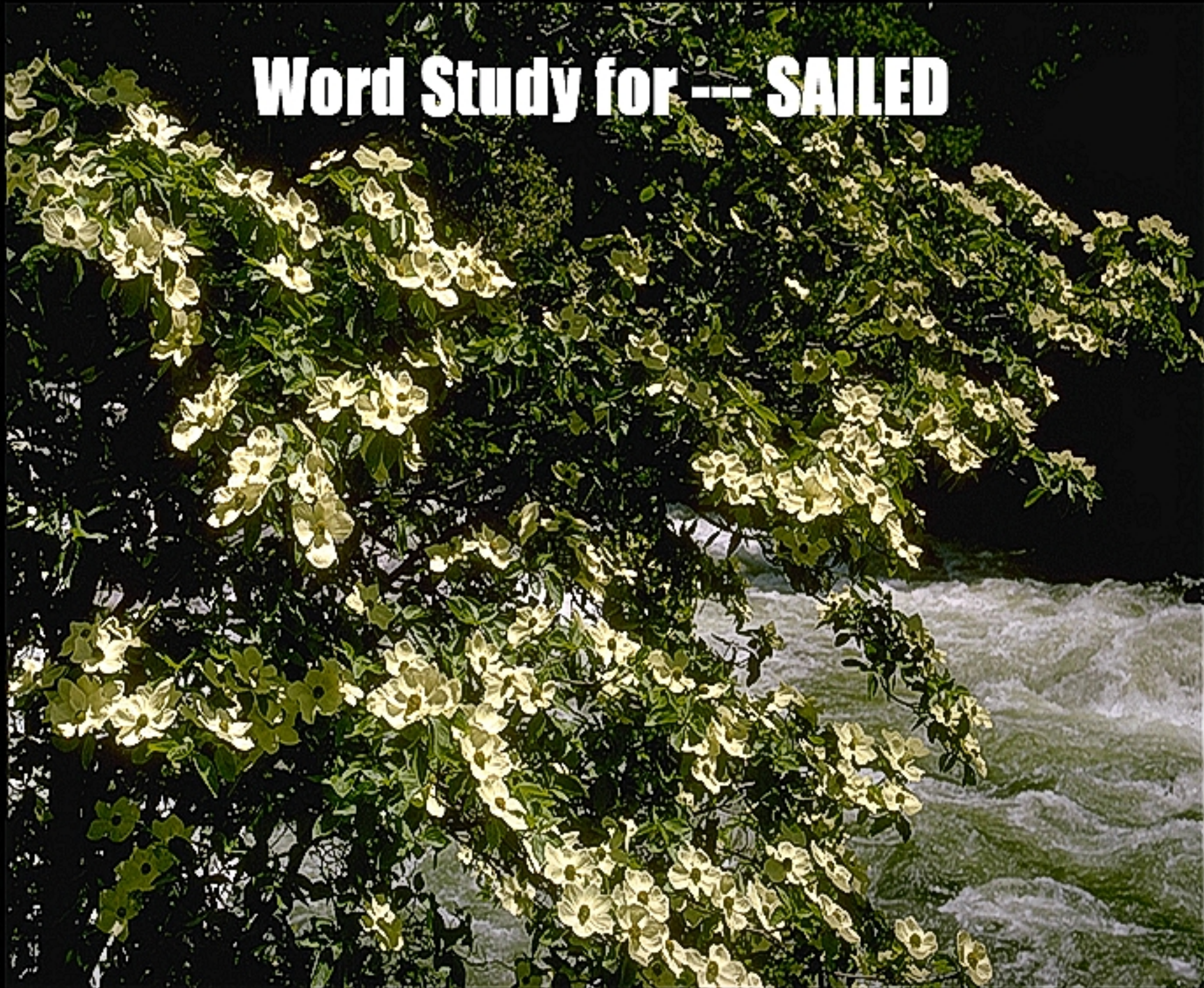








Luk 08:23 But as they sailed he fell asleep: and there came down a storm of wind on the lake; and they were filled [with water], and were in jeopardy.




**Act 13:04 So they, being sent forth by


**Act 20:15 And we sailed thence, and
