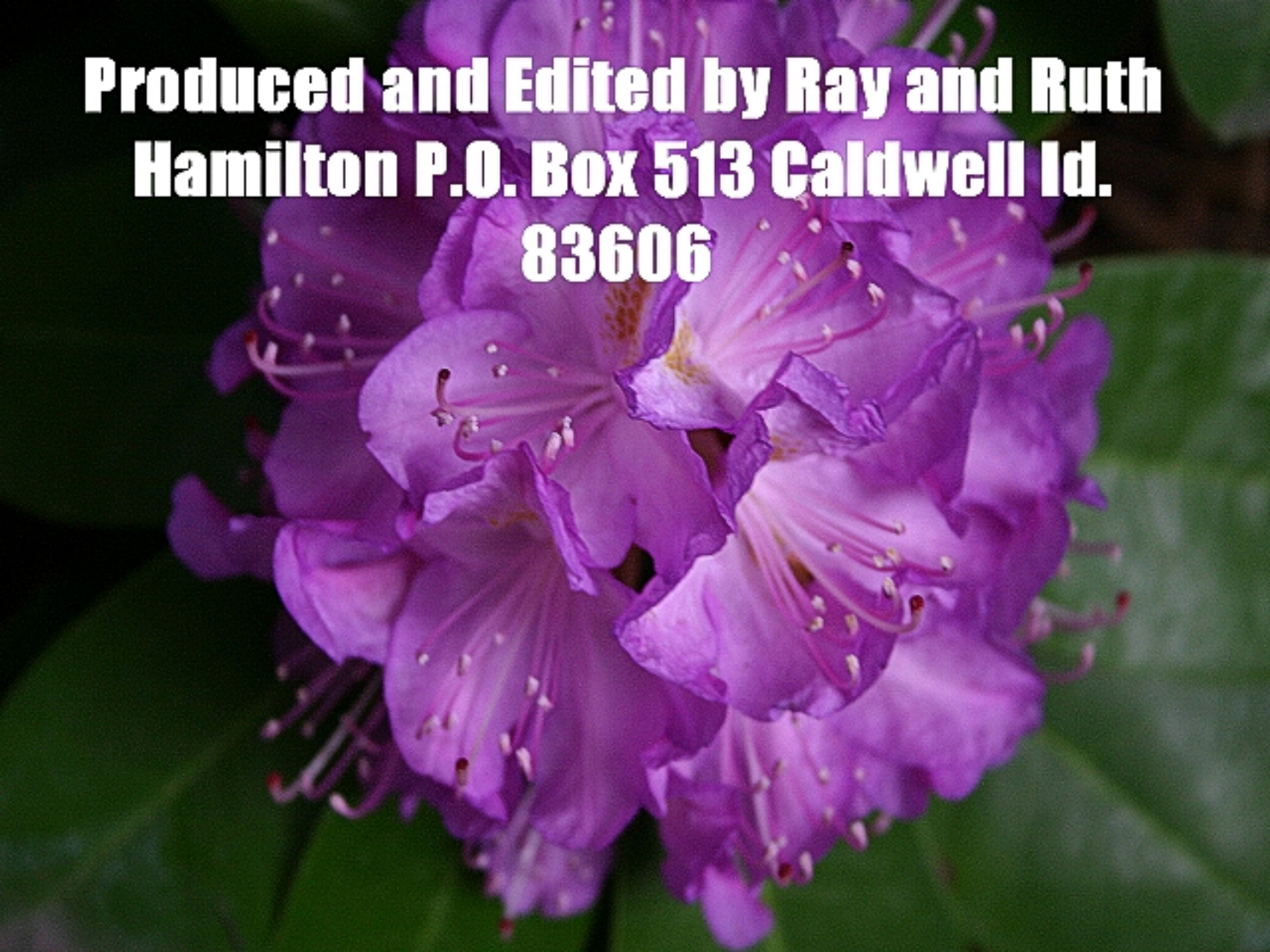


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