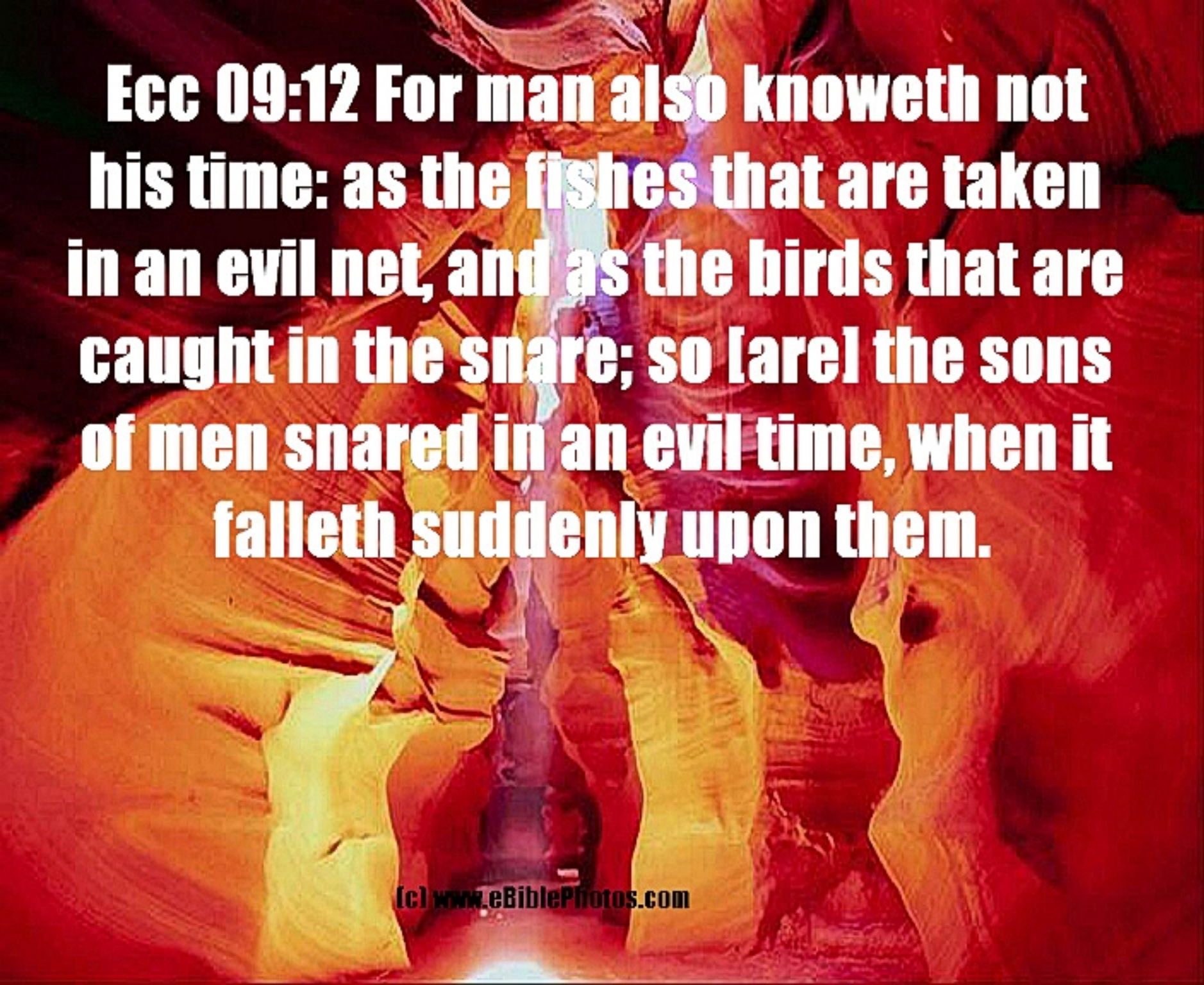
**Psa 09:16 The LORD is known [by] the

shall come out of trouble.