dress for the [10 2SA 12 04](#) # And there came a traveller unto the rich man, and he spared to take of his own flock and of his own herd, to dress for the wayfaring man that was come unto him; but took the poor man's lamb, and dressed it for the man that was come to him.

dress him meat [10 2SA 13 07](#) # Then David sent home to Tamar, saying, Go now to thy brother Amnon's house, and dress him meat.

dress it and [01 GEN 02 15](#) # And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to keep it.

dress it first [11 1KI 18 25](#) # And Elijah said unto the prophets of Baal, Choose you one bullock for yourselves, and dress [it] first; for ye [are] many; and call on the name of your gods, but put no fire [under].

dress it for [11 1KI 17 12](#) # And she said, [As] the LORD thy God liveth, I have not a cake, but an handful of meal in a barrel, and a little oil in a cruse: and, behold, I [am] gathering two sticks, that I may go in and dress it for me and my son, that we may eat it, and die.

dress it [01 GEN 18 07](#) # And Abraham ran unto the herd, and fetched a calf tender and good, and gave [it] unto a young man; and he hastened to dress it.

dress the meat [10 2SA 13 05](#) # And Jonadab said unto him, Lay thee down on thy bed, and make thyself sick: and when thy father cometh to see thee, say unto him, I pray thee, let my sister Tamar come, and give me meat, and dress the meat in my sight, that I may see [it], and eat [it] at her hand.

dresser of his [42 LUK 13 07](#) # Then said he unto the dresser of his vineyard, Behold, these three years I come seeking fruit on this fig tree, and find none: cut it down; why cumbereth it the ground?

dressers in the [14 2CH 26 10](#) # Also he built towers in the desert, and digged many wells: for he had much cattle, both in the low country, and in the plains: husbandmen [also], and vine dressers in the mountains, and in Carmel: for he loved husbandry.

dresseth the lamps [02 EXO 30 07](#) # And Aaron shall burn thereon sweet incense every morning: when he dresseth the lamps, he shall burn incense upon it.

undressed for it [03 LEV 25 05](#) # That which groweth of its own accord of thy harvest thou shalt not reap, neither gather the grapes of thy vine undressed: [for] it is a year of rest unto the land.

undressed [03 LEV 25 11](#) # A jubilee shall that fiftieth year be unto you: ye shall not sow, neither reap that which groweth of itself in it, nor gather [the grapes] in it of thy vine undressed.

vinedressers and husbandmen [12 2KI 25 12](#) # But the captain of the guard left of the poor of the land [to be] vinedressers and husbandmen.

vinedressers for the [29 JOE 01 11](#) # Be ye ashamed, O ye husbandmen; howl, O ye vinedressers, for the wheat and for the barley; because the harvest of the field is perished.

vinedressers [23 ISA 61 05](#) # And strangers shall stand and feed your flocks, and the sons of the alien [shall be] your plowmen and your vinedressers.