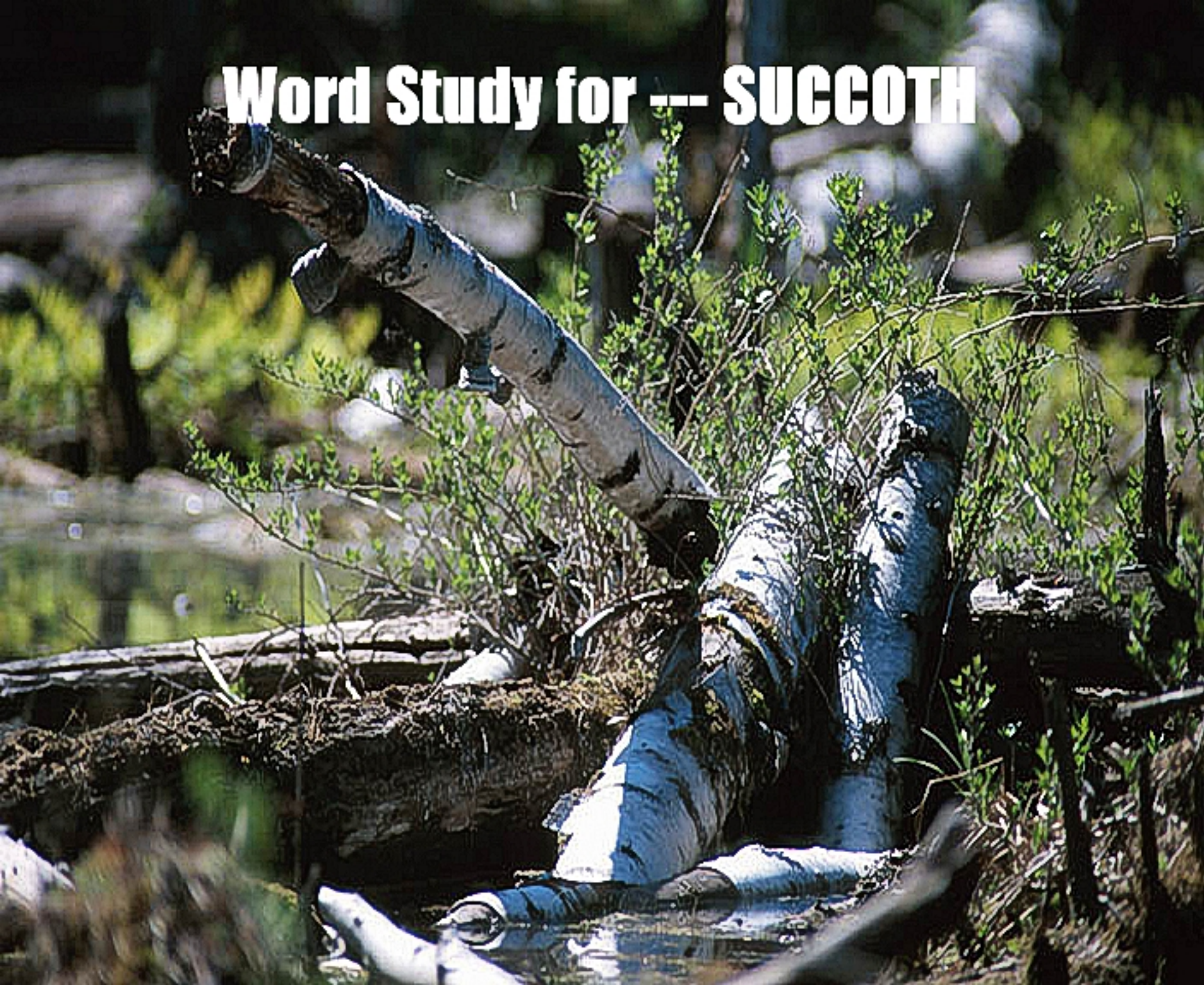
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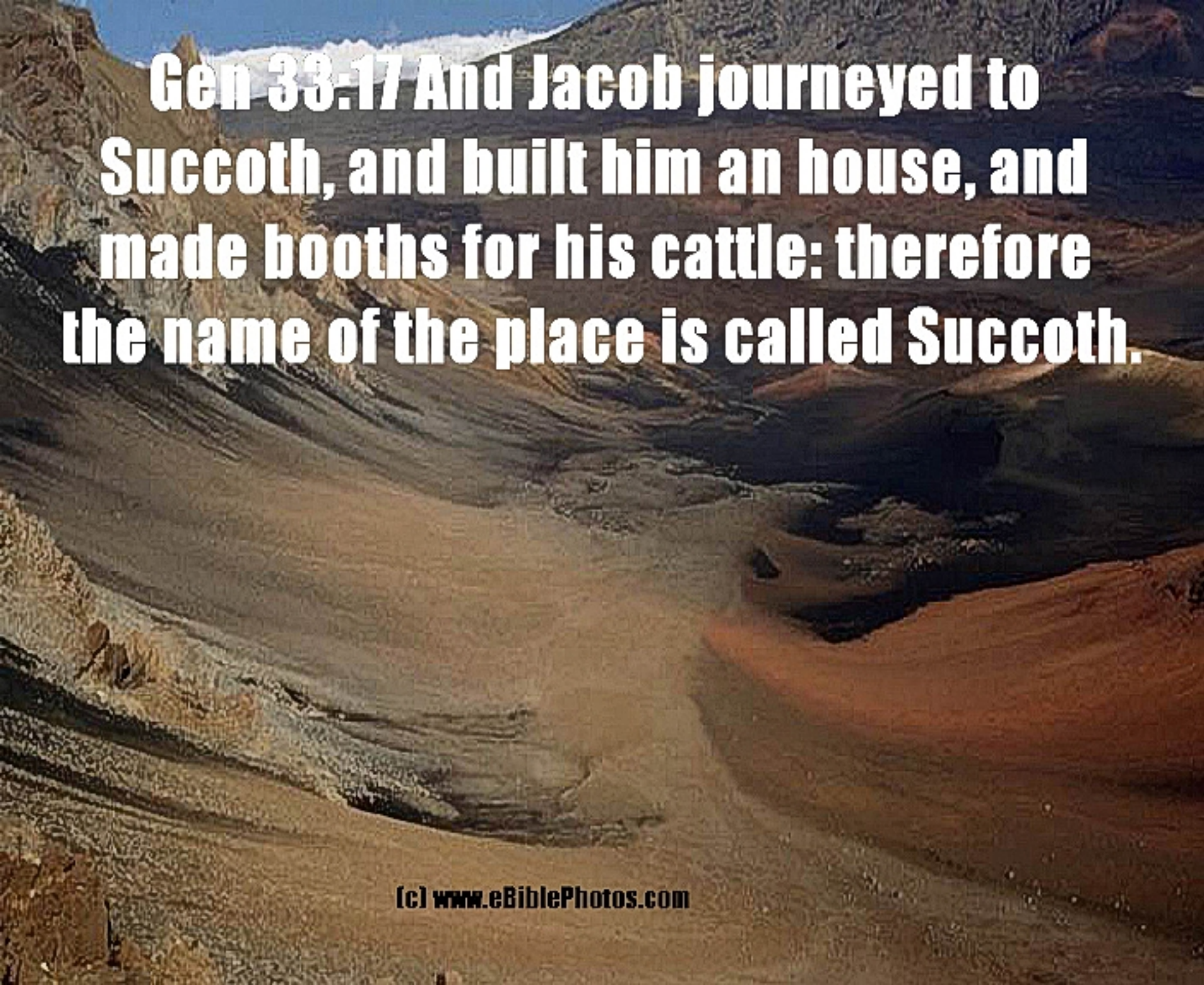




