fellowprisoner in Christ [57 PHM 01 23](#) # There salute thee Epaphras, my fellowprisoner in Christ Jesus;

fellowprisoner saluteth you [51 COL 04 10](#) # Aristarchus my fellowprisoner saluteth you, and Marcus, sister's son to Barnabas, [touching whom ye received commandments: if he come unto you, receive him;]

fellowprisoners who are [45 ROM 16 07](#) # Salute Andronicus and Junia, my kinsmen, and my fellowprisoners, who are of note among the apostles, who also were in Christ before me.

imprisoned and beat [44 ACT 22 19](#) # And I said, Lord, they know that I imprisoned and beat in every synagogue them that believed on thee:

imprisonment [15 EZR 07 26](#) # And whosoever will not do the law of thy God, and the law of the king, let judgment be executed speedily upon him, whether [it be] unto death, or to banishment, or to confiscation of goods, or to imprisonment.

imprisonment [58 HEB 11 36](#) # And others had trial of [cruel] mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:

imprisonments in tumults [47 2CO 06 05](#) # In stripes, in imprisonments, in tumults, in labours, in watchings, in fastings;

prison a place [01 GEN 39 20](#) # And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners [were] bound: and he was there in the prison.

prison according to [24 JER 32 08](#) # So Hanameel mine uncle's son came to me in the court of the prison according to the word of the LORD, and said unto me, Buy my field, I pray thee, that [is] in Anathoth, which [is] in the country of Benjamin: for the right of inheritance [is] thine, and the redemption [is] thine; buy [it] for thyself. Then I knew that this [was] the word of the LORD.

prison After him [16 NEH 03 25](#) # Palal the son of Uzai, over against the turning [of the wall], and the tower which lieth out from the king's high house, that [was] by the court of the prison. After him Pedaiah the son of Parosh.

prison and after [23 ISA 24 22](#) # And they shall be gathered together, [as] prisoners are gathered in the pit, and shall be shut up in the prison, and after many days shall they be visited.

prison and came [40 MAT 25 39](#) # Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee?

prison and committed [24 JER 39 14](#) # Even they sent, and took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: so he dwelt among the people.

prison and delivered [44 ACT 12 04](#) # And when he had apprehended him, he put [him] in prison, and delivered [him] to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people.

prison and did [40 MAT 25 44](#) # Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungered, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee?

prison and entered [44 ACT 16 40](#) # And they went out of the prison, and entered into [the house of] Lydia: and when they had seen the brethren, they comforted them, and departed.

prison and feed [11 1KI 22 27](#) # And say, Thus saith the king, Put this [fellow] in the prison, and feed him with bread of affliction and with water of affliction, until I come in peace.

prison and feed [14 2CH 18 26](#) # And say, Thus saith the king, Put this [fellow] in the prison, and feed him with bread of affliction and with water of affliction, until I return in peace.

prison and from [23 ISA 53 08](#) # He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.

prison and he [44 ACT 12 07](#) # And, behold, the angel of the Lord came upon [him], and a light shined in the prison: and he smote Peter on the side, and raised him up, saying, Arise up quickly. And his chains fell off from [his] hands.

prison And he [44 ACT 12 17](#) # But he, beckoning unto them with the hand to hold their peace, declared unto them how the Lord had brought him out of the prison. And he said, Go show these things unto James, and to the brethren. And he departed, and went into another place.

prison and in [24 JER 29 26](#) # The LORD hath made thee priest in the stead of Jehoiada the priest, that ye should be officers in the house of the LORD, for every man [that is] mad, and maketh himself a prophet, that thou shouldest put him in prison, and in the stocks.

prison and made [44 ACT 16 24](#) # Who, having received such a charge, thrust them into the inner prison, and made their feet fast in the stocks.

prison and now [44 ACT 16 37](#) # But Paul said unto them, They have beaten us openly uncondemned, being Romans, and have cast [us] into prison; and now do they thrust us out privily? nay verily; but let them come themselves and fetch us out.

