considereth a field [20_PRO_31_16](#) # She considereth a field, and buyeth it: with the fruit of her hands she planteth a vineyard.

considereth all their [19_PSA_33_15](#) # He fashioneth their hearts alike; he considereth all their works.

considereth and doeth [26_EZE_18_14](#) # Now, lo, [if] he beget a son, that seeth all his father's sins which he hath done, and considereth, and doeth not such like,

considereth and turneth [26_EZE_18_28](#) # Because he considereth, and turneth away from all his transgressions that he hath committed, he shall surely live, he shall not die.

considereth in his [23_ISA_44_19](#) # And none considereth in his heart, neither [is there] knowledge nor understanding to say, I have burned part of it in the fire; yea, also I have baked bread upon the coals thereof; I have roasted flesh, and eaten [it]: and shall I make the residue thereof an abomination? shall I fall down to the stock of a tree?

considereth not that [20_PRO_28_22](#) # He that hasteth to be rich [hath] an evil eye, and considereth not that poverty shall come upon him.

considereth the cause [20_PRO_29_07](#) # The righteous considereth the cause of the poor: [but] the wicked regardeth not to know [it].

considereth the house [20_PRO_21_12](#) # The righteous [man] wisely considereth the house of the wicked: [but God] overthroweth the wicked for [their] wickedness.

considereth the poor [19_PSA_41_01](#) # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Blessed [is] he that considereth the poor: the LORD will deliver him in time of trouble.