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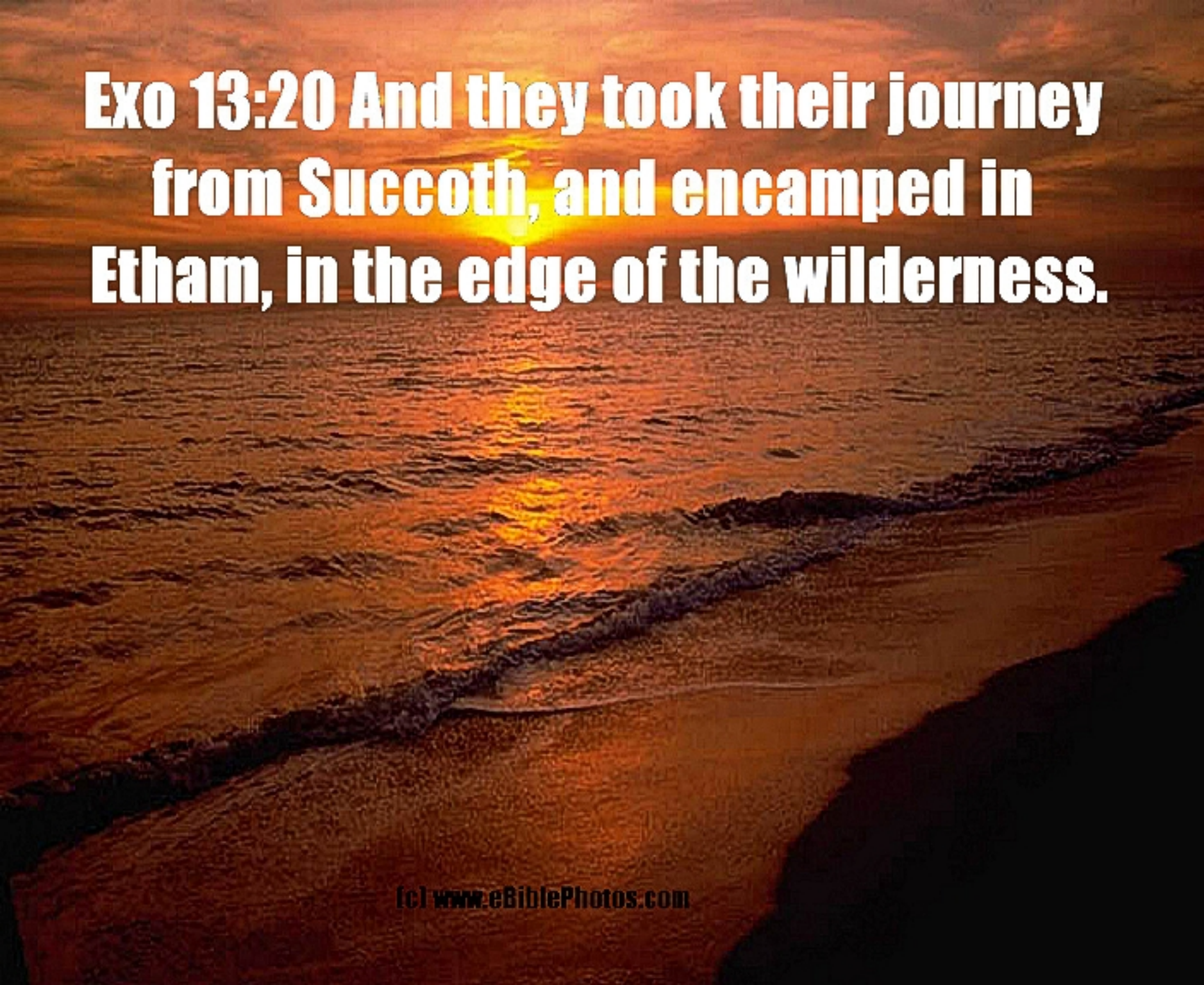
