grope as if [23 ISA 59 10](#) # We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if [we had] no eyes: we stumble at noon day as in the night; [we are] in desolate places as dead [men].

grope at noonday [05 DEU 28 29](#) # And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save [thee].

grope for the [23 ISA 59 10](#) # We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if [we had] no eyes: we stumble at noon day as in the night; [we are] in desolate places as dead [men].

grope in the [18 JOB 05 14](#) # They meet with darkness in the daytime, and grope in the noonday as in the night.

grope in the [18 JOB 12 25](#) # They grope in the dark without light, and he maketh them to stagger like [a] drunken [man].

gropeth in darkness [05 DEU 28 29](#) # And thou shalt grope at noonday, as the blind gropeth in darkness, and thou shalt not prosper in thy ways: and thou shalt be only oppressed and spoiled evermore, and no man shall save [thee].

proper child and [58 HEB 11 23](#) # By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw [he was] a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.

proper gift of [46 ICO 07 07](#) # For I would that all men were even as I myself. But every man hath his proper gift of God, one after this manner, and another after that.

proper good of [13 ICH 29 03](#) # Moreover, because I have set my affection to the house of my God, I have of mine own proper good, of gold and silver, [which] I have given to the house of my God, over and above all that I have prepared for the holy house,

proper tongue Aceldama [44 ACT 01 19](#) # And it was known unto all the dwellers at Jerusalem; insomuch as that field is called in their proper tongue, Aceldama, that is to say, The field of blood.

rope [23 ISA 05 18](#) # Woe unto them that draw iniquity with cords of vanity, and sin as it were with a cart rope:
