Abagtha Zethar and [17 EST 01 10](#) # On the seventh day, when the heart of the king was merry with wine, he commanded Mehuman, Biztha, Harbona, Bigtha, and Abagtha, Zethar, and Carcas, the seven chamberlains that served in the presence of Ahasuerus the king,

bag and bare [43 JOH 12 06](#) # This he said, not that he cared for the poor; but because he was a thief, and had the bag, and bare what was put therein.

bag and thou [18 JOB 14 17](#) # My transgression [is] sealed up in a bag, and thou sewest up mine iniquity.

bag and took [09 ISA 17 49](#) # And David put his hand in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang [it], and smote the Philistine in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead; and he fell upon his face to the earth.

bag and weigh [23 ISA 46 06](#) # They lavish gold out of the bag, and weigh silver in the balance, [and] hire a goldsmith; and he maketh it a god: they fall down, yea, they worship.

bag are his [20 PRO 16 11](#) # A just weight and balance [are] the LORD's: all the weights of the bag [are] his work.

bag divers weights [05 DEU 25 13](#) # Thou shalt not have in thy bag divers weights, a great and a small.

bag of deceitful [33 MIC 06 11](#) # Shall I count [them] pure with the wicked balances, and with the bag of deceitful weights?

bag of money [20 PRO 07 20](#) # He hath taken a bag of money with him, [and] will come home at the day appointed.

bag that Jesus [43 JOH 13 29](#) # For some [of them] thought, because Judas had the bag, that Jesus had said unto him, Buy [those things] that we have need of against the feast; or, that he should give something to the poor.

bag which he [09 ISA 17 40](#) # And he took his staff in his hand, and chose him five smooth stones out of the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag which he had, even in a scrip; and his sling [was] in his hand: and he drew near to the Philistine.

bag with holes [37 HAG 01 06](#) # Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages [to put it] into a bag with holes.

bags and told [12 2KI 12 10](#) # And it was [so], when they saw that [there was] much money in the chest, that the king's scribe and the high priest came up, and they put up in bags, and told the money that was found in the house of the LORD.
