leasing Selah [19 PSA 04 02](#) # O ye sons of men, how long [will ye turn] my glory into shame? [how long] will ye love vanity, [and] seek after leasing? Selah.

leasing the LORD [19 PSA 05 06](#) # Thou shalt destroy them that speak leasing: the LORD will abhor the bloody and deceitful man.

pleasing being fruitful [51 COL 01 10](#) # That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God;

pleasing in his [62 1JO 03 22](#) # And whatsoever we ask, we receive of him, because we keep his commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in his sight.

pleasing in his [17 EST 08 05](#) # And said, If it please the king, and if I have found favour in his sight, and the thing [seem] right before the king, and I [be] pleasing in his eyes, let it be written to reverse the letters devised by Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, which he wrote to destroy the Jews which [are] in all the king's provinces:

pleasing men but [52 1TH 02 04](#) # But as we were allowed of God to be put in trust with the gospel, even so we speak; not as pleasing men, but God, which trieth our hearts.

pleasing unto him [28 HOS 09 04](#) # They shall not offer wine [offerings] to the LORD, neither shall they be pleasing unto him: their sacrifices [shall be] unto them as the bread of mourners; all that eat thereof shall be polluted: for their bread for their soul shall not come into the house of the LORD.

pleasing unto the [51 COL 03 20](#) # Children, obey [your] parents in all things: for this is well pleasing unto the Lord.

wellpleasing in his [58 HEB 13 21](#) # Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is wellpleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom [be] glory for ever and ever. Amen.

wellpleasing to God [50 PHP 04 18](#) # But I have all, and abound: I am full, having received of Epaphroditus the things [which were sent] from you, an odour of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, wellpleasing to God.
