flee also youthful [55 2TI 02 22](#) # Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

flee and draw [07 JUD 20 32](#) # And the children of Benjamin said, They [are] smitten down before us, as at the first. But the children of Israel said, Let us flee, and draw them from the city unto the highways.

flee and escape [24 JER 50 28](#) # The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of Babylon, to declare in Zion the vengeance of the LORD our God, the vengeance of his temple.

flee and fear [24 JER 49 24](#) # Damascus is waxed feeble, [and] turneth herself to flee, and fear hath seized on [her]: anguish and sorrows have taken her, as a woman in travail.

flee and get [24 JER 48 09](#) # Give wings unto Moab, that it may flee and get away: for the cities thereof shall be desolate, without any to dwell therein.

flee and I [10 2SA 17 02](#) # And I will come upon him while he [is] weary and weak handed, and will make him afraid: and all the people that [are] with him shall flee; and I will smite the king only:
