approve their sayings [19_PSA_49_13](#) # This their way [is] their folly: yet their posterity approve their sayings. Selah.

approve things that [50_PHP_01_10](#) # That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;

approved but that [47_2CO_13_07](#) # Now I pray to God that ye do no evil; not that we should appear approved, but that ye should do that which is honest, though we be as reprobates.

approved but whom [47_2CO_10_18](#) # For not he that commendeth himself is approved, but whom the Lord commendeth.
