displease him and [20_PRO_24_18](#) # Lest the LORD see [it], and it displease him, and he turn away his wrath from him.

displease my lord [01_GEN_31_35](#) # And she said to her father, Let it not displease my lord that I cannot rise up before thee; for the custom of women [is] upon me. And he searched, but found not the images.

displease not the [09_1SA_29_07](#) # Wherefore now return, and go in peace, that thou displease not the lords of the Philistines.

displease thee for [10_2SA_11_25](#) # Then David said unto the messenger, Thus shalt thou say unto Joab, Let not this thing displease thee, for the sword devoureth one as well as another: make thy battle more strong against the city, and overthrow it: and encourage thou him.

displease thee I [04_NUM_22_34](#) # And Balaam said unto the angel of the LORD, I have sinned; for I knew not that thou stoodest in the way against me: now therefore, if it displease thee, I will get me back again.

displeased against the [35_HAB_03_08](#) # Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? [was] thine anger against the rivers? [was] thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst ride upon thine horses [and] thy chariots of salvation?

displeased and came [11_1KI_20_43](#) # And the king of Israel went to his house heavy and displeased, and came to Samaria.

displeased and said [41_MAR_10_14](#) # But when Jesus saw [it], he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.

displeased and they [38_ZEC_01_15](#) # And I am very sore displeased with the heathen [that are] at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

displeased because of [11_1KI_21_04](#) # And Ahab came into his house heavy and displeased because of the word which Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him: for he had said, I will not give thee the inheritance of my fathers. And he laid him down upon his bed, and turned away his face, and would eat no bread.

displeased because the [13_1CH_13_11](#) # And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzza: wherefore that place is called Perezuzza to this day.

displeased because the [10_2SA_06_08](#) # And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzzah: and he called the name of the place Perezuzzah to this day.

displeased him and [09_1SA_18_08](#) # And Saul was very wroth, and the saying displeased him; and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed [but] thousands: and [what] can he have more but the kingdom?

displeased him and [01_GEN_48_17](#) # And when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand upon the head of Ephraim, it displeased him: and he held up his father's hand, to remove it from Ephraim's head unto Manasseh's head.

displeased him at [11_1KI_01_06](#) # And his father had not displeased him at any time in saying, Why hast

thou done so? and he also [was a] very goodly [man]; and [his mother] bare him after Absalom.

displeased him that [23 ISA 59 15](#) # Yea, truth faileth; and he [that] departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw [it], and it displeased him that [there was] no judgment.

displeased Jonah exceedingly [32 JON 04 01](#) # But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry.

displeased O turn [19 PSA 60 01](#) # To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

displeased Samuel when [09 ISA 08 06](#) # But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD.

displeased the LORD [10 2SA 11 27](#) # And when the mourning was past, David sent and fetched her to his house, and she became his wife, and bare him a son. But the thing that David had done displeased the LORD.

displeased the LORD [01 GEN 38 10](#) # And the thing which he did displeased the LORD: wherefore he slew him also.

displeased the LORD [04 NUM 11 01](#) # And [when] the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard [it]; and his anger was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and consumed [them that were] in the uttermost parts of the camp.

displeased with himself [27 DAN 06 14](#) # Then the king, when he heard [these] words, was sore displeased with himself, and set [his] heart on Daniel to deliver him: and he laboured till the going down of the sun to deliver him.

displeased with James [41 MAR 10 41](#) # And when the ten heard [it], they began to be much displeased with James and John.

displeased with the [38 ZEC 01 15](#) # And I am very sore displeased with the heathen [that are] at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

displeased with them [44 ACT 12 20](#) # And Herod was highly displeased with them of Tyre and Sidon: but they came with one accord to him, and, having made Blastus the king's chamberlain their friend, desired peace; because their country was nourished by the king's [country].

displeased with this [13 1CH 21 07](#) # And God was displeased with this thing; therefore he smote Israel.

displeased with your [38 ZEC 01 02](#) # The LORD hath been sore displeased with your fathers.

displeased [40 MAT 21 15](#) # And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased,

displeased [04 NUM 11 10](#) # Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased.

menpleasers but as [49 EPH 06 06](#) # Not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but as the servants of Christ, doing the will of God from the heart;

menpleasers but in [51 COL 03 22](#) # Servants, obey in all things [your] masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God:

please all men [46 1CO 10 33](#) # Even as I please all [men] in all [things], not seeking mine own profit, but the [profit] of many, that they may be saved.

please and it [23 ISA 55 11](#) # So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper [in the thing] whereto I sent it.

please God so [52 1TH 04 01](#) # Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort [you] by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, [so] ye would abound more and more.

please God that [04 NUM 23 27](#) # And Balak said unto Balaam, Come, I pray thee, I will bring thee unto another place; peradventure it will please God that thou mayest curse me them from thence.

please God to [18 JOB 06 09](#) # Even that it would please God to destroy me; that he would let loose his hand, and cut me off!

please God [45 ROM 08 08](#) # So then they that are in the flesh cannot please God.

please her husband [46 1CO 07 34](#) # There is difference [also] between a wife and a virgin. The unmarried woman careth for the things of the Lord, that she may be holy both in body and in spirit: but she that is married careth for the things of the world, how she may please [her] husband.

please him for [58 HEB 11 06](#) # But without faith [it is] impossible to please [him]: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and [that] he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

please him who [55 2TI 02 04](#) # No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of [this] life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier.

please him [43 JOH 08 29](#) # And he that sent me is with me: the Father hath not left me alone; for I do always those things that please him.

please his neighbour [45 ROM 15 02](#) # Let every one of us please [his] neighbour for [his] good to edification.

please his wife [46 1CO 07 33](#) # But he that is married careth for the things that are of the world, how he may please [his] wife.

please me and [23 ISA 56 04](#) # For thus saith the LORD unto the eunuchs that keep my sabbaths, and choose [the things] that please me, and take hold of my covenant;

please men for [48 GAL 01 10](#) # For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

please my father [09 ISA 20 13](#) # The LORD do so and much more to Jonathan: but if it please my father [to do] thee evil, then I will show it thee, and send thee away, that thou mayest go in peace: and the LORD be with thee, as he hath been with my father.

please not God [52 1TH 02 15](#) # Who both killed the Lord Jesus, and their own prophets, and have persecuted us; and they please not God, and are contrary to all men:

please not her [02 EXO 21 08](#) # If she please not her master, who hath betrothed her to himself, then shall he let her be redeemed: to sell her unto a strange nation he shall have no power, seeing he hath dealt deceitfully with her.

please ourselves [45 ROM 15 01](#) # We then that are strong ought to bear the infirmities of the weak, and not to please ourselves.

please the king [17 EST 01 19](#) # If it please the king, let there go a royal commandment from him, and let it be written among the laws of the Persians and the Medes, that it be not altered, That Vashti come no more before king Ahasuerus; and let the king give her royal estate unto another that is better than she.

please the king [17 EST 03 09](#) # If it please the king, let it be written that they may be destroyed: and I will pay ten thousand talents of silver to the hands of those that have the charge of the business, to bring [it] into the king's treasuries.

please the king [17 EST 05 08](#) # If I have found favour in the sight of the king, and if it please the king to grant my petition, and to perform my request, let the king and Haman come to the banquet that I shall prepare for them, and I will do to morrow as the king hath said.

please the king [17 EST 07 03](#) # Then Esther the queen answered and said, If I have found favour in thy sight, O king, and if it please the king, let my life be given me at my petition, and my people at my request:

please the king [17 EST 08 05](#) # And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing [seem] right before the king, and I [be] pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which [are] in all the king's provinces:

please the king [17 EST 09 13](#) # Then said Esther, If it please the king, let it be granted to the Jews which [are] in Shushan to do to morrow also according unto this day's decree, and let Haman's ten sons be hanged upon the gallows.

