Andrew and again [43 JOH 12 22](#) # Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

Andrew and Peter [43 JOH 01 44](#) # Now Philip was of Bethsaida, the city of Andrew and Peter.

Andrew and Philip [43 JOH 12 22](#) # Philip cometh and telleth Andrew: and again Andrew and Philip tell Jesus.

Andrew and Philip [41 MAR 03 18](#) # And Andrew, and Philip, and Bartholomew, and Matthew, and Thomas, and James the [son] of Alphaeus, and Thaddaeus, and Simon the Canaanite,

Andrew asked him [41 MAR 13 03](#) # And as he sat upon the mount of Olives over against the temple, Peter and James and John and Andrew asked him privately,

Andrew his brother [42 LUK 06 14](#) # Simon, [whom he also named Peter,] and Andrew his brother, James and John, Philip and Bartholomew,

Andrew his brother [41 MAR 01 16](#) # Now as he walked by the sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and Andrew his brother casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.

Andrew his brother [40 MAT 04 18](#) # And Jesus, walking by the sea of Galilee, saw two brethren, Simon called Peter, and Andrew his brother, casting a net into the sea: for they were fishers.

Andrew his brother [40 MAT 10 02](#) # Now the names of the twelve apostles are these; The first, Simon, who is called Peter, and Andrew his brother; James [the son] of Zebedee, and John his brother;

Andrew Philip and [44 ACT 01 13](#) # And when they were come in, they went up into an upper room, where abode both Peter, and James, and John, and Andrew, Philip, and Thomas, Bartholomew, and Matthew, James [the son] of Alphaeus, and Simon Zelotes, and Judas [the brother] of James.

Andrew Simon Peter's [43 JOH 01 40](#) # One of the two which heard John [speak], and followed him, was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother.

Andrew Simon Peter's [43 JOH 06 08](#) # One of his disciples, Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, saith unto him,

Andrew with James [41 MAR 01 29](#) # And forthwith, when they were come out of the synagogue, they entered into the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John.

drew a bow [11 1KI 22 34](#) # And a [certain] man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: wherefore he said unto the driver of his chariot, Turn thine hand, and carry me out of the host; for I am wounded.

drew a bow [14 2CH 18 33](#) # And a [certain] man drew a bow at a venture, and smote the king of Israel between the joints of the harness: therefore he said to his chariot man, Turn thine hand, that thou mayest carry me out of the host; for I am wounded.

drew a bow [12 2KI 09 24](#) # And Jehu drew a bow with his full strength, and smote Jehoram between his

arms, and the arrow went out at his heart, and he sunk down in his chariot.

drew a sword [41 MAR 14 47](#) # And one of them that stood by drew a sword, and smote a servant of the high priest, and cut off his ear.

drew Alexander out [44 ACT 19 33](#) # And they drew Alexander out of the multitude, the Jews putting him forward. And Alexander beckoned with the hand, and would have made his defence unto the people.

drew and lifted [01 GEN 37 28](#) # Then there passed by Midianites merchantmen; and they drew and lifted up Joseph out of the pit, and sold Joseph to the Ishmeelites for twenty [pieces] of silver: and they brought Joseph into Egypt.

drew away much [44 ACT 05 37](#) # After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and all, [even] as many as obeyed him, were dispersed.

drew back his [01 GEN 38 29](#) # And it came to pass, as he drew back his hand, that, behold, his brother came out: and she said, How hast thou broken forth? [this] breach [be] upon thee: therefore his name was called Pharez.

drew bows two [14 2CH 14 08](#) # And Asa had an army [of men] that bare targets and spears, out of Judah three hundred thousand; and out of Benjamin, that bare shields and drew bows, two hundred and fourscore thousand: all these [were] mighty men of valour.

drew for all [01 GEN 24 20](#) # And she hasted, and emptied her pitcher into the trough, and ran again unto the well to draw [water], and drew for all his camels.

drew forth the [13 1CH 19 16](#) # And when the Syrians saw that they were put to the worse before Israel, they sent messengers, and drew forth the Syrians that [were] beyond the river: and Shophach the captain of the host of Hadarezer [went] before them.

drew him out [44 ACT 14 19](#) # And there came thither [certain] Jews from Antioch and Iconium, who persuaded the people, and, having stoned Paul, drew [him] out of the city, supposing he had been dead.

drew him out [44 ACT 21 30](#) # And all the city was moved, and the people ran together: and they took Paul, and drew him out of the temple: and forthwith the doors were shut.