Word Study for --- SUCCOTH



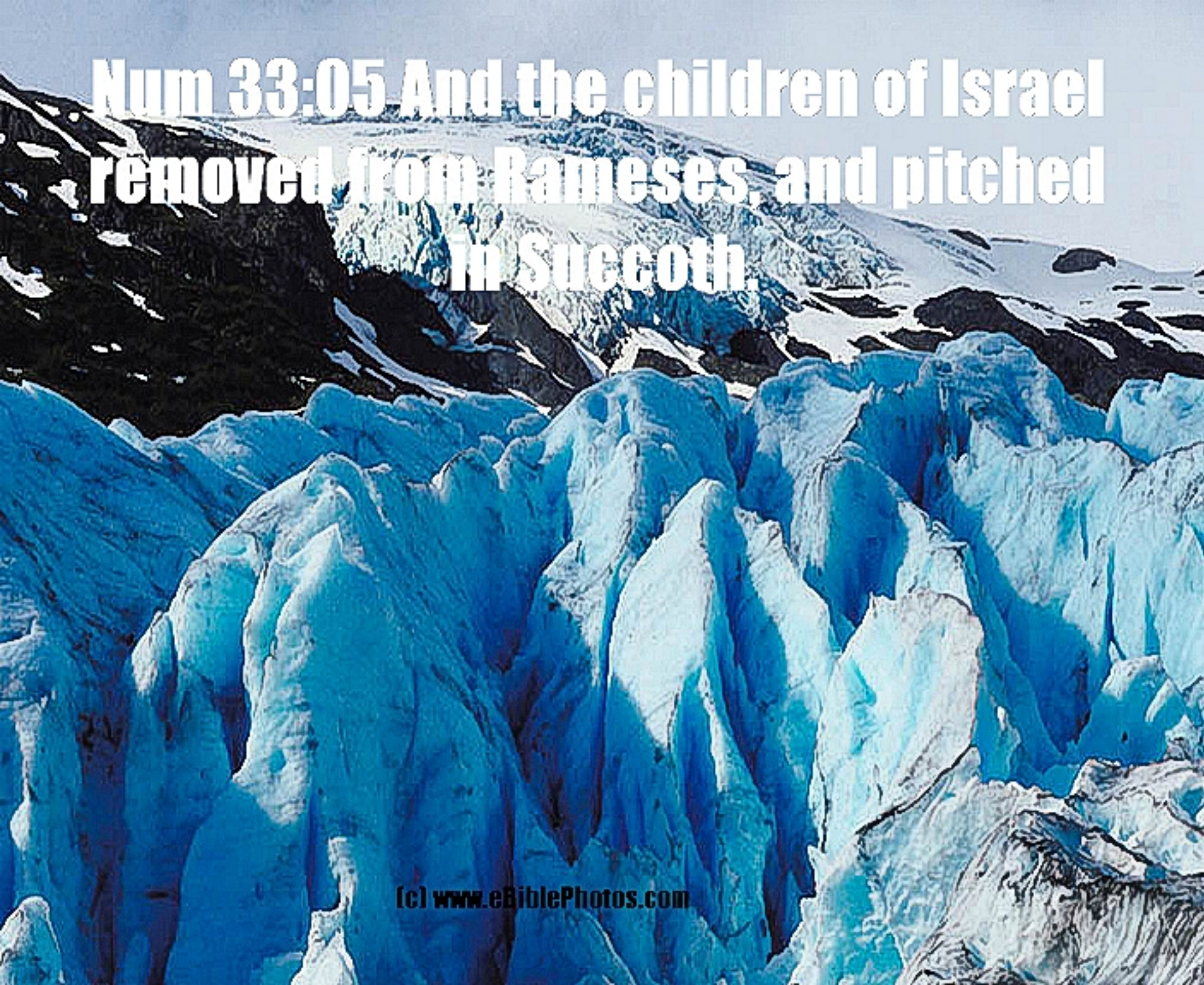

Exo 12:37 And the children of Israel journeyed from Rameses to Succoth, about six hundred thousand on foot that were men, beside children.