please the king [16 NEH 02 05](#) # And I said unto the king, If it please the king, and if thy servant have found favour in thy sight, that thou wouldest send me unto Judah, unto the city of my fathers' sepulchres, that I may build it.

please the king [16 NEH 02 07](#) # Moreover I said unto the king, If it please the king, let letters be given me to the governors beyond the river, that they may convey me over till I come into Judah;

please the Lord [46 1CO 07 32](#) # But I would have you without carefulness. He that is unmarried careth for the things that belong to the Lord, how he may please the Lord:

please the LORD [20 PRO 16 07](#) # When a man's ways please the LORD, he maketh even his enemies to be at peace with him.

please the LORD [19 PSA 69 31](#) # [This] also shall please the LORD better than an ox [or] bullock that hath horns and hoofs.

please the poor [18 JOB 20 10](#) # His children shall seek to please the poor, and his hands shall restore their goods.

please thee I [11 1KI 21 06](#) # And he said unto her, Because I spake unto Naboth the Jezreelite, and said unto him, Give me thy vineyard for money; or else, if it please thee, I will give thee [another] vineyard for it: and he answered, I will not give thee my vineyard.

please thee to [13 1CH 17 27](#) # Now therefore let it please thee to bless the house of thy servant, that it may be before thee for ever: for thou blessest, O LORD, and [it shall be] blessed for ever.

please thee to [10 2SA 07 29](#) # Therefore now let it please thee to bless the house of thy servant, that it may continue for ever before thee: for thou, O Lord GOD, hast spoken [it]: and with thy blessing let the house of

thy servant be blessed for ever.

please them and [14 2CH 10 07](#) # And they spake unto him, saying, If thou be kind to this people, and please them, and speak good words to them, they will be thy servants for ever.

please them well [56 TIT 02 09](#) # [Exhort] servants to be obedient unto their own masters, [and] to please [them] well in all [things]; not answering again;

please themselves in [23 ISA 02 06](#) # Therefore thou hast forsaken thy people the house of Jacob, because they be replenished from the east, and [are] soothsayers like the Philistines, and they please themselves in the children of strangers.

please [22 SON 02 07](#) # I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake [my] love, till he please.

please [22 SON 03 05](#) # I charge you, O ye daughters of Jerusalem, by the roes, and by the hinds of the field, that ye stir not up, nor awake [my] love, till he please.

please [22 SON 08 04](#) # I charge you, O daughters of Jerusalem, that ye stir not up, nor awake [my] love, until he please.

pleased Absalom well [10 2SA 17 04](#) # And the saying pleased Absalom well, and all the elders of Israel.

pleased all the [10 2SA 03 36](#) # And all the people took notice [of it], and it pleased them: as whatsoever the king did pleased all the people.

pleased Darius to [27 DAN 06 01](#) # It pleased Darius to set over the kingdom an hundred and twenty princes, which should be over the whole kingdom;

pleased David well [09 ISA 18 26](#) # And when his servants told David these words, it pleased David well to be the king's son in law: and the days were not expired.

pleased for his [23 ISA 42 21](#) # The LORD is well pleased for his righteousness' sake; he will magnify the law, and make [it] honourable.

pleased for they [46 1CO 10 05](#) # But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.

pleased God by [46 1CO 01 21](#) # For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

pleased God who [48 GAL 01 15](#) # But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called [me] by his grace,

pleased God [58 HEB 11 05](#) # By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

pleased Haman and [17 EST 05 14](#) # Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made.

pleased Hamor and [01 GEN 34 18](#) # And their words pleased Hamor, and Shechem Hamor's son.

pleased hear ye [40 MAT 17 05](#) # While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.

pleased Herod and [41 MAR 06 22](#) # And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in, and danced, and pleased Herod and them that sat with him, the king said unto the damsel, Ask of me whatsoever thou wilt, and I will give [it] thee.