drew him out [02 EXO 02 10](#) # And the child grew, and she brought him unto Pharaoh's daughter, and he became her son. And she called his name Moses: and she said, Because I drew him out of the water.

drew his sword [40 MAT 26 51](#) # And, behold, one of them which were with Jesus stretched out [his] hand, and drew his sword, and struck a servant of the high priest's, and smote off his ear.

drew it and [43 JOH 18 10](#) # Then Simon Peter having a sword drew it, and smote the high priest's servant, and cut off his right ear. The servant's name was Malchus.

drew it out [09 1SA 17 51](#) # Therefore David ran, and stood upon the Philistine, and took his sword, and drew it out of the sheath thereof, and slew him, and cut off his head therewith. And when the Philistines saw their champion was dead, they fled.

drew Jason and [44 ACT 17 06](#) # And when they found them not, they drew Jason and certain brethren unto the rulers of the city, crying, These that have turned the world upside down are come hither also;

drew me out [10 2SA 22 17](#) # He sent from above, he took me; he drew me out of many waters;

drew me out [19 PSA 18 16](#) # He sent from above, he took me, he drew me out of many waters.

drew near and [17\\_EST\\_05\\_02](#) # And it was so, when the king saw Esther the queen standing in the court, [that] she obtained favour in his sight: and the king held out to Esther the golden sceptre that [was] in his hand. So Esther drew near, and touched the top of the sceptre.

drew near and [01\\_GEN\\_18\\_23](#) # And Abraham drew near, and said, Wilt thou also destroy the righteous with the wicked?

drew near and [23\\_ISA\\_41\\_05](#) # The isles saw [it], and feared; the ends of the earth were afraid, drew near, and came.

drew near and [03\\_LEV\\_09\\_05](#) # And they brought [that] which Moses commanded before the tabernacle of the congregation: and all the congregation drew near and stood before the LORD.

drew near and [42\\_LUK\\_24\\_15](#) # And it came to pass, that, while they communed [together] and reasoned, Jesus himself drew near, and went with them.

drew near he [40\\_MAT\\_21\\_34](#) # And when the time of the fruit drew near, he sent his servants to the husbandmen, that they might receive the fruits of it.

drew near morning [09\\_ISA\\_17\\_16](#) # And the Philistine drew near morning and evening, and presented himself forty days.

drew near to [09\\_ISA\\_07\\_10](#) # And as Samuel was offering up the burnt offering, the Philistines drew near to battle against Israel: but the LORD thundered with a great thunder on that day upon the Philistines, and discomfited them; and they were smitten before Israel.

drew near to [09\\_ISA\\_09\\_18](#) # Then Saul drew near to Samuel in the gate, and said, Tell me, I pray thee, where the seer's house [is].

drew near to [09\\_ISA\\_17\\_40](#) # And he took his staff in his hand, and chose him five smooth stones out of the brook, and put them in a shepherd's bag which he had, even in a scrip; and his sling [was] in his hand: and he drew near to the Philistine.

drew near to [44\\_ACT\\_07\\_31](#) # When Moses saw [it], he wondered at the sight: and as he drew near to behold [it], the voice of the Lord came unto him,

drew near to [44\\_ACT\\_27\\_27](#) # But when the fourteenth night was come, as we were driven up and down in Adria, about midnight the shipmen deemed that they drew near to some country;

drew near to [17\\_EST\\_09\\_01](#) # Now in the twelfth month, that [is], the month Adar, on the thirteenth day of the same, when the king's commandment and his decree drew near to be put in execution, in the day that the enemies of the Jews hoped to have power over them, [though it was turned to the contrary, that the Jews had rule over them that hated them;]

drew near unto [09\\_ISA\\_17\\_41](#) # And the Philistine came on and drew near unto David; and the man that bare the shield [went] before him.

drew near unto [02\\_EXO\\_20\\_21](#) # And the people stood afar off, and Moses drew near unto the thick darkness where God [was].

drew near unto [42\\_LUK\\_15\\_01](#) # Then drew near unto him all the publicans and sinners for to hear him.

drew near unto [42\\_LUK\\_22\\_47](#) # And while he yet spake, behold a multitude, and he that was called Judas, one of the twelve, went before them, and drew near unto Jesus to kiss him.

drew near [10 2SA 18 25](#) # And the watchman cried, and told the king. And the king said, If he [be] alone, [there is] tidings in his mouth. And he came apace, and drew near.

drew nigh and [10 2SA 10 13](#) # And Joab drew nigh, and the people that [were] with him, unto the battle against the Syrians: and they fled before him.

