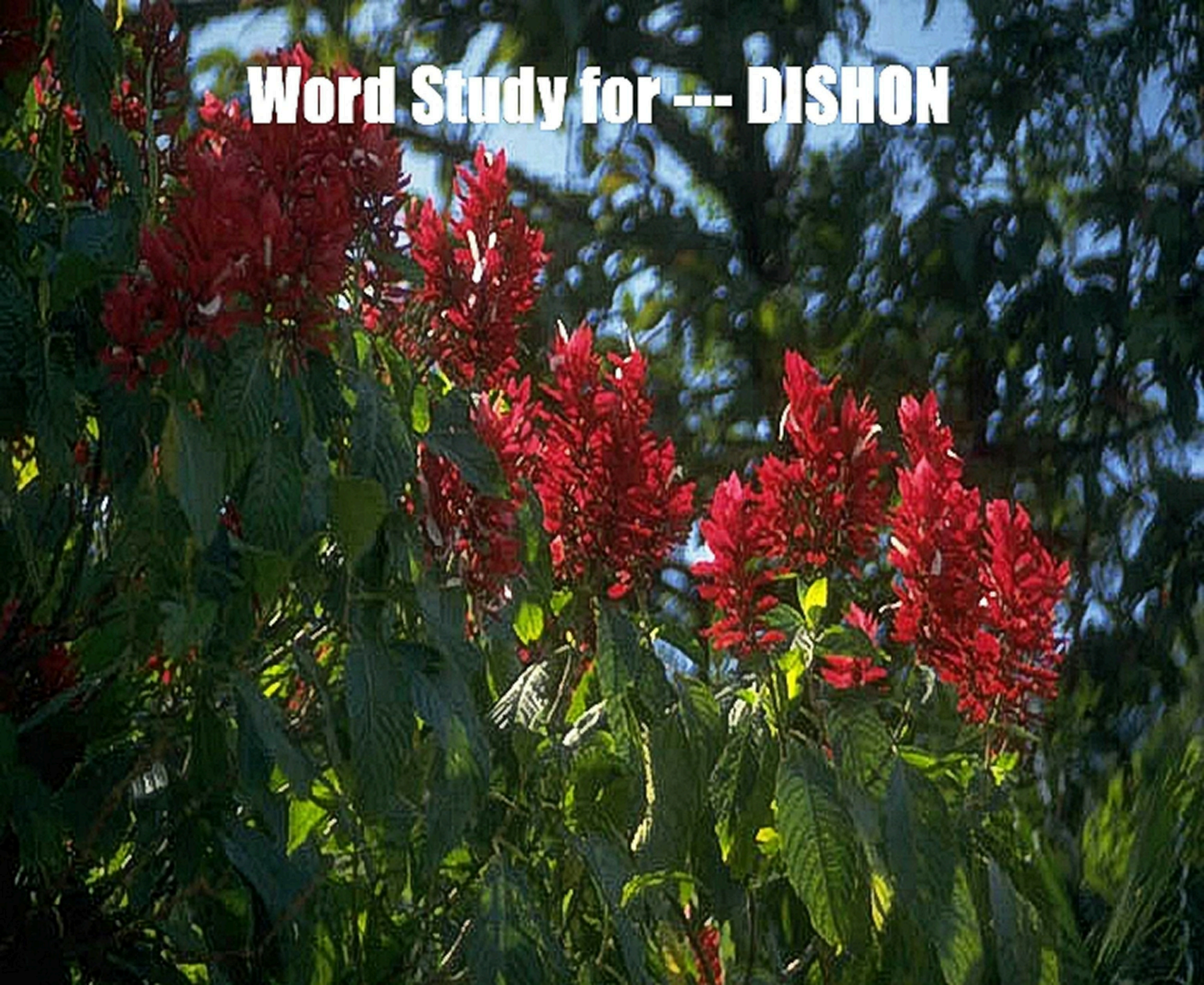

Genesis 36:25 And the children of Anah were these; Dishon, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah.

