blossom abundantly and [23 ISA 35 02](#) # It shall blossom abundantly, and rejoice even with joy and singing: the glory of Lebanon shall be given unto it, the excellency of Carmel and Sharon, they shall see the glory of the LORD, [and] the excellency of our God.

blossom and bud [23 ISA 27 06](#) # He shall cause them that come of Jacob to take root: Israel shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit.

blossom and I [04 NUM 17 05](#) # And it shall come to pass, [that] the man's rod, whom I shall choose, shall blossom: and I will make to cease from me the murmurings of the children of Israel, whereby they murmur against you.

blossom as the [23 ISA 35 01](#) # The wilderness and the solitary place shall be glad for them; and the desert shall rejoice, and blossom as the rose.