drew nigh and [06 JOS 08 11](#) # And all the people, [even the people] of war that [were] with him, went up, and drew nigh, and came before the city, and pitched on the north side of Ai: now [there was] a valley between them and Ai.

drew nigh before [13 1CH 19 14](#) # So Joab and the people that [were] with him drew nigh before the Syrians unto the battle; and they fled before him.

drew nigh that [11 1KI 02 01](#) # Now the days of David drew nigh that he should die; and he charged Solomon his son, saying,

drew nigh that [01 GEN 47 29](#) # And the time drew nigh that Israel must die: and he called his son Joseph, and said unto him, If now I have found grace in thy sight, put, I pray thee, thy hand under my thigh, and deal kindly and truly with me; bury me not, I pray thee, in Egypt:

drew nigh the [02 EXO 14 10](#) # And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them; and they were sore afraid: and the children of Israel cried out unto the LORD.

drew nigh to [09 ISA 17 48](#) # And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine.

drew nigh to [42 LUK 15 25](#) # Now his elder son was in the field: and as he came and drew nigh to the house, he heard music and dancing.

drew nigh unto [44 ACT 10 09](#) # On the morrow, as they went on their journey, and drew nigh unto the city, Peter went up upon the housetop to pray about the sixth hour:

drew nigh unto [42 LUK 24 28](#) # And they drew nigh unto the village, whither they went: and he made as though he would have gone further.

drew nigh unto [40 MAT 21 01](#) # And when they drew nigh unto Jerusalem, and were come to Bethphage, unto the mount of Olives, then sent Jesus two disciples,

drew nigh which [44 ACT 07 17](#) # But when the time of the promise drew nigh, which God had sworn to Abraham, the people grew and multiplied in Egypt,

drew nigh which [42 LUK 22 01](#) # Now the feast of unleavened bread drew nigh, which is called the Passover.

drew not his [06 JOS 08 26](#) # For Joshua drew not his hand back, wherewith he stretched out the spear, until he had utterly destroyed all the inhabitants of Ai.

drew not his [07 JUD 08 20](#) # And he said unto Jether his firstborn, Up, [and] slay them. But the youth drew not his sword: for he feared, because he [was] yet a youth.

drew not near [36 ZEP 03 02](#) # She obeyed not the voice; she received not correction; she trusted not in the LORD; she drew not near to her God.

drew off his [08 RUT 04 08](#) # Therefore the kinsman said unto Boaz, Buy [it] for thee. So he drew off his shoe.

drew on [42 LUK 23 54](#) # And that day was the preparation, and the sabbath drew on.

drew out his [44 ACT 16 27](#) # And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.

drew out the [11 1KI 08 08](#) # And they drew out the staves, that the ends of the staves were seen out in the holy [place] before the oracle, and they were not seen without: and there they are unto this day.

drew out the [14 2CH 05 09](#) # And they drew out the staves [of the ark], that the ends of the staves were seen from the ark before the oracle; but they were not seen without. And there it is unto this day.

drew sword all [07 JUD 20 17](#) # And the men of Israel, beside Benjamin, were numbered four hundred thousand men that drew sword: all these [were] men of war.

drew sword and [13 1CH 21 05](#) # And Joab gave the sum of the number of the people unto David. And all [they of] Israel were a thousand thousand and an hundred thousand men that drew sword: and Judah [was] four hundred threescore and ten thousand men that drew sword.

drew sword beside [07 JUD 20 15](#) # And the children of Benjamin were numbered at that time out of the cities twenty and six thousand men that drew sword, beside the inhabitants of Gibeah, which were numbered seven hundred chosen men.

drew sword [13 1CH 21 05](#) # And Joab gave the sum of the number of the people unto David. And all [they of] Israel were a thousand thousand and an hundred thousand men that drew sword: and Judah [was] four hundred threescore and ten thousand men that drew sword.

drew sword [07 JUD 08 10](#) # Now Zebah and Zalmunna [were] in Karkor, and their hosts with them, about fifteen thousand [men], all that were left of all the hosts of the children of the east: for there fell an hundred and twenty thousand men that drew sword.

drew sword [07 JUD 20 02](#) # And the chief of all the people, [even] of all the tribes of Israel, presented themselves in the assembly of the people of God, four hundred thousand footmen that drew sword.

drew swords to [12 2KI 03 26](#) # And when the king of Moab saw that the battle was too sore for him, he took with him seven hundred men that drew swords, to break through [even] unto the king of Edom: but they could not.

