clap the hands [34 NAH 03 19](#) # [There is] no healing of thy bruise; thy wound is grievous: all that hear the bruit of thee shall clap the hands over thee: for upon whom hath not thy wickedness passed continually?

clap their hands [23 ISA 55 12](#) # For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap [their] hands.

clap their hands [18 JOB 27 23](#) # [Men] shall clap their hands at him, and shall hiss him out of his place.

clap their hands [25 LAM 02 15](#) # All that pass by clap [their] hands at thee; they hiss and wag their head at the daughter of Jerusalem, [saying, Is] this the city that [men] call The perfection of beauty, The joy of the whole earth?
