fasting and my [19 PSA 109 24](#) # My knees are weak through fasting; and my flesh faileth of fatness.

fasting and my [19 PSA 35 13](#) # But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing [was] sackcloth: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom.

fasting and prayer [46 ICO 07 05](#) # Defraud ye not one the other, except [it be] with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency.

fasting and sackcloth [27 DAN 09 03](#) # And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes:

fasting and weeping [17 EST 04 03](#) # And in every province, whithersoever the king's commandment and his decree came, [there was] great mourning among the Jews, and fasting, and weeping, and wailing; and many lay in sackcloth and ashes.

fasting and with [29 JOE 02 12](#) # Therefore also now, saith the LORD, turn ye [even] to me with all your heart, and with fasting, and with weeping, and with mourning:

fasting and with [16 NEH 09 01](#) # Now in the twenty and fourth day of this month the children of Israel were assembled with fasting, and with sackclothes, and earth upon them.