drew the net [43 JOH 21 11](#) # Simon Peter went up, and drew the net to land full of great fishes, an hundred and fifty and three: and for all there were so many, yet was not the net broken.

drew the sword [10 2SA 24 09](#) # And Joab gave up the sum of the number of the people unto the king: and there were in Israel eight hundred thousand valiant men that drew the sword; and the men of Judah [were] five hundred thousand men.

drew the sword [07 JUD 20 25](#) # And Benjamin went forth against them out of Gibeah the second day, and destroyed down to the ground of the children of Israel again eighteen thousand men; all these drew the sword.

drew the sword [07 JUD 20 35](#) # And the LORD smote Benjamin before Israel: and the children of Israel destroyed of the Benjamites that day twenty and five thousand and an hundred men: all these drew the sword.

drew the sword [07\\_JUD\\_20\\_46](#) # So that all which fell that day of Benjamin were twenty and five thousand men that drew the sword; all these [were] men of valour.

drew the third [66\\_REV\\_12\\_04](#) # And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth: and the dragon stood before the woman which was ready to be delivered, for to devour her child as soon as it was born.

drew the water [43\\_JOH\\_02\\_09](#) # When the ruler of the feast had tasted the water that was made wine, and knew not whence it was: [but the servants which drew the water knew;] the governor of the feast called the bridegroom,

drew them into [44\\_ACT\\_16\\_19](#) # And when her masters saw that the hope of their gains was gone, they caught Paul and Silas, and drew [them] into the marketplace unto the rulers,

drew them with [28\\_HOS\\_11\\_04](#) # I drew them with cords of a man, with bands of love: and I was to them as they that take off the yoke on their jaws, and I laid meat unto them.

drew themselves along [07\\_JUD\\_20\\_37](#) # And the liers in wait hasted, and rushed upon Gibeah; and the liers in wait drew [themselves] along, and smote all the city with the edge of the sword.

drew to shore [40\\_MAT\\_13\\_48](#) # Which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away.

drew to the [41\\_MAR\\_06\\_53](#) # And when they had passed over, they came into the land of Gennesaret, and drew to the shore.

drew up Jeremiah [24\\_JER\\_38\\_13](#) # So they drew up Jeremiah with cords, and took him up out of the dungeon: and Jeremiah remained in the court of the prison.

drew water and [09\\_ISA\\_07\\_06](#) # And they gathered together to Mizpeh, and drew water, and poured [it] out before the LORD, and fasted on that day, and said there, We have sinned against the LORD. And Samuel judged the children of Israel in Mizpeh.

drew water and [02\\_EXO\\_02\\_16](#) # Now the priest of Midian had seven daughters: and they came and drew [water], and filled the troughs to water their father's flock.

drew water and [01\\_GEN\\_24\\_45](#) # And before I had done speaking in mine heart, behold, Rebekah came forth with her pitcher on her shoulder; and she went down unto the well, and drew [water]: and I said unto her, Let me drink, I pray thee.

drew water enough [02\\_EXO\\_02\\_19](#) # And they said, An Egyptian delivered us out of the hand of the shepherds, and also drew [water] enough for us, and watered the flock.

drew water out [13\\_1CH\\_11\\_18](#) # And the three brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: but David would not drink [of] it, but poured it out to the LORD,

drew water out [10\\_2SA\\_23\\_16](#) # And the three mighty men brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: nevertheless he would not drink thereof, but poured it out unto the LORD.

drewest near in [25\\_LAM\\_03\\_57](#) # Thou drewest near in the day [that] I called upon thee: thou saidst, Fear not.

withdrew and separated [48 GAL 02 12](#) # For before that certain came from James, he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the circumcision.

withdrew himself from [40 MAT 12 15](#) # But when Jesus knew [it], he withdrew himself from thence: and great multitudes followed him, and he healed them all;

withdrew himself into [42 LUK 05 16](#) # And he withdrew himself into the wilderness, and prayed.

withdrew himself with [41 MAR 03 07](#) # But Jesus withdrew himself with his disciples to the sea: and a great multitude from Galilee followed him, and from Judaea,

withdrew mine hand [26 EZE 20 22](#) # Nevertheless I withdrew mine hand, and wrought for my name's sake, that it should not be polluted in the sight of the heathen, in whose sight I brought them forth.

withdrew the shoulder [16 NEH 09 29](#) # And testifiedst against them, that thou mightest bring them again unto thy law: yet they dealt proudly, and hearkened not unto thy commandments, but sinned against thy judgments, [which if a man do, he shall live in them;] and withdrew the shoulder, and hardened their neck, and would not hear.