pleased Herod [40 MAT 14 06](#) # But when Herod's birthday was kept, the daughter of Herodias danced before them, and pleased Herod.

pleased him and [46 1CO 15 38](#) # But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.

pleased him and [17 EST 02 09](#) # And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained kindness of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, [which were] meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best [place] of the house of the women.

pleased him not [11 1KI 09 12](#) # And Hiram came out from Tyre to see the cities which Solomon had given him; and they pleased him not.

pleased him [46 1CO 12 18](#) # But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

pleased him [09 ISA 18 20](#) # And Michal Saul's daughter loved David: and they told Saul, and the thing pleased him.

pleased I will [40 MAT 12 18](#) # Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall show judgment to the Gentiles.

pleased it the [44 ACT 15 22](#) # Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

pleased me well [05 DEU 01 23](#) # And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe:

pleased men I [48 GAL 01 10](#) # For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

pleased not himself [45 ROM 15 03](#) # For even Christ pleased not himself; but, as it is written, The reproaches of them that reproached thee fell on me.

pleased not Isaac [01 GEN 28 08](#) # And Esau seeing that the daughters of Canaan pleased not Isaac his father;

pleased O LORD [19 PSA 40 13](#) # Be pleased, O LORD, to deliver me: O LORD, make haste to help me.

pleased Pharaoh well [01 GEN 45 16](#) # And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

pleased Samson well [07 JUD 14 07](#) # And he went down, and talked with the woman; and she pleased Samson well.

pleased Silas to [44 ACT 15 34](#) # Notwithstanding it pleased Silas to abide there still.

pleased that did [19 PSA 135 06](#) # Whatsoever the LORD pleased, [that] did he in heaven, and in earth, in the seas, and all deep places.

pleased the children [06 JOS 22 33](#) # And the thing pleased the children of Israel; and the children of Israel blessed God, and did not intend to go up against them in battle, to destroy the land wherein the children of Reuben and Gad dwelt.

pleased the Father [51 COL 01 19](#) # For it pleased [the Father] that in him should all fulness dwell;

pleased the Jews [44 ACT 12 03](#) # And because he saw it pleased the Jews, he proceeded further to take Peter also. [Then were the days of unleavened bread.]

pleased the king [14 2CH 30 04](#) # And the thing pleased the king and all the congregation.

pleased the king [17 EST 01 21](#) # And the saying pleased the king and the princes; and the king did according to the word of Memucan:

pleased the king [17 EST 02 04](#) # And let the maiden which pleaseth the king be queen instead of Vashti. And the thing pleased the king; and he did so.

pleased the king [16 NEH 02 06](#) # And the king said unto me, [the queen also sitting by him,] For how long shall thy journey be? and when wilt thou return? So it pleased the king to send me; and I set him a time.

pleased the Lord [11 1KI 03 10](#) # And the speech pleased the Lord, that Solomon had asked this thing.

pleased the LORD [09 ISA 12 22](#) # For the LORD will not forsake his people for his great name's sake: because it hath pleased the LORD to make you his people.

pleased the LORD [23 ISA 53 10](#) # Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise him; he hath put [him] to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see [his] seed, he shall prolong [his] days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in his hand.

pleased the LORD [04 NUM 24 01](#) # And when Balaam saw that it pleased the LORD to bless Israel, he went not, as at other times, to seek for enchantments, but he set his face toward the wilderness.

pleased the whole [44 ACT 06 05](#) # And the saying pleased the whole multitude: and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Ghost, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolas a proselyte of Antioch:

pleased thee well [10 2SA 19 06](#) # In that thou lovest thine enemies, and hatest thy friends. For thou hast declared this day, that thou regardest neither princes nor servants: for this day I perceive, that if Absalom had lived, and all we had died this day, then it had pleased thee well.

pleased thee [32 JON 01 14](#) # Wherefore they cried unto the LORD, and said, We beseech thee, O LORD, we beseech thee, let us not perish for this man's life, and lay not upon us innocent blood: for thou, O LORD, hast done as it pleased thee.

