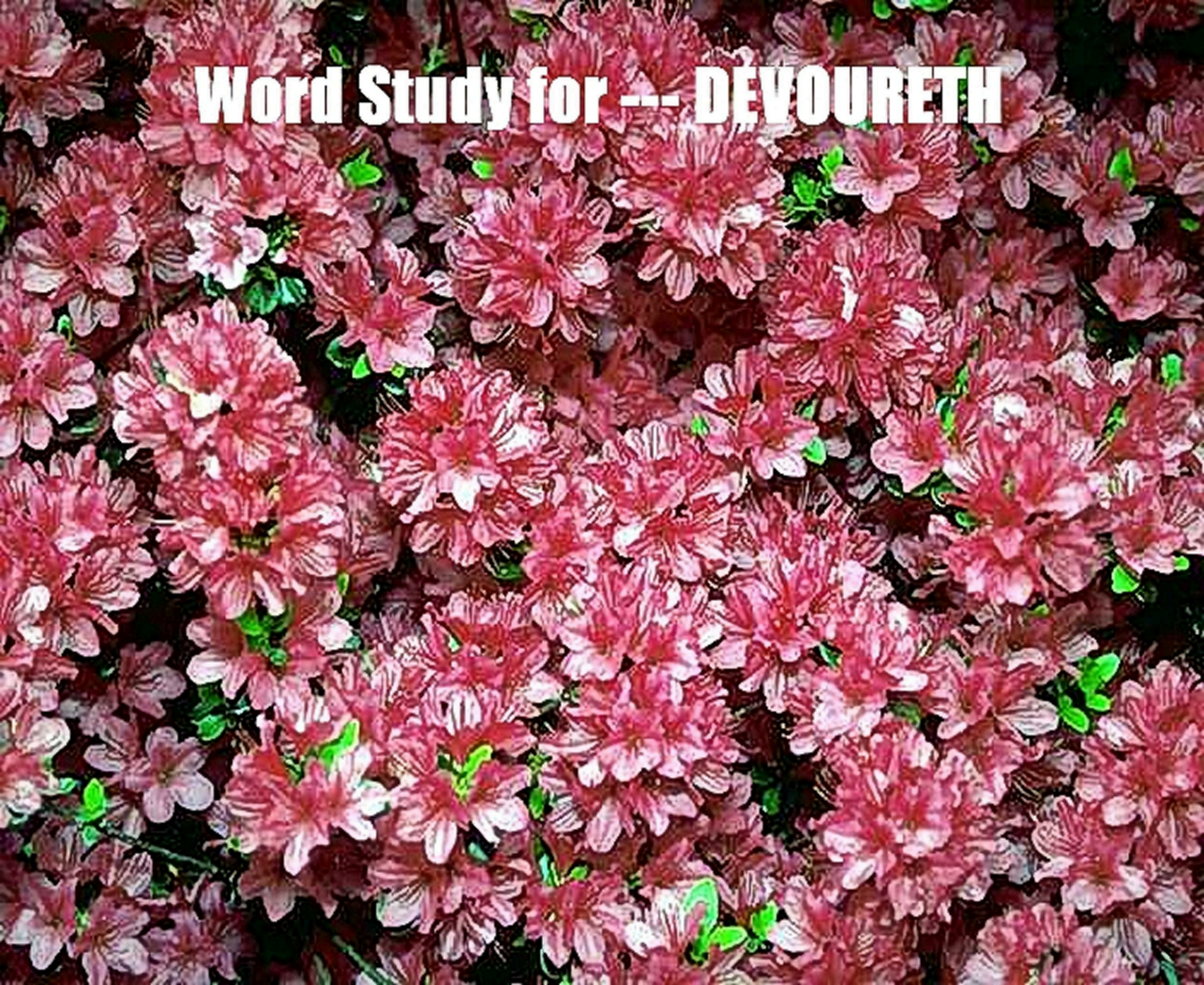



**2nd Samuel 11:25 Then David said

iniquity.**




Proverbs 20:25 It is a snare to the

of Israel.





Lamentations 02:03 He hath cut

work?**




Joel 02:03 A fire devoureth before

and nothing shall escape them.






**Joel 02:05 Like the noise of