prison and that [24 JER 37 21](#) # Then Zedekiah the king commanded that they should commit Jeremiah into the court of the prison, and that they should give him daily a piece of bread out of the bakers' street, until all the bread in the city were spent. Thus Jeremiah remained in the court of the prison.

prison and them [23 ISA 42 07](#) # To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, [and] them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

prison and they [24 JER 38 06](#) # Then took they Jeremiah, and cast him into the dungeon of Malchiah the son of Hammelech, that [was] in the court of the prison: and they let down Jeremiah with cords. And in the dungeon [there was] no water, but mire: so Jeremiah sunk in the mire.

prison and to [42 LUK 22 33](#) # And he said unto him, Lord, I am ready to go with thee, both into prison, and to death.

prison and whatsoever [01 GEN 39 22](#) # And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners that [were] in the prison; and whatsoever they did there, he was the doer [of it].

prison and ye [40 MAT 25 36](#) # Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.

prison and ye [40 MAT 25 43](#) # I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not.

prison are standing [44 ACT 05 25](#) # Then came one and told them, saying, Behold, the men whom ye put in prison are standing in the temple, and teaching the people.

prison awaking out [44 ACT 16 27](#) # And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.

prison but prayer [44 ACT 12 05](#) # Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him.

prison charging the [44 ACT 16 23](#) # And when they had laid many stripes upon them, they cast [them] into prison, charging the jailor to keep them safely:

prison committed to [01 GEN 39 22](#) # And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners that [were] in the prison; and whatsoever they did there, he was the doer [of it].

prison doors and [44 ACT 05 19](#) # But the angel of the Lord by night opened the prison doors, and brought them forth, and said,

prison doors open [44 ACT 16 27](#) # And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.

prison for Herodias'sake [41 MAR 06 17](#) # For Herod himself had sent forth and laid hold upon John, and bound him in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife: for he had married her.

prison for Herodias'sake [40 MAT 14 03](#) # For Herod had laid hold on John, and bound him, and put [him] in prison for Herodias' sake, his brother Philip's wife.

prison garments and [12 2KI 25 29](#) # And changed his prison garments: and he did eat bread continually before him all the days of his life.

prison garments and [24 JER 52 33](#) # And changed his prison garments: and he did continually eat bread before him all the days of his life.

prison gate [16 NEH 12 39](#) # And from above the gate of Ephraim, and above the old gate, and above the fish gate, and the tower of Hananeel, and the tower of Meah, even unto the sheep gate: and they stood still in the prison gate.

prison go ye [01 GEN 42 19](#) # If ye [be] true [men], let one of your brethren be bound in the house of your prison: go ye, carry corn for the famine of your houses:

prison having received [44 ACT 26 10](#) # Which thing I also did in Jerusalem: and many of the saints did I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I gave my voice against [them].

prison he cometh [21 ECC 04 14](#) # For out of prison he cometh to reign; whereas also [he that is] born in his kingdom becometh poor.

prison he departed [40 MAT 04 12](#) # Now when Jesus had heard that John was cast into prison, he departed into Galilee;

prison house and [07 JUD 16 25](#) # And it came to pass, when their hearts were merry, that they said, Call for Samson, that he may make us sport. And they called for Samson out of the prison house; and he made

them sport: and they set him between the pillars.

prison house for [14 2CH 16 10](#) # Then Asa was wroth with the seer, and put him in a prison house; for [he was] in a rage with him because of this [thing]. And Asa oppressed [some] of the people the same time.

prison house [23 ISA 42 07](#) # To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, [and] them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

prison house [07 JUD 16 21](#) # But the Philistines took him, and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza, and bound him with fetters of brass; and he did grind in the prison house.

prison houses they [23 ISA 42 22](#) # But this [is] a people robbed and spoiled; [they are] all of them snared in holes, and they are hid in prison houses: they are for a prey, and none delivereth; for a spoil, and none saith, Restore.

prison in the [24 JER 37 15](#) # Wherefore the princes were wroth with Jeremiah, and smote him, and put him in prison in the house of Jonathan the scribe: for they had made that the prison.

prison Jesus came [41 MAR 01 14](#) # Now after that John was put in prison, Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God,

prison looked not [01 GEN 39 23](#) # The keeper of the prison looked not to any thing [that was] under his hand; because the LORD was with him, and [that] which he did, the LORD made [it] to prosper.

