 [Awake, Awake, stand up, O Jerusalem, which hast drunk at the hand of the LORD the cup of his fury; thou hast drunken the dregs of the cup of trembling, \[ And\] wrung \[ them\] out.](#)