**

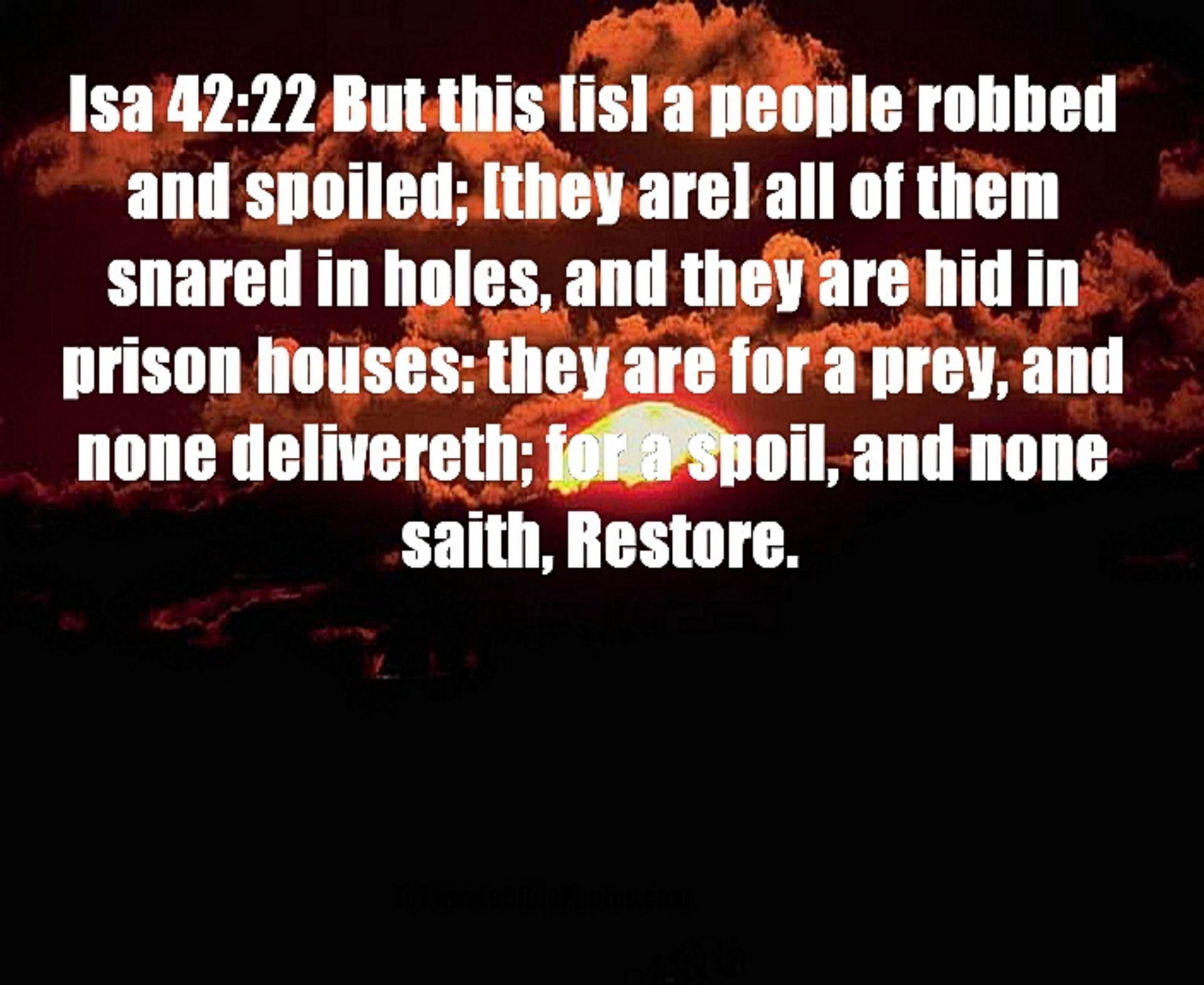


**Ecc 09:12 For man also knoweth not
