pardon all their [24 JER 33 08](#) # And I will cleanse them from all their iniquity, whereby they have sinned against me; and I will pardon all their iniquities, whereby they have sinned, and whereby they have transgressed against me.

pardon every one [14 2CH 30 18](#) # For a multitude of the people, [even] many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, The good LORD pardon every one

pardon gracious and [16 NEH 09 17](#) # And refused to obey, neither were mindful of thy wonders that thou didst among them; but hardened their necks, and in their rebellion appointed a captain to return to their bondage: but thou [art] a God ready to pardon, gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and of great kindness, and forsookest them not.

Pardon I beseech [04 NUM 14 19](#) # Pardon, I beseech thee, the iniquity of this people according unto the greatness of thy mercy, and as thou hast forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now.

pardon it [24 JER 05 01](#) # Run ye to and fro through the streets of Jerusalem, and see now, and know, and seek in the broad places thereof, if ye can find a man, if there be [any] that executeth judgment, that seeketh the truth; and I will pardon it.

pardon mine iniquity [19 PSA 25 11](#) # For thy name's sake, O LORD, pardon mine iniquity; for it [is] great.

pardon my sin [09 ISA 15 25](#) # Now therefore, I pray thee, pardon my sin, and turn again with me, that I may worship the LORD.

pardon my transgression [18 JOB 07 21](#) # And why dost thou not pardon my transgression, and take away mine iniquity? for now shall I sleep in the dust; and thou shalt seek me in the morning, but I [shall] not [be].

pardon our iniquity [02 EXO 34 09](#) # And he said, If now I have found grace in thy sight, O Lord, let my Lord, I pray thee, go among us; for it [is] a stiffnecked people; and pardon our iniquity and our sin, and take us for thine inheritance.

pardon thee for [24 JER 05 07](#) # How shall I pardon thee for this? thy children have forsaken me, and sworn by [them that are] no gods: when I had fed them to the full, they then committed adultery, and assembled themselves by troops in the harlots' houses.

pardon them whom [24 JER 50 20](#) # In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and [there shall be] none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found: for I will pardon them whom I reserve.

pardon thy servant [12 2KI 05 18](#) # In this thing the LORD pardon thy servant, [that] when my master goeth into the house of Rimmon to worship there, and he leaneth on my hand, and I bow myself in the house of Rimmon: when I bow down myself in the house of Rimmon, the LORD pardon thy servant in this thing.

pardon thy servant [12 2KI 05 18](#) # In this thing the LORD pardon thy servant, [that] when my master goeth into the house of Rimmon to worship there, and he leaneth on my hand, and I bow myself in the house of Rimmon: when I bow down myself in the house of Rimmon, the LORD pardon thy servant in this thing.

pardon your transgressions [02 EXO 23 21](#) # Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name [is] in him.

pardon [12 2KI 24 04](#) # And also for the innocent blood that he shed: for he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood; which the LORD would not pardon.

pardon [23 ISA 55 07](#) # Let the wicked forsake his way, and the unrighteous man his thoughts: and let him return unto the LORD, and he will have mercy upon him; and to our God, for he will abundantly pardon.

pardoned according to [04 NUM 14 20](#) # And the LORD said, I have pardoned according to thy word:

pardoned for she [23 ISA 40 02](#) # Speak ye comfortably to Jerusalem, and cry unto her, that her warfare is accomplished, that her iniquity is pardoned: for she hath received of the LORD's hand double for all her sins.

pardoned [25 LAM 03 42](#) # We have transgressed and have rebelled: thou hast not pardoned.

pardoneth iniquity and [33 MIC 07 18](#) # Who [is] a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage? he retaineth not his anger for ever, because he delighteth [in] mercy.
