


# Word Study for --- FIRSTLING




**Exodus 13:12 That thou shalt set

be the LORD'S.**




**Exodus 13:13 And every firstling of

lamb; and if thou wilt not redeem

and all the firstborn of man  
among thy children shalt thou  
redeem.**

among thy cattle, whether ox or  
sheep, that is male .**



before me empty.






**Numbers 18:15 Every thing that  
openeth the matrix in all flesh,  
which they bring unto the LORD,  
whether it be of men or beasts,  
shall be thine: nevertheless the  
firstborn of man shalt thou surely  
redeem, and the firstling of  
unclean beasts shalt thou redeem.**

**Numbers 18:17 But the firstling of a cow, or the firstling of a sheep, or the firstling of a goat, thou shalt not redeem; they are holy: thou shalt sprinkle their blood upon the altar, and shalt burn their fat for an offering made by fire, for a sweet savour unto the LORD.**



Deuteronomy 15:19 All the firstling  
males that come of thy herd and of  
thy flock thou shalt sanctify unto  
the LORD thy God: thou shalt do  
no work with the firstling of thy  
bullock, nor shear the firstling of  
thy sheep.
