- 25\_LAM\_02\_01 [how hath the LORD covered the daughter of Zion with A cloud in his anger, \[ And\] cast down from heaven unto the earth the beauty of Israel, And remembered not his footstool in the day of his anger !](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_02 [the LORD hath swallowed up all the habitations of Jacob, And hath not pitied; he hath thrown down in his wrath the strong holds of the daughter of Judah; he hath brought \[ them\] down to the ground; he hath polluted the kingdom And the princes thereof.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_03 [he hath cut off in \[ his\] fierce anger all the horn of Israel; he hath drawn back his right hand from before the enemy, And he burned against Jacob like A flaming fire, \[ which\] devoureth round about.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_04 [he hath bent his bow like an enemy; he stood with his right hand as an adversary, And slew all \[ that were\] pleasant to the eye in the tabernacle of the daughter of Zion; he poured out his fury like fire.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_05 [the LORD was as an enemy; he hath swallowed up Israel, he hath swallowed up all her palaces; he hath destroyed his strong holds, And hath increased in the daughter of Judah mourning And lamentation.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_06 [And he hath violently taken away his tabernacle, as \[ if it were of\] A garden; he hath destroyed his places of the assembly; the LORD hath caused the solemn feasts And sabbaths to be forgotten in Zion, And hath despised in the indignation of his anger the king And the priest.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_07 [the LORD hath cast off his altar, he hath abhorred his sanctuary, he hath given up into the hand of the enemy the walls of her palaces; they have made A noise in the house of the LORD, as in the day of A solemn feast.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_08 [the LORD hath purposed to destroy the wall of the daughter of Zion; he hath stretched out A line, he hath not withdrawn his hand from destroying; therefore he made the rampart And the wall to lament; they languished together.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_09 [her gates are sunk into the ground; he hath destroyed And broken her bars; her king And her princes \[ are\] among the Gentiles; the law \[ Is\] no \[ more\]; her prophets also find no vision from the LORD.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_10 [the elders of the daughter of Zion sit upon the ground, \[ And\] keep silence; they have cast up dust upon their heads; they have girded themselves with sackcloth; the virgins of Jerusalem hang down their heads to the ground.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_11 [mine eyes do fail with tears, my bowels are troubled, my liver Is poured upon the earth, for the destruction of the daughter of my people; because the children And the sucklings swoon in the streets of the city.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_12 [they say to their mothers, where \[ Is\] corn And wine? when they swooned as the wounded in the streets of the city, when their soul was poured out into their mothers' bosom.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_13 [what thing shall I take to witness for thee? what thing shall I liken to thee, O daughter of Jerusalem? what shall I equal to thee, that I may comfort thee, O virgin daughter of Zion? for thy Breach \[ Is\] great like the sea; who can heal thee?](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_14 [thy prophets have seen vain And foolish things for thee; And they have not discovered thine iniquity, to turn away thy captivity; but have seen for thee false burdens And causes of banishment.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_15 [all that pass by clap \[ their\] hands at thee; they hiss And wag their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, \[ saying, Is\] this the city that \[ men\] call the perfection of beauty, the joy of the whole earth?](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_16 [all thine enemies have opened their mouth against thee; they hiss And gnash the teeth; they say, we have swallowed \[ her\] up; certainly this \[ Is\] the day that we looked for; we have found, we have seen \[ it\].](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_17 [the LORD hath done \[ that\] which he had devised; he hath fulfilled his word that he had commanded in the days of old; he hath thrown down, And hath not pitied; And he hath caused \[ thine\] enemy to Reioice over thee, he hath set up the horn of thine adversaries.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_18 [their heart cried unto the LORD, O wall of the daughter of Zion, let tears run down like A river day And night; give thyself no rest; let not the apple of thine eye cease.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_19 [Arise, cry out in the night; in the beginning of the watches Pour out thine heart like water before the face of the LORD; lift up thy hands toward him for the life of thy young children, that faint for hunger in the top of every street.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_20 [behold, O LORD, And consider to whom thou hast done this, shall the women eat their fruit, \[ And\] children of A span long? shall the priest And the prophet be slain in the sanctuary of the LORD?](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_21 [the young And the old Lie on the ground in the streets; my virgins And my young men are fallen by the sword; thou hast slain \[ them\] in the day of thine anger; thou hast killed, \[ And\] not pitied.](#)
- 25\_LAM\_02\_22 [thou hast called as in A solemn day my terrors round about, So that in the day of the LORD's anger none escaped nor remained; those that I have swaddled And brought up hath mine enemy consumed.](#)