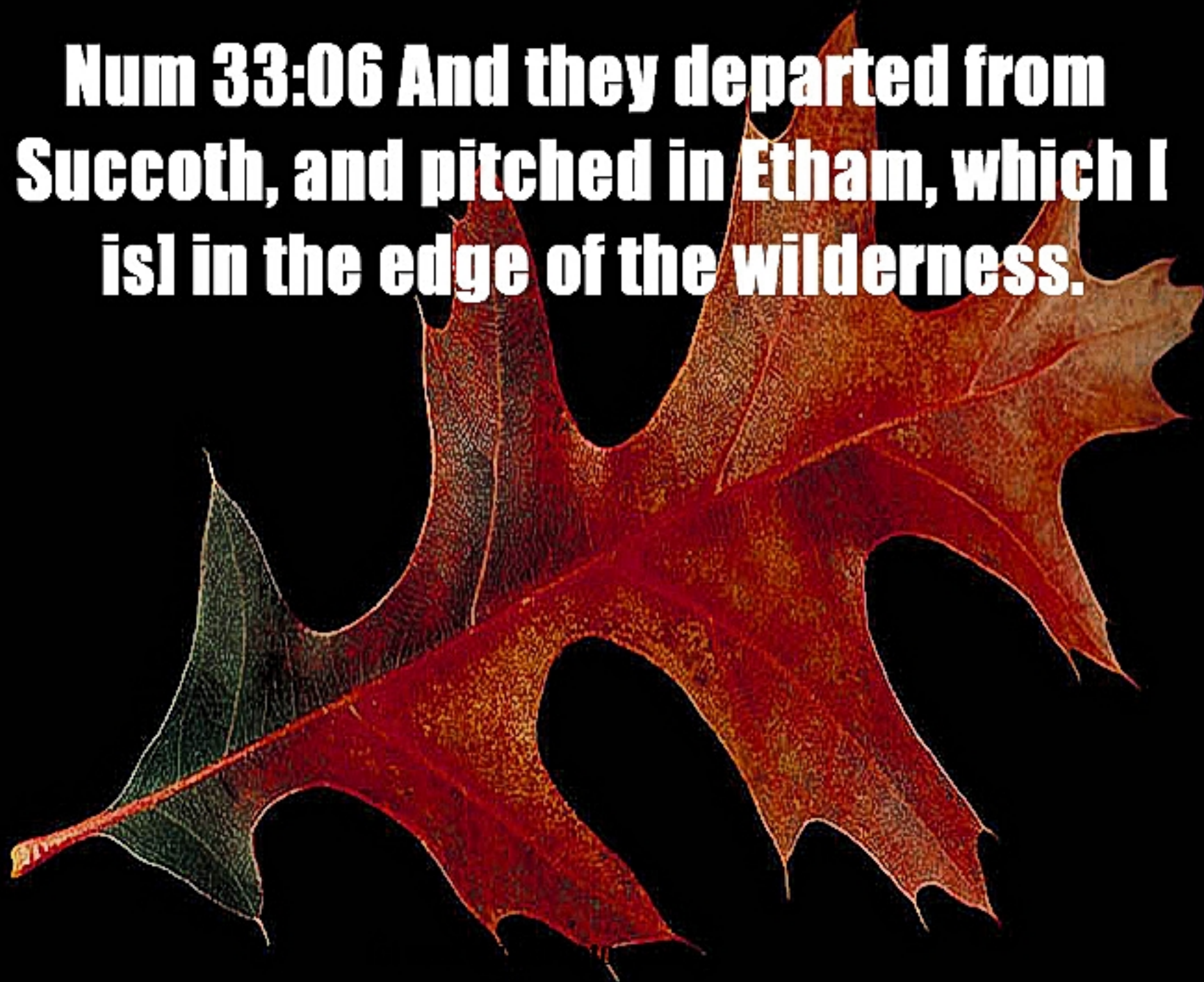

