offence and seek [28 HOS 05 15](#) # I will go [and] return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

offence and whosoever [45 ROM 09 33](#) # As it is written, Behold, I lay in Sion a stumblingstone and rock of offence: and whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed.

offence cometh [40 MAT 18 07](#) # Woe unto the world because of offences! for it must needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!

offence death reigned [45 ROM 05 17](#) # For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.]

offence even to [60 1PE 02 08](#) # And a stone of stumbling, and a rock of offence, [even to them] which stumble at the word, being disobedient: whereunto also they were appointed.

offence in abasing [47 2CO 11 07](#) # Have I committed an offence in abasing myself that ye might be exalted, because I have preached to you the gospel of God freely?

offence in any [47 2CO 06 03](#) # Giving no offence in any thing, that the ministry be not blamed:

offence might abound [45 ROM 05 20](#) # Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:

offence neither to [46 1CO 10 32](#) # Give none offence, neither to the Jews, nor to the Gentiles, nor to the church of God:

offence of heart [09 ISA 25 31](#) # That this shall be no grief unto thee, nor offence of heart unto my lord, either that thou hast shed blood causeless, or that my lord hath avenged himself: but when the LORD shall have dealt well with my lord, then remember thine handmaid.

offence of one [45 ROM 05 15](#) # But not as the offence, so also [is] the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, [which is] by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.

offence of one [45 ROM 05 18](#) # Therefore as by the offence of one [judgment came] upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one [the free gift came] upon all men unto justification of life.

offence of the [48 GAL 05 11](#) # And I, brethren, if I yet preach circumcision, why do I yet suffer persecution? then is the offence of the cross ceased.

offence so also [45 ROM 05 15](#) # But not as the offence, so also [is] the free gift. For if through the offence of one many be dead, much more the grace of God, and the gift by grace, [which is] by one man, Jesus Christ, hath abounded unto many.

offence till the [50 PHP 01 10](#) # That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;

offence to both [23 ISA 08 14](#) # And he shall be for a sanctuary; but for a stone of stumbling and for a rock of offence to both the houses of Israel, for a gin and for a snare to the inhabitants of Jerusalem.

offence toward God [44 ACT 24 16](#) # And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offence toward God, and [toward] men.

offence unto me [40 MAT 16 23](#) # But he turned, and said unto Peter, Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me: for thou savourest not the things that be of God, but those that be of men.

offence [45 ROM 14 20](#) # For meat destroy not the work of God. All things indeed [are] pure; but [it is] evil for that man who eateth with offence.

offences and was [45 ROM 04 25](#) # Who was delivered for our offences, and was raised again for our justification.

offences come but [40 MAT 18 07](#) # Woe unto the world because of offences! for it must needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!

offences contrary to [45 ROM 16 17](#) # Now I beseech you, brethren, mark them which cause divisions and offences contrary to the doctrine which ye have learned; and avoid them.

offences for it [40 MAT 18 07](#) # Woe unto the world because of offences! for it must needs be that offences come; but woe to that man by whom the offence cometh!

offences unto justification [45 ROM 05 16](#) # And not as [it was] by one that sinned, [so is] the gift: for the judgment [was] by one to condemnation, but the free gift [is] of many offences unto justification.

offences will come [42 LUK 17 01](#) # Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences will come: but woe [unto him], through whom they come!

offences [21 ECC 10 04](#) # If the spirit of the ruler rise up against thee, leave not thy place; for yielding pacifieth great offences.