pleased them as [10 2SA 03 36](#) # And all the people took notice [of it], and it pleased them: as whatsoever the king did pleased all the people.

pleased them of [45 ROM 15 26](#) # For it hath pleased them of Macedonia and Achaia to make a certain contribution for the poor saints which are at Jerusalem.

pleased them verily [45 ROM 15 27](#) # It hath pleased them verily; and their debtors they are. For if the Gentiles have been made partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister unto them in carnal things.

pleased them [06 JOS 22 30](#) # And when Phinehas the priest, and the princes of the congregation and heads of the thousands of Israel which [were] with him, heard the words that the children of Reuben and the children of Gad and the children of Manasseh spake, it pleased them.

pleased to do [11 1KI 09 01](#) # And it came to pass, when Solomon had finished the building of the house of the LORD, and the king's house, and all Solomon's desire which he was pleased to do,

pleased to dwell [46 1CO 07 12](#) # But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother hath a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away.

pleased to dwell [46 1CO 07 13](#) # And the woman which hath an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him.

pleased to kill [07 JUD 13 23](#) # But his wife said unto him, If the LORD were pleased to kill us, he would not have received a burnt offering and a meat offering at our hands, neither would he have showed us all these [things], nor would as at this time have told us [such things] as these.

pleased with me [01 GEN 33 10](#) # And Jacob said, Nay, I pray thee, if now I have found grace in thy sight, then receive my present at my hand: for therefore I have seen thy face, as though I had seen the face of God, and thou wast pleased with me.

pleased with the [19 PSA 51 19](#) # Then shalt thou be pleased with the sacrifices of righteousness, with burnt offering and whole burnt offering: then shall they offer bullocks upon thine altar.

pleased with thee [39 MAL 01 08](#) # And if ye offer the blind for sacrifice, [is it] not evil? and if ye offer the lame and sick, [is it] not evil? offer it now unto thy governor; will he be pleased with thee, or accept thy person? saith the LORD of hosts.

pleased with thousands [33 MIC 06 07](#) # Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, [or] with ten thousands of rivers of oil? shall I give my firstborn [for] my transgression, the fruit of my body [for] the sin of my soul?

pleased [61 2PE 01 17](#) # For he received from God the Father honour and glory, when there came such a voice to him from the excellent glory, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

pleased [58 HEB 13 16](#) # But to do good and to communicate forget not: for with such sacrifices God is well pleased.

pleased [42 LUK 03 22](#) # And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

pleased [41 MAR 01 11](#) # And there came a voice from heaven, [saying], Thou art my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

pleased [40 MAT 03 17](#) # And lo a voice from heaven, saying, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased.

pleased [19 PSA 115 03](#) # But our God [is] in the heavens: he hath done whatsoever he hath pleased.

pleaseth God shall [21 ECC 07 26](#) # And I find more bitter than death the woman, whose heart [is] snares and nets, [and] her hands [as] bands: whoso pleaseth God shall escape from her; but the sinner shall be

taken by her.

pleaseth him [21 ECC 08 03](#) # Be not hasty to go out of his sight: stand not in an evil thing; for he doeth whatsoever pleaseth him.

pleaseth me well [07 JUD 14 03](#) # Then his father and his mother said unto him, [Is there] never a woman among the daughters of thy brethren, or among all my people, that thou goest to take a wife of the uncircumcised Philistines? And Samson said unto his father, Get her for me; for she pleaseth me well.

pleaseth the king [17 EST 02 04](#) # And let the maiden which pleaseth the king be queen instead of Vashti. And the thing pleased the king; and he did so.

pleaseth thee And [01 GEN 16 06](#) # But Abram said unto Sarai, Behold, thy maid [is] in thy hand; do to her as it pleaseth thee. And when Sarai dealt hardly with her, she fled from her face.

pleaseth thee [01 GEN 20 15](#) # And Abimelech said, Behold, my land [is] before thee: dwell where it pleaseth thee.
