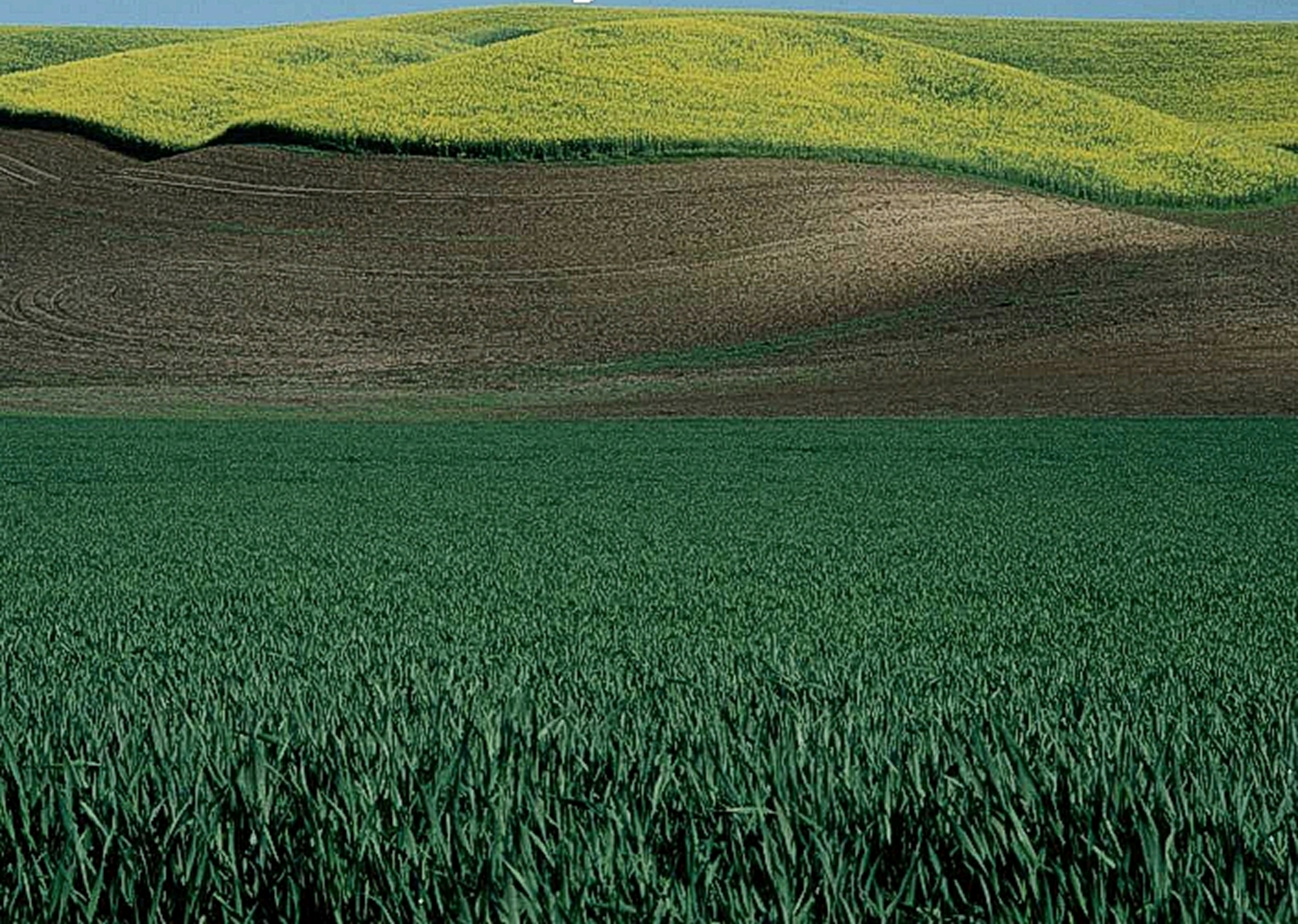




# Word Study for --- BITTERN