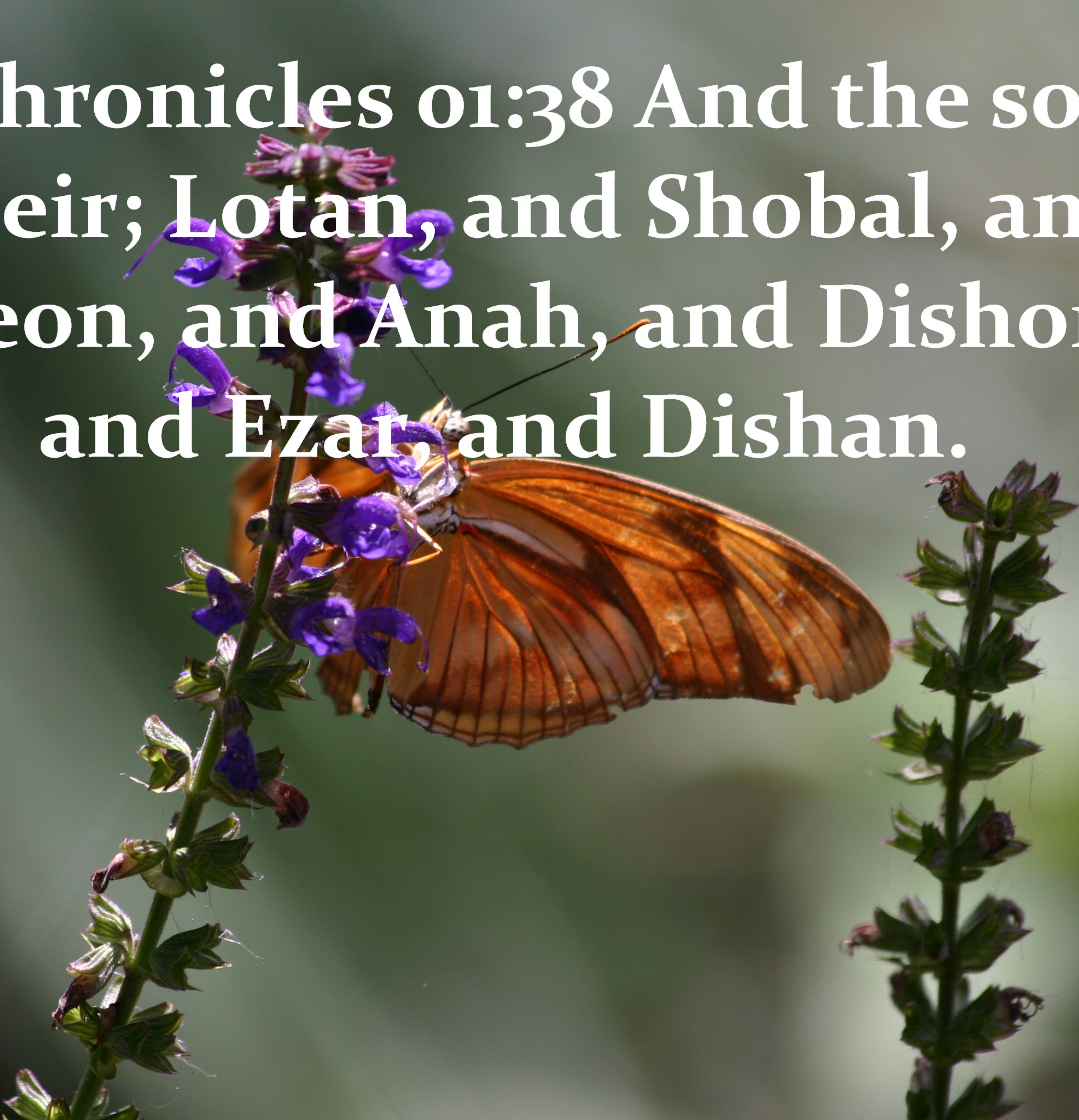
**Genesis 36:26 And these are the children of Dishon; Hemdan, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.**