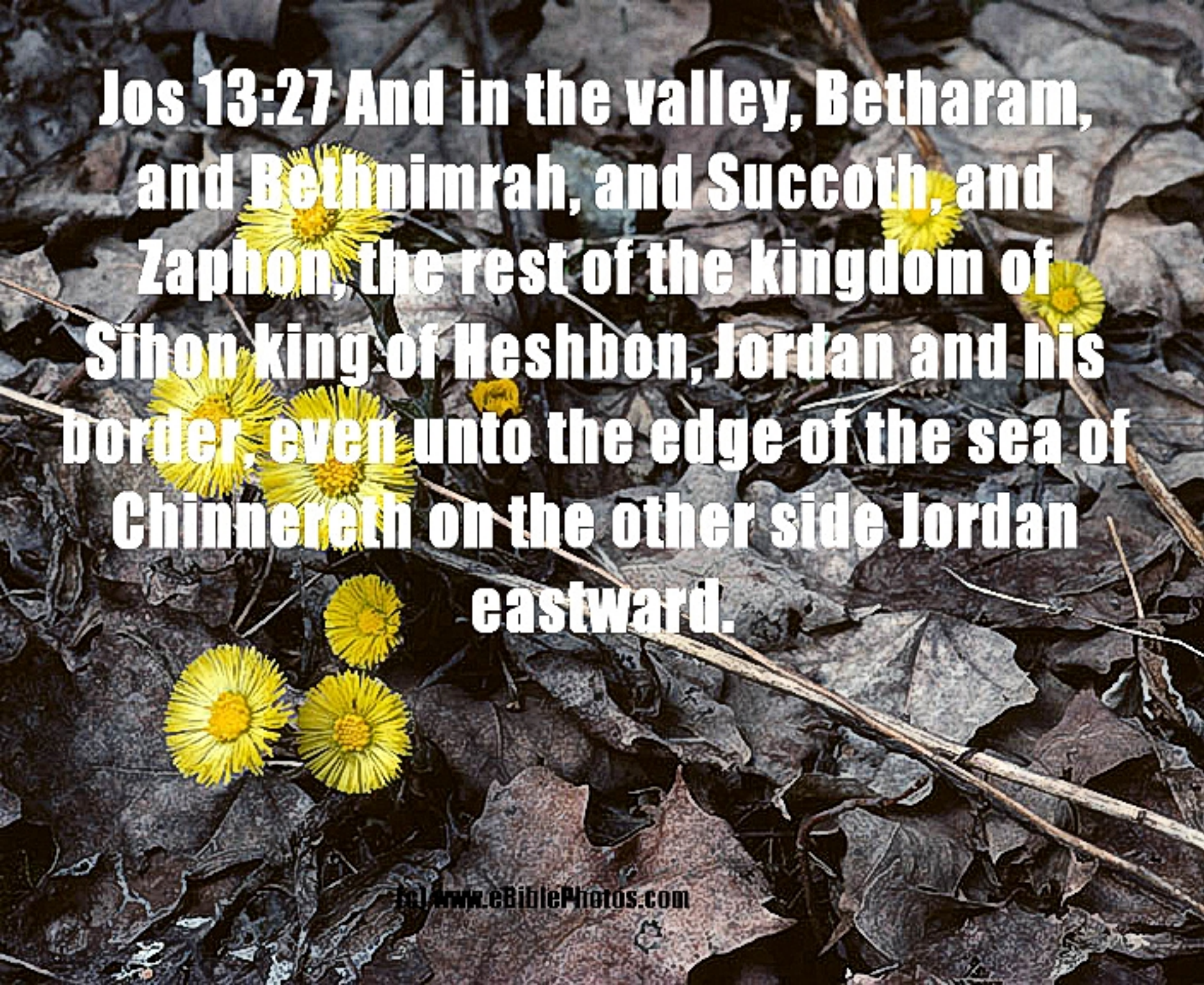

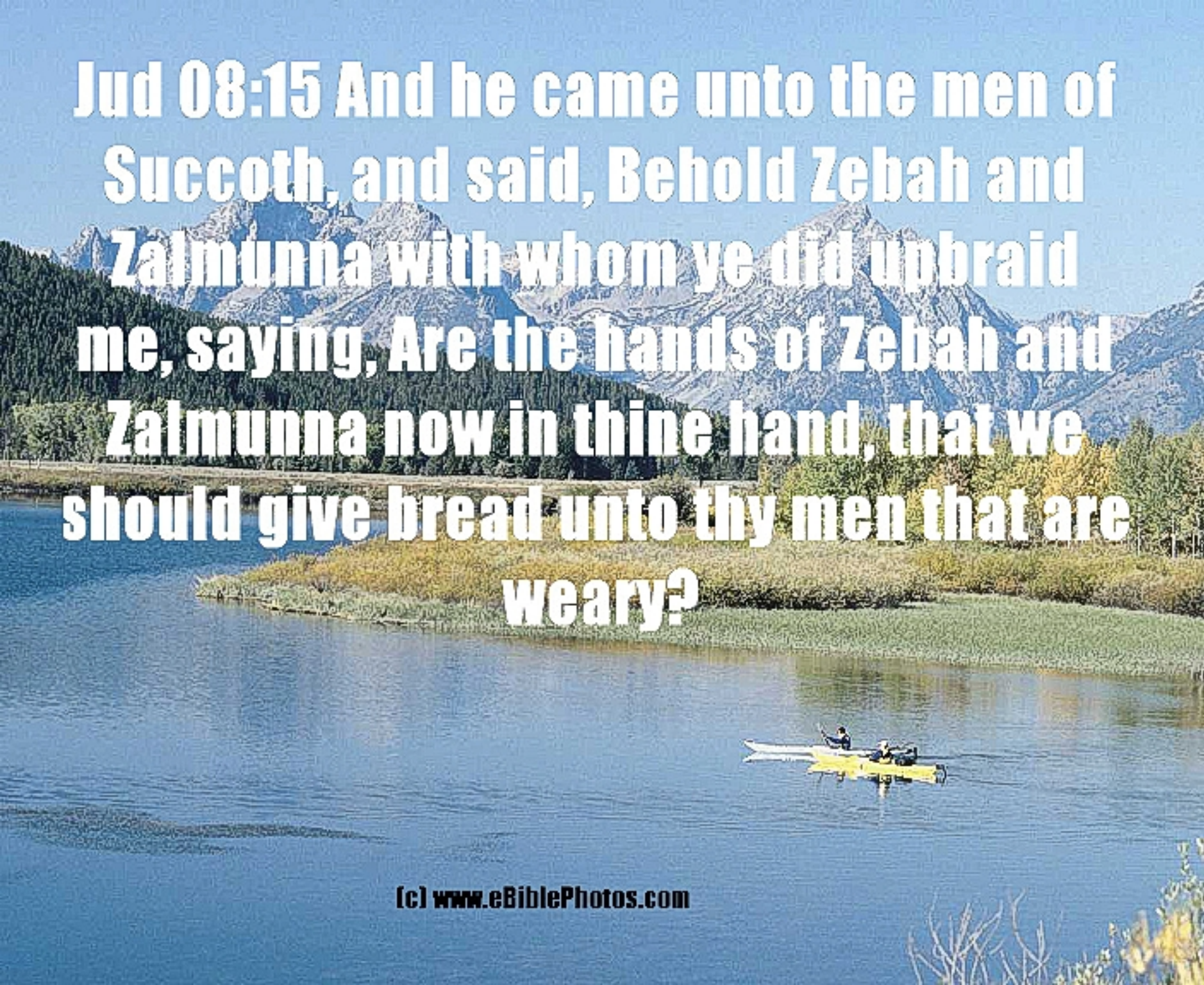
**Jos 13:27 And in the valley, Betharam,
