**conceal a thing [20 PRO 25 02](#) # [It is] the glory of God to conceal a thing: but the honour of kings [is] to search out a matter.**

**conceal him [05 DEU 13 08](#) # Thou shalt not consent unto him, nor hearken unto him; neither shall thine eye pity him, neither shalt thou spare, neither shalt thou conceal him:**

**conceal his blood [01 GEN 37 26](#) # And Judah said unto his brethren, What profit [is it] if we slay our brother, and conceal his blood?**

**conceal his parts [18 JOB 41 12](#) # I will not conceal his parts, nor his power, nor his comely proportion.**

**conceal not say [24 JER 50 02](#) # Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, [and] conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces.**

**conceal [18 JOB 27 11](#) # I will teach you by the hand of God: [that] which [is] with the Almighty will I not conceal.**

**concealed the words [18 JOB 06 10](#) # Then should I yet have comfort; yea, I would harden myself in sorrow: let him not spare; for I have not concealed the words of the Holy One.**

**concealed thy lovingkindness [19 PSA 40 10](#) # I have not hid thy righteousness within my heart; I have declared thy faithfulness and thy salvation: I have not concealed thy lovingkindness and thy truth from the great congregation.**

**concealeth knowledge but [20 PRO 12 23](#) # A prudent man concealeth knowledge: but the heart of fools proclaimeth foolishness.**

**concealeth the matter [20 PRO 11 13](#) # A talebearer revealeth secrets: but he that is of a faithful spirit concealeth the matter.**
