


**Neh 02:10 When Sanballat the
Haronite, and Tobiah the servant, the
Ammonite, heard [of it], it grieved
them exceedingly that there was
come a man to seek the welfare of the
children of Israel.**

**Neh 02:19 But when Sanballat the
Haronite, and Tobiah the servant, the
Ammonite, and Geshem the Arabian,
heard [it], they laughed us to scorn,
and despised us, and said, What [is]
this thing that ye do? will ye rebel
against the king?**

**Neh 04:01 But it came to pass, that

**Neh 06:14 My God, think thou upon
Tobiah and Sanballat according to
these their works, and on the
prophetess Noadiah, and the rest of
the prophets, that would have put me
in fear.**

**Neh 13:28 And [one] of the sons of
Joiada, the son of Eliashib the high
priest, [was] son in law to Sanballat
the Horonite: therefore I chased him
from me.**
