tarry a while [46_1CO_16_07](#) # For I will not see you now by the way; but I trust to tarry a while with you, if the Lord permit.

tarry abroad out [03_LEV_14_08](#) # And he that is to be cleansed shall wash his clothes, and shave off all his hair, and wash himself in water, that he may be clean: and after that he shall come into the camp, and shall tarry abroad out of his tent seven days.

tarry all night [01_GEN_19_02](#) # And he said, Behold now, my lords, turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and tarry all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall rise up early, and go on your ways. And they said, Nay; but we will abide in the street all night.

tarry all night [07_JUD_19_06](#) # And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine heart be merry.

tarry all night [07_JUD_19_09](#) # And when the man rose up to depart, he, and his concubine, and his servant, his father in law, the damsel's father, said unto him, Behold, now the day draweth toward evening, I pray you tarry all night: behold, the day groweth to an end, lodge here, that thine heart may be merry; and to morrow get you early on your way, that thou mayest go home.

tarry and I [23_ISA_46_13](#) # I bring near my righteousness: it shall not be far off, and my salvation shall not tarry: and I will place salvation in Zion for Israel my glory.

tarry at Ephesus [46_1CO_16_08](#) # But I will tarry at Ephesus until Pentecost.

tarry at home [12_2KI_14_10](#) # Thou hast indeed smitten Edom, and thine heart hath lifted thee up: glory [of this], and tarry at home: for why shouldest thou meddle to [thy] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

Tarry at Jericho [13_1CH_19_05](#) # Then there went [certain], and told David how the men were served. And he sent to meet them: for the men were greatly ashamed. And the king said, Tarry at Jericho until your beards be grown, and [then] return.

Tarry at Jericho [10_2SA_10_05](#) # When they told [it] unto David, he sent to meet them, because the men were greatly ashamed: and the king said, Tarry at Jericho until your beards be grown, and [then] return.

tarry certain days [44_ACT_10_48](#) # And he commanded them to be baptized in the name of the Lord. Then prayed they him to tarry certain days.

tarry for a [24_JER_14_08](#) # O the hope of Israel, the saviour thereof in time of trouble, why shouldest thou be as a stranger in the land, and as a wayfaring man [that] turneth aside to tarry for a night?

tarry for I [01_GEN_30_27](#) # And Laban said unto him, I pray thee, if I have found favour in thine eyes, [tarry: for] I have learned by experience that the LORD hath blessed me for thy sake.

tarry for them [08_RUT_01_13](#) # Would ye tarry for them till they were grown? would ye stay for them from having husbands? nay, my daughters; for it grieveth me much for your sakes that the hand of the LORD is gone out against me.

Tarry here I [12 2KI 02 02](#) # And Elijah said unto Elisha, Tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Bethel. And Elisha said [unto him, As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they went down to Bethel.

tarry here I [12 2KI 02 04](#) # And Elijah said unto him, Elisha, tarry here, I pray thee; for the LORD hath sent me to Jericho. And he said, [As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. So they came to Jericho.

Tarry here to [10 2SA 11 12](#) # And David said to Uriah, Tarry here to day also, and to morrow I will let thee depart. So Uriah abode in Jerusalem that day, and the morrow.

Tarry I pray [12 2KI 02 06](#) # And Elijah said unto him, Tarry, I pray thee, here; for the LORD hath sent me to Jordan. And he said, [As] the LORD liveth, and [as] thy soul liveth, I will not leave thee. And they two went on.

tarry in my [19 PSA 101 07](#) # He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house: he that telleth lies shall not tarry in my sight.

tarry in the [10 2SA 15 28](#) # See, I will tarry in the plain of the wilderness, until there come word from you to certify me.

tarry long at [20 PRO 23 30](#) # They that tarry long at the wine; they that go to seek mixed wine.

tarry long that [54 1TI 03 15](#) # But if I tarry long, that thou mayest know how thou oughtest to behave thyself in the house of God, which is the church of the living God, the pillar and ground of the truth.

tarry longer time [44 ACT 18 20](#) # When they desired [him] to tarry longer time with them, he consented not;

tarry neither had [02 EXO 12 39](#) # And they baked unleavened cakes of the dough which they brought forth out of Egypt, for it was not leavened; because they were thrust out of Egypt, and could not tarry, neither had they prepared for themselves any victual.