prison saying [24 JER 33 01](#) # Moreover the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah the second time, while he was yet shut up in the court of the prison, saying,

prison saying [24 JER 39 15](#) # Now the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah, while he was shut up in the court of the prison, saying,

prison that I [19 PSA 142 07](#) # Bring my soul out of prison, that I may praise thy name: the righteous shall compass me about; for thou shalt deal bountifully with me.

prison that ye [66 REV 02 10](#) # Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer: behold, the devil shall cast [some] of you into prison, that ye may be tried; and ye shall have tribulation ten days: be thou faithful unto death, and I will give thee a crown of life.

prison that your [01 GEN 42 16](#) # Send one of you, and let him fetch your brother, and ye shall be kept in prison, that your words may be proved, whether [there be any] truth in you: or else by the life of Pharaoh surely ye [are] spies.

prison the place [01 GEN 40 03](#) # And he put them in ward in the house of the captain of the guard, into the prison, the place where Joseph [was] bound.

prison the works [40 MAT 11 02](#) # Now when John had heard in the prison the works of Christ, he sent two of his disciples,

prison they returned [44 ACT 05 22](#) # But when the officers came, and found them not in the prison, they returned, and told,

prison till he [40 MAT 18 30](#) # And he would not: but went and cast him into prison, till he should pay the debt.

prison till the [24 JER 52 11](#) # Then he put out the eyes of Zedekiah; and the king of Babylon bound him in chains, and carried him to Babylon, and put him in prison till the day of his death.

prison to have [44 ACT 05 21](#) # And when they heard [that], they entered into the temple early in the morning, and taught. But the high priest came, and they that were with him, and called the council together, and all the senate of the children of Israel, and sent to the prison to have them brought.

prison to them [23 ISA 61 01](#) # The spirit of the Lord GOD [is] upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to [them that are] bound;

prison told this [44 ACT 16 36](#) # And the keeper of the prison told this saying to Paul, The magistrates have sent to let you go: now therefore depart, and go in peace.

prison truly found [44 ACT 05 23](#) # Saying, The prison truly found we shut with all safety, and the keepers standing without before the doors: but when we had opened, we found no man within.

prison until the [24 JER 38 28](#) # So Jeremiah abode in the court of the prison until the day that Jerusalem was taken: and he was [there] when Jerusalem was taken.

prison were shaken [44 ACT 16 26](#) # And suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken: and immediately all the doors were opened, and every one's bands were loosed.

prison which was [24 JER 32 02](#) # For then the king of Babylon's army besieged Jerusalem: and Jeremiah the prophet was shut up in the court of the prison, which [was] in the king of Judah's house.

prison whom they [42 LUK 23 25](#) # And he released unto them him that for sedition and murder was cast into prison, whom they had desired; but he delivered Jesus to their will.

prison [60 1PE 03 19](#) # By which also he went and preached unto the spirits in prison;

prison [12 2KI 17 04](#) # And the king of Assyria found conspiracy in Hoshea: for he had sent messengers to So king of Egypt, and brought no present to the king of Assyria, as [he had done] year by year: therefore the king of Assyria shut him up, and bound him in prison.

prison [12 2KI 25 27](#) # And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the seven and twentieth [day] of the month, [that] Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the year that he began to reign did lift up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah out of prison;

prison [44 ACT 05 18](#) # And laid their hands on the apostles, and put them in the common prison.

prison [44 ACT 08 03](#) # As for Saul, he made havock of the church, entering into every house, and haling men and women committed [them] to prison.

prison [44 ACT 12 06](#) # And when Herod would have brought him forth, the same night Peter was sleeping between two soldiers, bound with two chains: and the keepers before the door kept the prison.

prison [01 GEN 39 20](#) # And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners [were] bound: and he was there in the prison.

prison [01 GEN 39 21](#) # But the LORD was with Joseph, and showed him mercy, and gave him favour in the sight of the keeper of the prison.

