displayed because of [19 PSA 60 04](#) # Thou hast given a banner to them that fear thee, that it may be displayed because of the truth. Selah.

played and said [09 ISA 18 07](#) # And the women answered [one another] as they played, and said, Saul hath slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands.

played before God [13 ICH 13 08](#) # And David and all Israel played before God with all [their] might, and with singing, and with harps, and with psalteries, and with timbrels, and with cymbals, and with trumpets.

played before the [10 2SA 06 05](#) # And David and all the house of Israel played before the LORD on all manner of [instruments made of] fir wood, even on harps, and on psalteries, and on timbrels, and on cornets, and on cymbals.

played that the [12 2KI 03 15](#) # But now bring me a minstrel. And it came to pass, when the minstrel played, that the hand of the LORD came upon him.

played the fool [09 ISA 26 21](#) # Then said Saul, I have sinned: return, my son David: for I will no more do thee harm, because my soul was precious in thine eyes this day: behold, I have played the fool, and have erred exceedingly.

played the harlot [26 EZE 16 28](#) # Thou hast played the whore also with the Assyrians, because thou wast unsatiable; yea, thou hast played the harlot with them, and yet couldst not be satisfied.

played the harlot [26 EZE 23 05](#) # And Aholah played the harlot when she was mine; and she doted on her lovers, on the Assyrians [her] neighbours,

played the harlot [26 EZE 23 19](#) # Yet she multiplied her whoredoms, in calling to remembrance the days of her youth, wherein she had played the harlot in the land of Egypt.

played the harlot [01 GEN 38 24](#) # And it came to pass about three months after, that it was told Judah, saying, Tamar thy daughter in law hath played the harlot; and also, behold, she [is] with child by whoredom. And Judah said, Bring her forth, and let her be burnt.

played the harlot [28 HOS 02 05](#) # For their mother hath played the harlot: she that conceived them hath done shamefully: for she said, I will go after my lovers, that give [me] my bread and my water, my wool and my flax, mine oil and my drink.

played the harlot [24 JER 03 01](#) # They say, If a man put away his wife, and she go from him, and become another man's, shall he return unto her again? shall not that land be greatly polluted? but thou hast played the harlot with many lovers; yet return again to me, saith the LORD.

played the harlot [24 JER 03 06](#) # The LORD said also unto me in the days of Josiah the king, Hast thou seen [that] which backsliding Israel hath done? she is gone up upon every high mountain and under every green tree, and there hath played the harlot.

played the harlot [24 JER 03 08](#) # And I saw, when for all the causes whereby backsliding Israel committed adultery I had put her away, and given her a bill of divorce; yet her treacherous sister Judah feared not, but went and played the harlot also.

played the whore [07 JUD 19 02](#) # And his concubine played the whore against him, and went away from him unto her father's house to Bethlehemjudah, and was there four whole months.

played with his [09 ISA 16 23](#) # And it came to pass, when the [evil] spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.
