[28\\_HOS\\_13\\_03 therefore they shall be as the morning cloud, And as the early dew that passeth away, as the chaff \[ that\] Is driven with the whirlwind out of the floor, And as the smoke out of the chimney.](#)

[28\\_HOS\\_13\\_06 according to their pasture, So were they filled; they were filled, And their heart was exalted; therefore have they forgotten me.](#)

[28\\_HOS\\_13\\_11 I gave thee A king in mine anger, And took \[ him\] away in my wrath.](#)

[28\\_HOS\\_13\\_12 the iniquity of Ephraim \[ Is\] bound up; his sin \[ Is\] hid.](#)

[28\\_HOS\\_13\\_13 the sorrows of A travailing woman shall come upon him: he \[ Is\] an unwise son; for he should not stay long in \[ the place of\] the breaking forth of children.](#)

[28\\_HOS\\_13\\_14 I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death: O death, I will be thy plagues; O grave, I will be thy destruction: repentance shall be hid from mine eyes.](#)

[28\\_HOS\\_13\\_15 though he be fruitful among \[ his\] brethren, an east wind shall come, the wind of the LORD shall come up from the wilderness, And his spring shall become dry, And his fountain shall be dried up: he shall spoil the treasure of all pleasant vessels.](#)