prison [01 GEN 40 05](#) # And they dreamed a dream both of them, each man his dream in one night, each man according to the interpretation of his dream, the butler and the baker of the king of Egypt, which [were] bound in the prison.

prison [24\\_JER\\_32\\_12](#) # And I gave the evidence of the purchase unto Baruch the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, in the sight of Hanameel mine uncle's [son], and in the presence of the witnesses that subscribed the book of the purchase, before all the Jews that sat in the court of the prison.

prison [24\\_JER\\_37\\_04](#) # Now Jeremiah came in and went out among the people: for they had not put him into prison.

prison [24\\_JER\\_37\\_15](#) # Wherefore the princes were wroth with Jeremiah, and smote him, and put him in prison in the house of Jonathan the scribe: for they had made that the prison.

prison [24\\_JER\\_37\\_18](#) # Moreover Jeremiah said unto king Zedekiah, What have I offended against thee, or against thy servants, or against this people, that ye have put me in prison?

prison [24\\_JER\\_37\\_21](#) # Then Zedekiah the king commanded that they should commit Jeremiah into the court of the prison, and that they should give him daily a piece of bread out of the bakers' street, until all the bread in the city were spent. Thus Jeremiah remained in the court of the prison.

prison [24\\_JER\\_38\\_13](#) # So they drew up Jeremiah with cords, and took him up out of the dungeon: and Jeremiah remained in the court of the prison.

prison [24\\_JER\\_52\\_31](#) # And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, in the five and twentieth [day] of the month, [that] Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the [first] year of his reign lifted up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah, and brought him forth out of prison,

prison [43\\_JOH\\_03\\_24](#) # For John was not yet cast into prison.

prison [42\\_LUK\\_03\\_20](#) # Added yet this above all, that he shut up John in prison.

prison [42\\_LUK\\_12\\_58](#) # When thou goest with thine adversary to the magistrate, [as thou art] in the way, give diligence that thou mayest be delivered from him; lest he hale thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and the officer cast thee into prison.

prison [42\\_LUK\\_23\\_19](#) # [Who for a certain sedition made in the city, and for murder, was cast into prison.]

prison [41\\_MAR\\_06\\_27](#) # And immediately the king sent an executioner, and commanded his head to be brought: and he went and beheaded him in the prison,

prison [40\\_MAT\\_05\\_25](#) # Agree with thine adversary quickly, whiles thou art in the way with him; lest at any time the adversary deliver thee to the judge, and the judge deliver thee to the officer, and thou be cast into prison.

prison [40\\_MAT\\_14\\_10](#) # And he sent, and beheaded John in the prison.

prison [66\\_REV\\_20\\_07](#) # And when the thousand years are expired, Satan shall be loosed out of his prison,

prisoner and not [44\\_ACT\\_25\\_27](#) # For it seemeth to me unreasonable to send a prisoner, and not withal to signify the crimes [laid] against him.

prisoner but be [55\\_2TI\\_01\\_08](#) # Be not thou therefore ashamed of the testimony of our Lord, nor of me his prisoner: but be thou partaker of the afflictions of the gospel according to the power of God;

prisoner called Barabbas [40\\_MAT\\_27\\_16](#) # And they had then a notable prisoner, called Barabbas.

prisoner called me [44 ACT 23 18](#) # So he took him, and brought [him] to the chief captain, and said, Paul the prisoner called me unto [him], and prayed me to bring this young man unto thee, who hath something to say unto thee.

prisoner come before [19 PSA 79 11](#) # Let the sighing of the prisoner come before thee; according to the greatness of thy power preserve thou those that are appointed to die;

prisoner from Jerusalem [44 ACT 28 17](#) # And it came to pass, that after three days Paul called the chief of the Jews together: and when they were come together, he said unto them, Men [and] brethren, though I have committed nothing against the people, or customs of our fathers, yet was I delivered prisoner from Jerusalem into the hands of the Romans.

prisoner of Jesus [49 EPH 03 01](#) # For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles,

prisoner of Jesus [57 PHM 01 01](#) # Paul, a prisoner of Jesus Christ, and Timothy [our] brother, unto Philemon our dearly beloved, and fellowlabourer,

prisoner of Jesus [57 PHM 01 09](#) # Yet for love's sake I rather beseech [thee], being such an one as Paul the aged, and now also a prisoner of Jesus Christ.

