devout Greeks a [44 ACT 17 04](#) # And some of them believed, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few.

devout man according [44 ACT 22 12](#) # And one Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good report of all the Jews which dwelt [there],

devout man and [44 ACT 10 02](#) # [A] devout [man], and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God alway.