tarry not [12 2KI 09 03](#) # Then take the box of oil, and pour [it] on his head, and say, Thus saith the LORD, I have anointed thee king over Israel. Then open the door, and flee, and tarry not.

tarry not [01 GEN 45 09](#) # Haste ye, and go up to my father, and say unto him, Thus saith thy son Joseph, God hath made me lord of all Egypt: come down unto me, tarry not:

tarry one for [46 1CO 11 33](#) # Wherefore, my brethren, when ye come together to eat, tarry one for another.

tarry one with [10 2SA 19 07](#) # Now therefore arise, go forth, and speak comfortably unto thy servants: for I swear by the LORD, if thou go not forth, there will not tarry one with thee this night: and that will be worse unto thee than all the evil that befell thee from thy youth until now.

tarry that night [07 JUD 19 10](#) # But the man would not tarry that night, but he rose up and departed, and came over against Jebus, which [is] Jerusalem; and [there were] with him two asses saddled, his concubine also [was] with him.

Tarry this night [08 RUT 03 13](#) # Tarry this night, and it shall be in the morning, [that] if he will perform

unto thee the part of a kinsman, well; let him do the kinsman's part: but if he will not do the part of a kinsman to thee, then will I do the part of a kinsman to thee, [as] the LORD liveth: lie down until the morning.

tarry thus with [10 2SA 18 14](#) # Then said Joab, I may not tarry thus with thee. And he took three darts in his hand, and thrust them through the heart of Absalom, while he [was] yet alive in the midst of the oak.

tarry till I [09 1SA 10 08](#) # And thou shalt go down before me to Gilgal; and, behold, I will come down unto thee, to offer burnt offerings, [and] to sacrifice sacrifices of peace offerings: seven days shalt thou tarry, till I come to thee, and show thee what thou shalt do.

tarry till I [43 JOH 21 22](#) # Jesus saith unto him, If I will that he tarry till I come, what [is that] to thee? follow thou me.

tarry till I [43 JOH 21 23](#) # Then went this saying abroad among the brethren, that that disciple should not die: yet Jesus said not unto him, He shall not die; but, If I will that he tarry till I come, what [is that] to thee?

tarry till the [12 2KI 07 09](#) # Then they said one to another, We do not well: this day [is] a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace: if we tarry till the morning light, some mischief will come upon us: now therefore come, that we may go and tell the king's household.

tarry until thou [09 1SA 01 23](#) # And Elkanah her husband said unto her, Do what seemeth thee good; tarry until thou have weaned him; only the LORD establish his word. So the woman abode, and gave her son suck until she weaned him.

tarry until thou [07 JUD 06 18](#) # Depart not hence, I pray thee, until I come unto thee, and bring forth my present, and set [it] before thee. And he said, I will tarry until thou come again.

Tarry until we [09 1SA 14 09](#) # If they say thus unto us, Tarry until we come to you; then we will stand still in our place, and will not go up unto them.

tarry wait for [35 HAB 02 03](#) # For the vision [is] yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.

tarry with him [01 GEN 27 44](#) # And tarry with him a few days, until thy brother's fury turn away;

tarry with them [44 ACT 28 14](#) # Where we found brethren, and were desired to tarry with them seven days: and so we went toward Rome.

tarry with them [43 JOH 04 40](#) # So when the Samaritans were come unto him, they besought him that he would tarry with them: and he abode there two days.

tarry with them [42 LUK 24 29](#) # But they constrained him, saying, Abide with us: for it is toward evening, and the day is far spent. And he went in to tarry with them.

tarry ye also [04 NUM 22 19](#) # Now therefore, I pray you, tarry ye also here this night, that I may know what the LORD will say unto me more.

Tarry ye here [02 EXO 24 14](#) # And he said unto the elders, Tarry ye here for us, until we come again unto you: and, behold, Aaron and Hur [are] with you: if any man have any matters to do, let him come unto them.

tarry ye here [41 MAR 14 34](#) # And saith unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful unto death: tarry ye here, and watch.

tarry ye here [40 MAT 26 38](#) # Then saith he unto them, My soul is exceeding sorrowful, even unto death: tarry ye here, and watch with me.

tarry ye in [42 LUK 24 49](#) # And, behold, I send the promise of my Father upon you: but tarry ye in the city of Jerusalem, until ye be endued with power from on high.

tarry [35 HAB 02 03](#) # For the vision [is] yet for an appointed time, but at the end it shall speak, and not lie: though it tarry, wait for it; because it will surely come, it will not tarry.
