safely all of [26 EZE 38 08](#) # After many days thou shalt be visited: in the latter years thou shalt come into the land [that is] brought back from the sword, [and is] gathered out of many people, against the mountains of Israel, which have been always waste: but it is brought forth out of the nations, and they shall dwell safely all of them.

safely all of [26 EZE 38 11](#) # And thou shalt say, I will go up to the land of unwalled villages; I will go to them that are at rest, that dwell safely, all of them dwelling without walls, and having neither bars nor gates,

safely and none [26 EZE 34 28](#) # And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make [them] afraid.

safely and shall [20 PRO 01 33](#) # But whoso hearkeneth unto me shall dwell safely, and shall be quiet from fear of evil.

safely and this [24 JER 23 06](#) # In his days Judah shall be saved, and Israel shall dwell safely: and this [is] his name whereby he shall be called, THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.

safely and this [24 JER 33 16](#) # In those days shall Judah be saved, and Jerusalem shall dwell safely: and this [is the name] wherewith she shall be called, The LORD our righteousness.

safely and thy [20 PRO 03 23](#) # Then shalt thou walk in thy way safely, and thy foot shall not stumble.

safely even by [23 ISA 41 03](#) # He pursued them, [and] passed safely; [even] by the way [that] he had not gone with his feet.

safely every man [11 IKI 04 25](#) # And Judah and Israel dwelt safely, every man under his vine and under his fig tree, from Dan even to Beersheba, all the days of Solomon.

safely in the [26 EZE 34 25](#) # And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the wilderness, and sleep in the woods.

safely in their [26 EZE 39 26](#) # After that they have borne their shame, and all their trespasses whereby they have trespassed against me, when they dwelt safely in their land, and none made [them] afraid.

safely inhabited [38 ZEC 14 11](#) # And [men] shall dwell in it, and there shall be no more utter destruction; but Jerusalem shall be safely inhabited.

safely shalt thou [26 EZE 38 14](#) # Therefore, son of man, prophesy and say unto Gog, Thus saith the Lord GOD; In that day when my people of Israel dwelleth safely, shalt thou not know [it]?

safely so that [19 PSA 78 53](#) # And he led them on safely, so that they feared not: but the sea overwhelmed their enemies.

safely therein and [26 EZE 28 26](#) # And they shall dwell safely therein, and shall build houses, and plant vineyards; yea, they shall dwell with confidence, when I have executed judgments upon all those that despise them round about them; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD their God.

safely trust in [20 PRO 31 11](#) # The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil.

safely [44 ACT 16 23](#) # And when they had laid many stripes upon them, they cast [them] into prison, charging the jailor to keep them safely:

safely [28 HOS 02 18](#) # And in that day will I make a covenant for them with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven, and [with] the creeping things of the ground: and I will break the bow and the sword and the battle out of the earth, and will make them to lie down safely.

safely [24 JER 32 37](#) # Behold, I will gather them out of all countries, whither I have driven them in mine anger, and in my fury, and in great wrath; and I will bring them again unto this place, and I will cause them to dwell safely:

safely [03 LEV 26 05](#) # And your threshing shall reach unto the vintage, and the vintage shall reach unto the sowing time: and ye shall eat your bread to the full, and dwell in your land safely.

safely [41 MAR 14 44](#) # And he that betrayed him had given them a token, saying, Whomsoever I shall kiss, that same is he; take him, and lead [him] away safely.