prisoner of the [49 EPH 04 01](#) # I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that ye walk worthy of the vocation wherewith ye are called,

prisoner to loose [19 PSA 102 20](#) # To hear the groaning of the prisoner; to loose those that are appointed to death;

prisoner whom they [40 MAT 27 15](#) # Now at [that] feast the governor was wont to release unto the people a prisoner, whom they would.

prisoner whomsoever they [41 MAR 15 06](#) # Now at [that] feast he released unto them one prisoner, whomsoever they desired.

prisoners and the [23 ISA 20 04](#) # So shall the king of Assyria lead away the Egyptians prisoners, and the Ethiopians captives, young and old, naked and barefoot, even with [their] buttocks uncovered, to the shame of Egypt.

prisoners and they [23 ISA 10 04](#) # Without me they shall bow down under the prisoners, and they shall fall under the slain. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.

prisoners are gathered [23 ISA 24 22](#) # And they shall be gathered together, [as] prisoners are gathered in the pit, and shall be shut up in the prison, and after many days shall they be visited.

prisoners from the [23 ISA 42 07](#) # To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, [and] them that sit in darkness out of the prison house.

prisoners Go forth [23 ISA 49 09](#) # That thou mayest say to the prisoners, Go forth; to them that [are] in darkness, Show yourselves. They shall feed in the ways, and their pastures [shall be] in all high places.

prisoners had been [44 ACT 16 27](#) # And the keeper of the prison awaking out of his sleep, and seeing the prison doors open, he drew out his sword, and would have killed himself, supposing that the prisoners had been fled.

prisoners heard them [44 ACT 16 25](#) # And at midnight Paul and Silas prayed, and sang praises unto God: and the prisoners heard them.

prisoners lest any [44 ACT 27 42](#) # And the soldiers' counsel was to kill the prisoners, lest any of them should swim out, and escape.

prisoners of hope [38 ZEC 09 12](#) # Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners of hope: even to day do I declare [that] I will render double unto thee;

prisoners of the [25 LAM 03 34](#) # To crush under his feet all the prisoners of the earth,

prisoners out of [38 ZEC 09 11](#) # As for thee also, by the blood of thy covenant I have sent forth thy prisoners out of the pit wherein [is] no water.

prisoners rest together [18 JOB 03 18](#) # [There] the prisoners rest together; they hear not the voice of the oppressor.

prisoners that were [01 GEN 39 22](#) # And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners that [were] in the prison; and whatsoever they did there, he was the doer [of it].

prisoners to the [44 ACT 28 16](#) # And when we came to Rome, the centurion delivered the prisoners to the captain of the guard: but Paul was suffered to dwell by himself with a soldier that kept him.

prisoners unto one [44 ACT 27 01](#) # And when it was determined that we should sail into Italy, they delivered Paul and certain other prisoners unto [one] named Julius, a centurion of Augustus' band.

prisoners were bound [01 GEN 39 20](#) # And Joseph's master took him, and put him into the prison, a place where the king's prisoners [were] bound: and he was there in the prison.

prisoners [23 ISA 14 17](#) # [That] made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed the cities thereof; [that] opened not the house of his prisoners?

prisoners [04 NUM 21 01](#) # And [when] king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south, heard tell that Israel came by the way of the spies; then he fought against Israel, and took [some] of them prisoners.

prisoners [19 PSA 146 07](#) # Which executeth judgment for the oppressed: which giveth food to the hungry. The LORD looseth the prisoners:

prisoners [19 PSA 69 33](#) # For the LORD heareth the poor, and despiseth not his prisoners.

prisons being brought [42 LUK 21 12](#) # But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute [you], delivering [you] up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake.

prisons both men [44 ACT 22 04](#) # And I persecuted this way unto the death, binding and delivering into prisons both men and women.

prisons more frequent [47 2CO 11 23](#) # Are they ministers of Christ? [I speak as a fool] I [am] more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.
